
# **Smoking During the Three Months Before Pregnancy**

(Prevalence (%))

Colorado 2010 Objective: Reduce the prevalence of women who smoke during the three months before pregnancy to 19.0 percent.

Data are survey data for 2004-2008, available for large counties; otherwise, only data for regions are available. The Colorado prevalence is 19.8 percent.



Counties or regions categorized as close to the target are within 80 percent of the target; counties or regions at some distance from the target are between 51 percent and 79 percent of the target; and counties or regions far from the target are 50 percent or less of the desired target.
