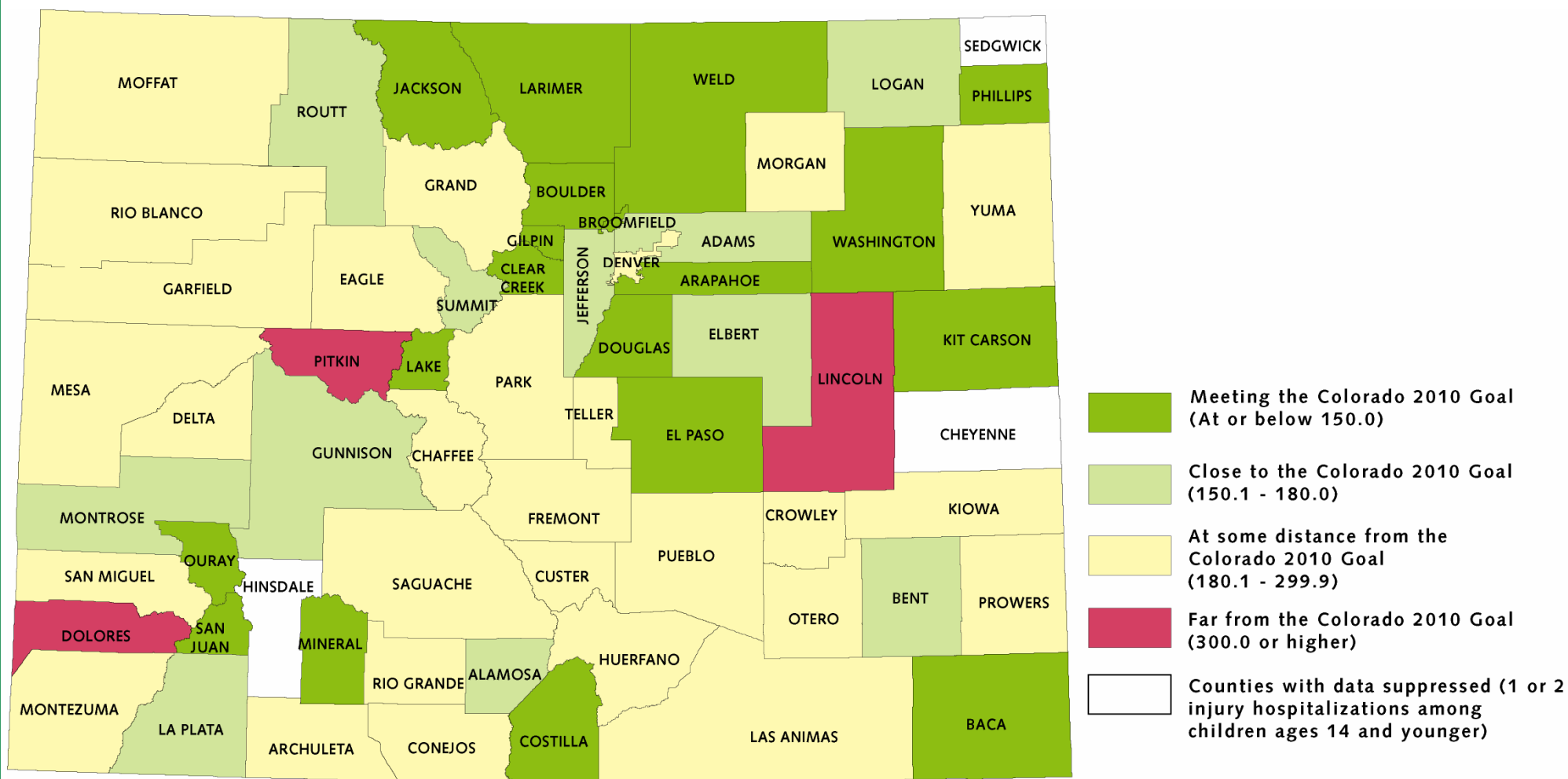

Colorado 2010 Goal: Reduce the rate of injury hospitalization among children age 14 and younger to 150.0 per 100,000.
