
Number of Cases and Rates* of *Clostridium difficile* by Episode Status** and County-- Denver Metropolitan Area (EIP)[^], 2015

An incident case is defined as a positive *C. difficile* toxin assay or a positive *C. difficile* molecular assay (e.g. PCR) in a resident of one of the 5 EIP counties who is at least 1 year of age and whose specimen was collected greater than 8 weeks after any previous positive test.
A recurrent case is defined as a positive C. difficile toxin assay or a positive C. difficile molecular assay (e.g. PCR) in a resident of one of the 5 EIP counties who is at least 1 year of age whose toxin positive or molecular assay positive test occurs between 2 and 8 weeks after a previous positive specimen.
A duplicate case is defined as a positive C. difficile toxin assay or a positive C. difficile molecular assay (e.g. PCR) in a resident of one of the 5 EIP counties who is at least 1 year of age whose toxin positive or molecular assay positive test occurs between 2 and 8 weeks after a previous positive specimen.
