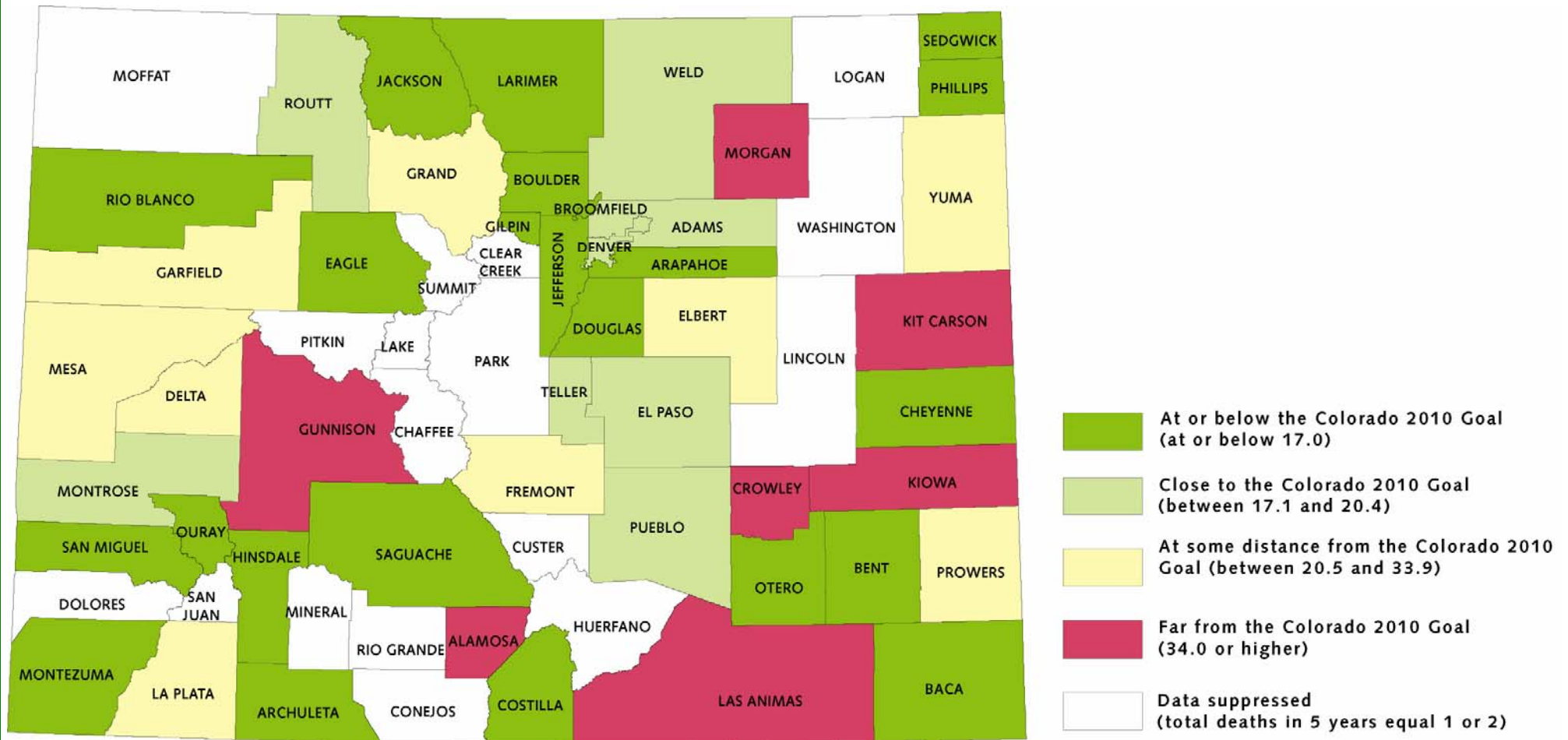

Colorado 2010 Goal: Reduce the death rate of children to no more than 17.0 deaths per 100,000 children ages 1 through 14.

County rates are 2003-2007 five-year averages. The state rate is 18.2 per 100,000.



Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
