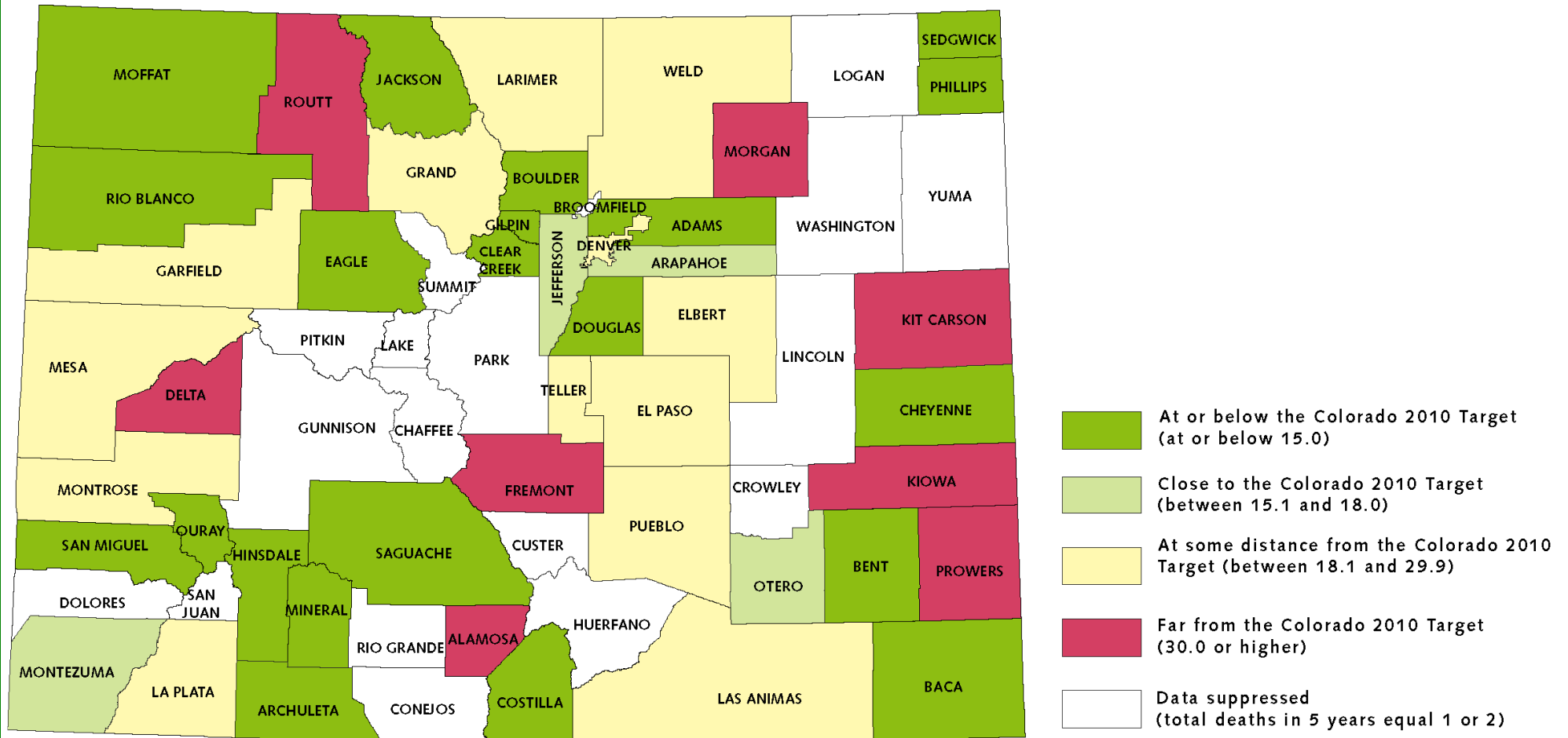

Colorado 2010 Objective: Reduce the death rate of children ages 1 through 14 years to 15.0 deaths per 100,000.

Data are 2004-2008 five-year averages. The Colorado rate is 17.7 per 100,000.



Counties categorized as close to the target are within 80 percent of the target; counties at some distance from the target are between 51 to 79 percent of the target; and counties far from the target are at least 50 percent lower than the desired target.
