
Overweight and Obese (Prevalence (%))

State Performance Measure 7

Healthy People 2010 Objective: Reduce the prevalence of both overweight and obesity in children ages 2 through 14 years (defined as having a body mass index (BMI) in the 85th percentile or greater) to 15.0 percent.

Data are combined results from 2007 and 2008. The Colorado prevalence is 26.8 percent.



Counties or regions categorized as close to the target are within 80 percent of the target; counties or regions at some distance from the target are between 51 to 79 percent of the target; and counties or regions far from the target are at least 50 percent lower than the desired target.
