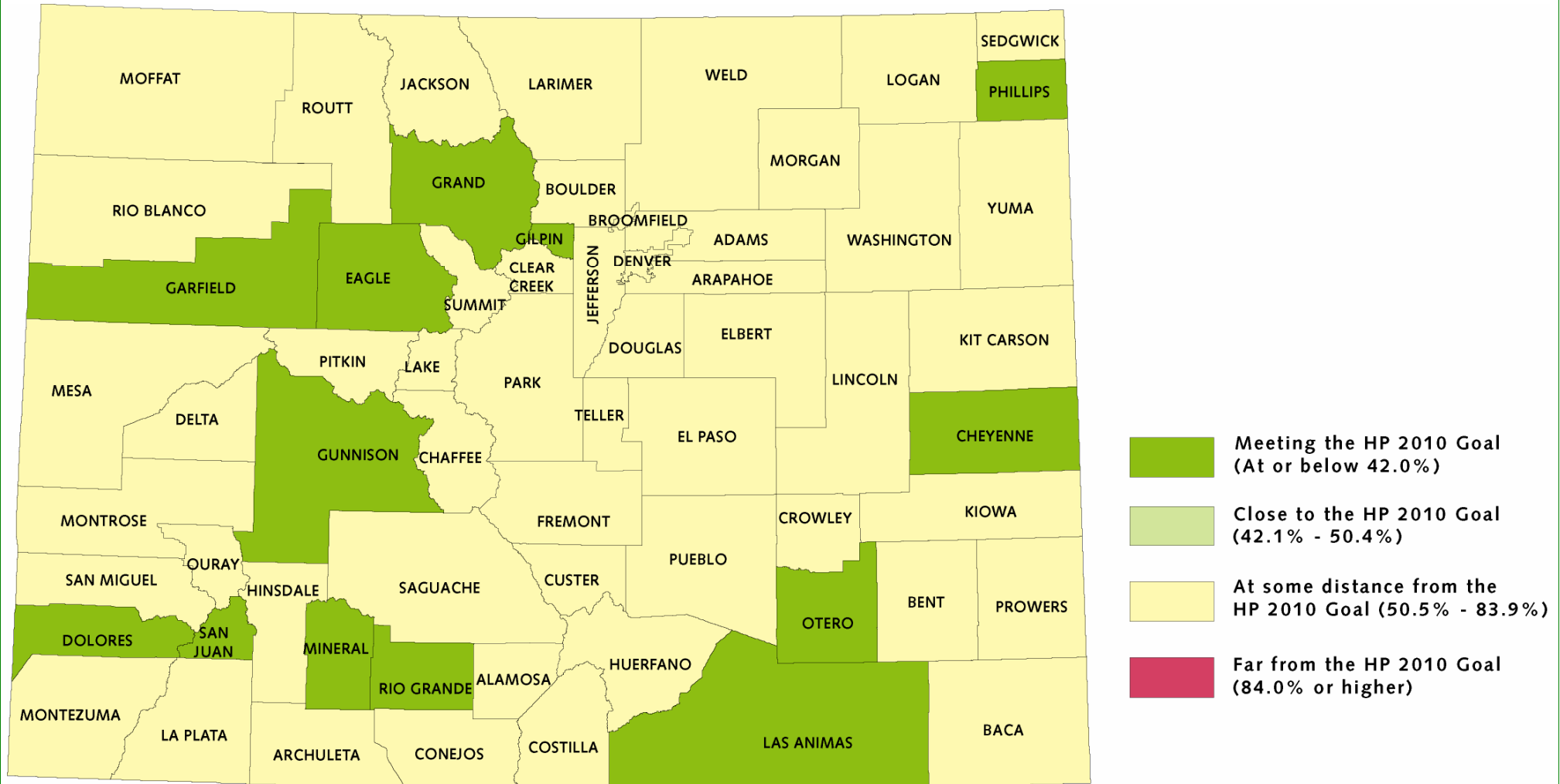


Caries Experience (Percent)

Health People 2010 Goal: Reduce the proportion of children who have dental caries experience in their primary and permanent teeth to 42.0 percent or less.

The Colorado rate is 57.2 percent. County rates are estimated for the 2006 – 2007 school year and are compared to the Healthy People 2010 Goal.



Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are double the goal.
