


Motor Vehicle Deaths 0-14

(Rate per 100,000)

National Performance Measure 10

Healthy People 2010 Goal: Reduce the rate of deaths to children ages 0 through 14 caused by motor vehicle crashes to no more than 9.2 deaths per 100,000 children.

County rates are 2005-2007 three-year averages. The state rate is 3.1 per 100,000.



Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
