

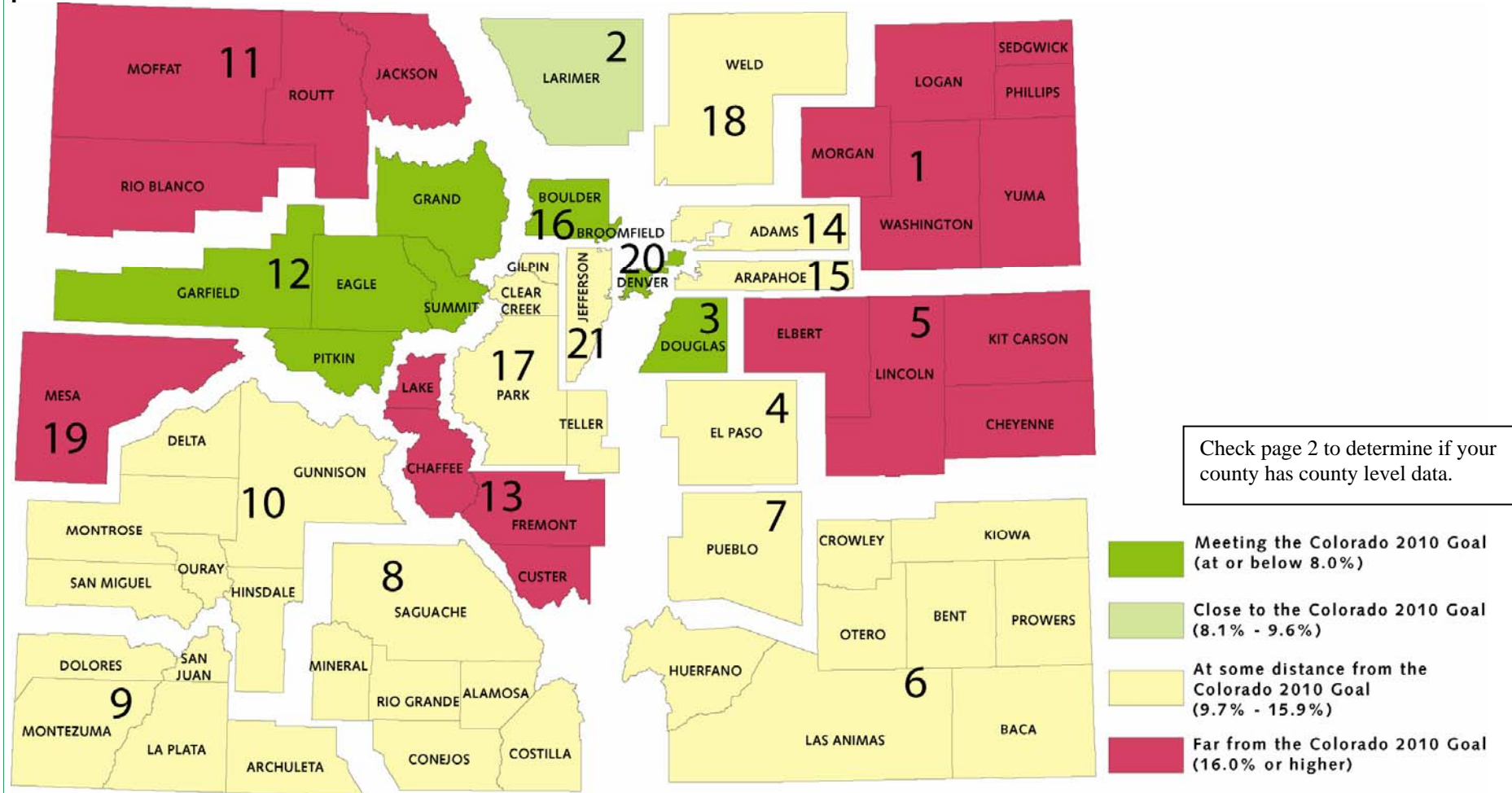
Smoking During the Last Three Months of Pregnancy

Colorado 2010 Goal: Reduce the percentage of women who smoke during the three months before pregnancy to 8.0 percent.

Data are survey data for 2003-2007, available for large counties; otherwise, only data for regions are available. The state rate is 10.4 percent.



Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
