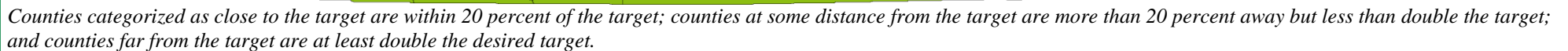

## Child Abuse

**Healthy People 2010 Objective: Reduce the rate of maltreatment of children younger than age 18 years (including physical abuse, sexual abuse, emotional abuse, and/or neglect) to 10.3 per 1,000 children.**

**Data are for calendar year 2007. The Colorado rate is 8.3 confirmed unique cases per 1,000 children. Each case is limited to one child. Counts and rates provided prior to 2003 referred to cases which may have included more than one child. The Healthy People 2010 Target is expressed in confirmed unique cases per 1,000 children.**
