
Unintended Births

Healthy People 2010 Objective: Decrease the prevalence of pregnancies that are unintended to 30.0 percent.

Data are survey data for 2004-2008, available for large counties; otherwise, only regional data are available. The survey data describe the percent of all births (not pregnancies) that are unintended. The Colorado prevalence is 38.6 percent.



Counties or regions categorized as close to the target are within 80 percent of the target; counties or regions at some distance from the target are between 51 percent and 79 percent of the target; and counties or regions far from the target are 50 percent or less of the desired target.
