

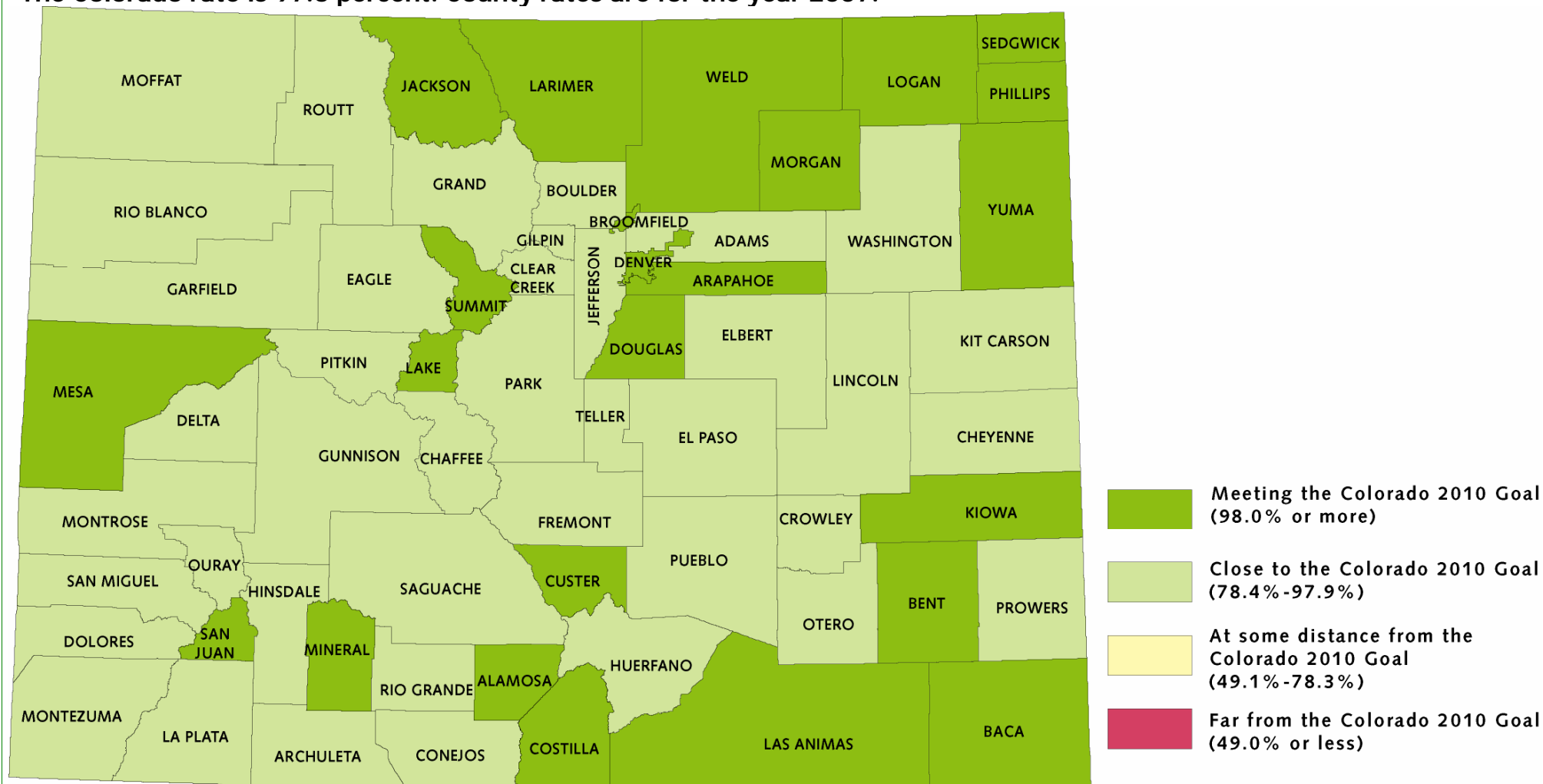

Colorado 2010 Goal: Increase the percent of infants whose hearing is screened for impairment before hospital discharge to 98.0 percent.

The Colorado rate is 97.6 percent. County rates are for the year 2007.
