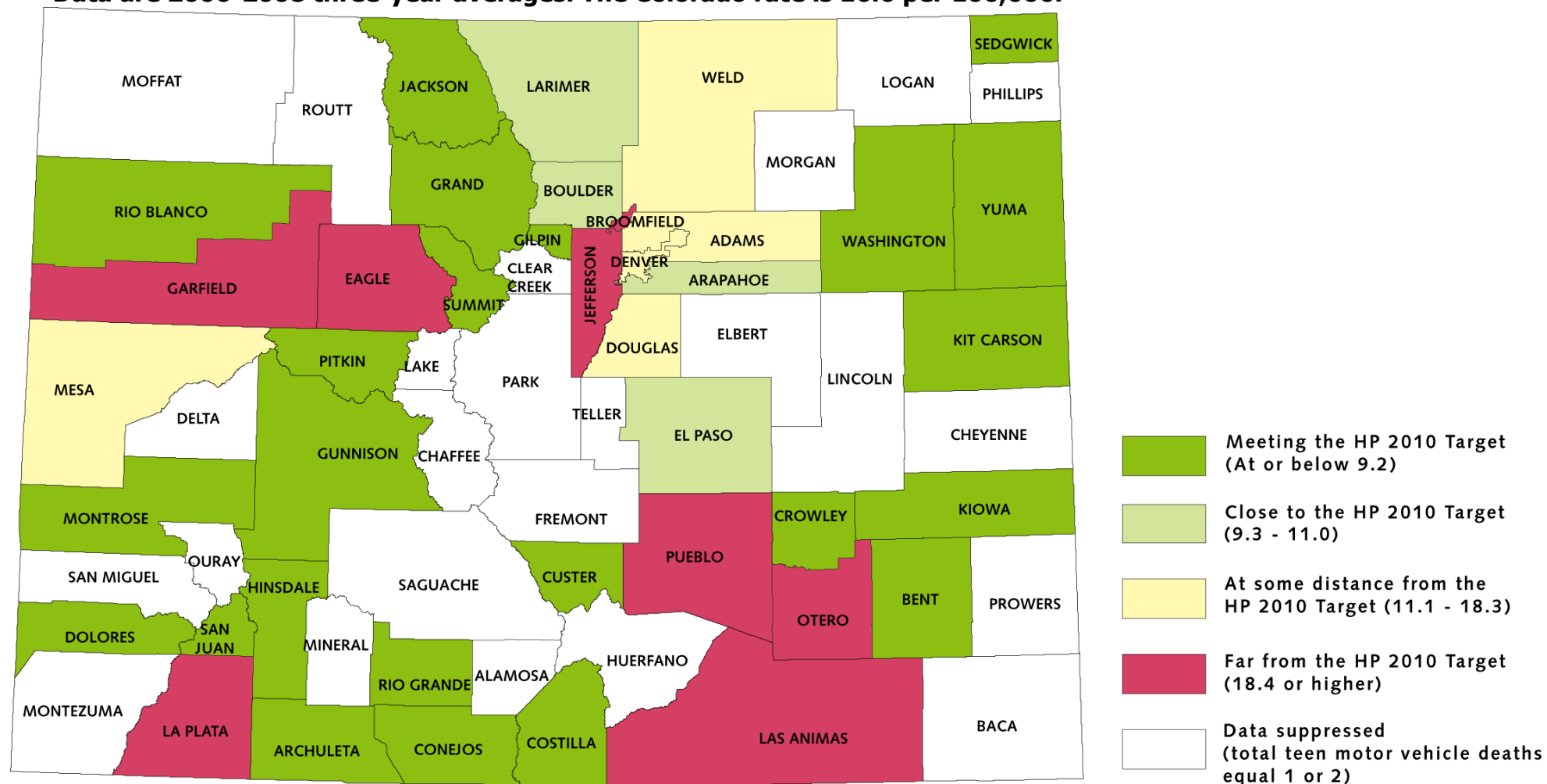


# Teen Motor Vehicle Deaths 15-19

**Healthy People 2010 Objective: Reduce the rate of deaths among teens ages 15 through 19 years caused by motor vehicle crashes to 9.2 per 100,000.**

**Data are 2006-2008 three-year averages. The Colorado rate is 16.6 per 100,000.**



*Counties categorized as close to the target are within 80 percent of the target; counties at some distance from the target are between 51 to 79 percent of the target; and counties far from the target are at least 50 percent lower than the desired target.*
