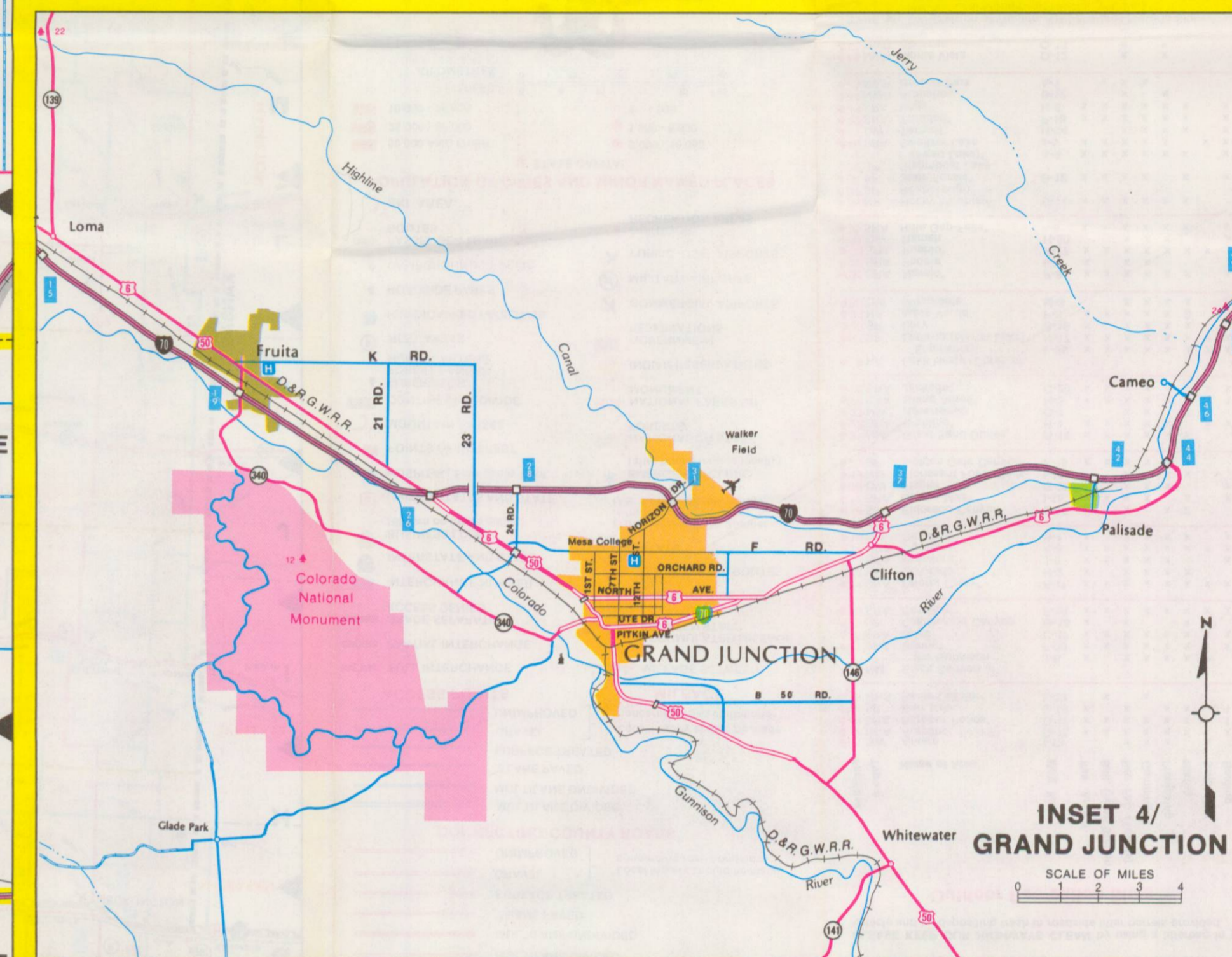
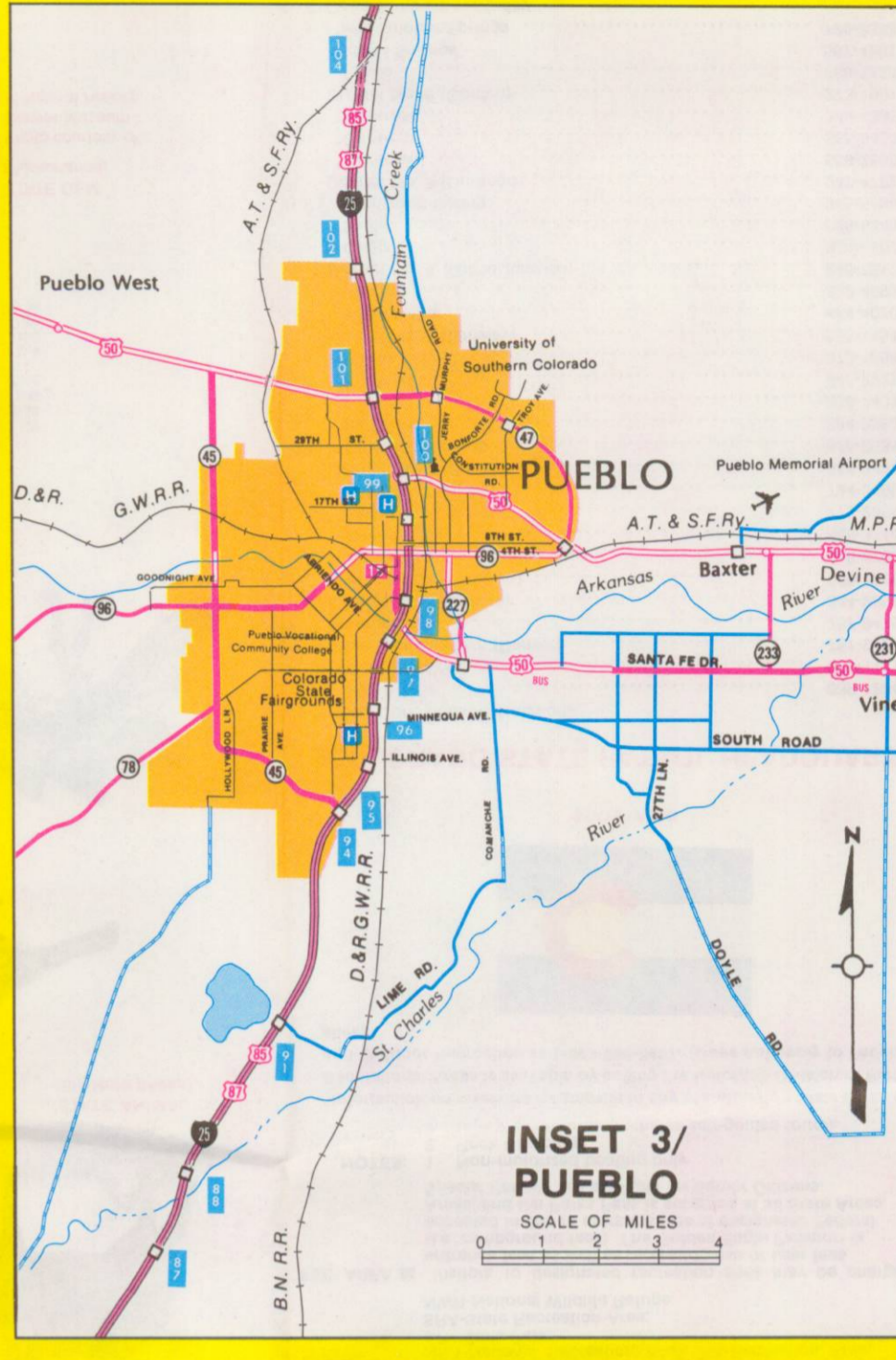
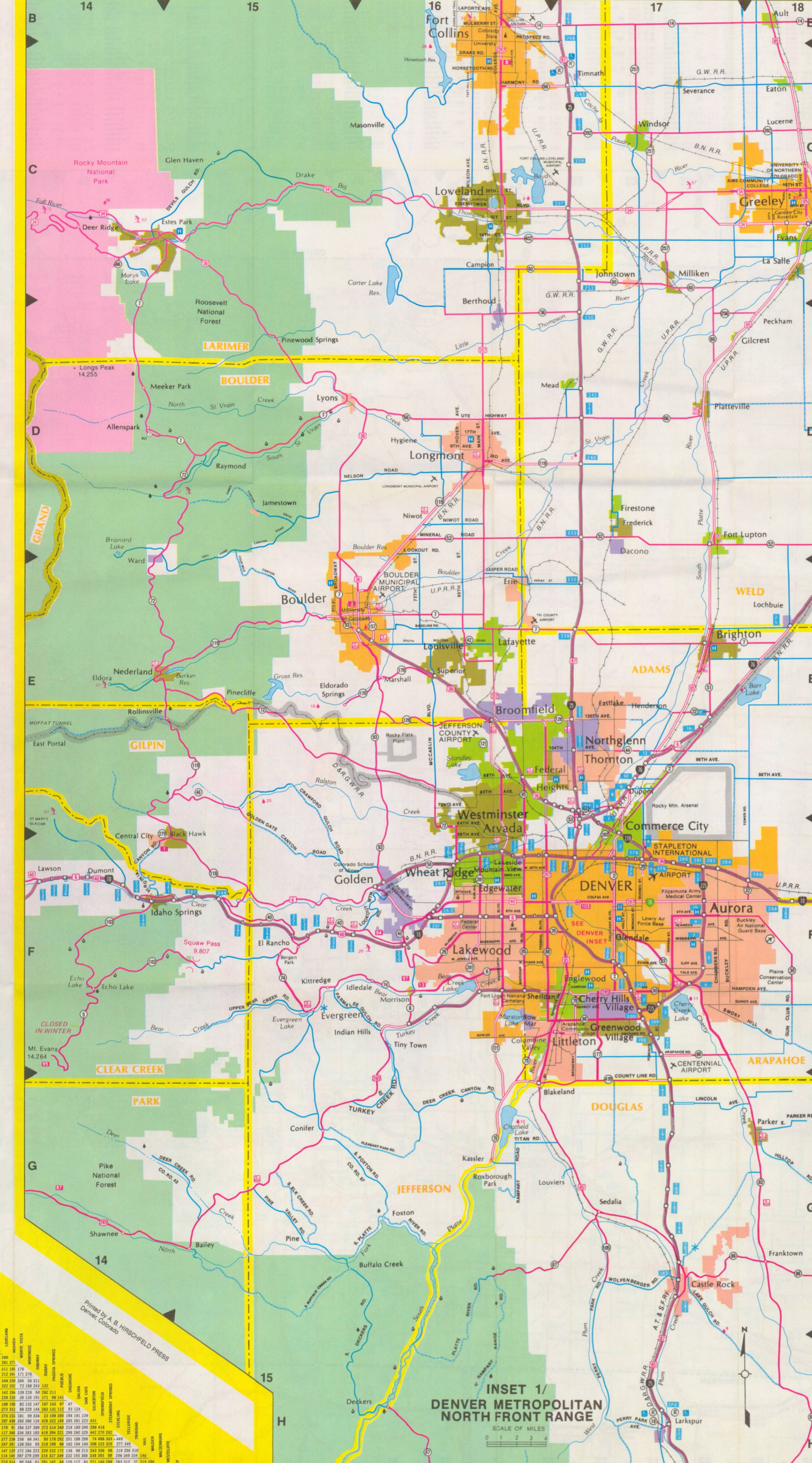

**SELECTED HISTORIC TOWNS AND DISTRICTS**

- BLACK HAWK-CENTRAL CITY - Gold mining district, the richest silver mine in the world.
- BOULDER - BOLLER'S QUADRANGLE UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO - History of the Boulder area.
- COEDALE - Early 20th century coal camp.
- COLORADO SPRINGS - NORTH END - Early 20th century residential district.
- CRIPPLE CREEK - Historic coal and iron mining town in 20th-century mountain setting.
- CRIPPLE CREEK - Historic coal and iron mining town in 20th-century mountain setting.
- DURANGO - Important trade center in southwestern Colorado, named after the Durango railroad.
- FORT COLLINS-OLD TOWN - Late 19th century commercial district.
- GEORGETOWN-SILVERPLUME - The oldest silver mining region in Colorado with some of the finest Victorian architecture in the U.S.
- LAKE CITY - The oldest city in the West, the most famous silver mining camp in the world.

- MARIONVILLE - Historic coal and iron mining town in 20th-century mountain setting.
- MORRISON - Early crossroads, townsite homesteaded by George Morrison in the 1860's.
- OURAY - Important supply center in San Juan mining district, southwestern of the Rockies.
- PUEBLO-LINDEN AVENUE - Historic commercial district.
- REDFORT - Turn-of-the-century coal camp.
- SALIDA - Historic commercial district.
- SAN LUIS - Colorado's oldest town, settled by Hispanic pioneers in 1853.
- SILVERTON - Rich mining town, "the gem of the Rockies", terminus of the narrow gauge railroad.
- TRINIDAD - Located on the mountain branch of the Santa Fe Trail, an important 19th century commercial center.
- VICTOR - Important gold town in the Cripple Creek district.

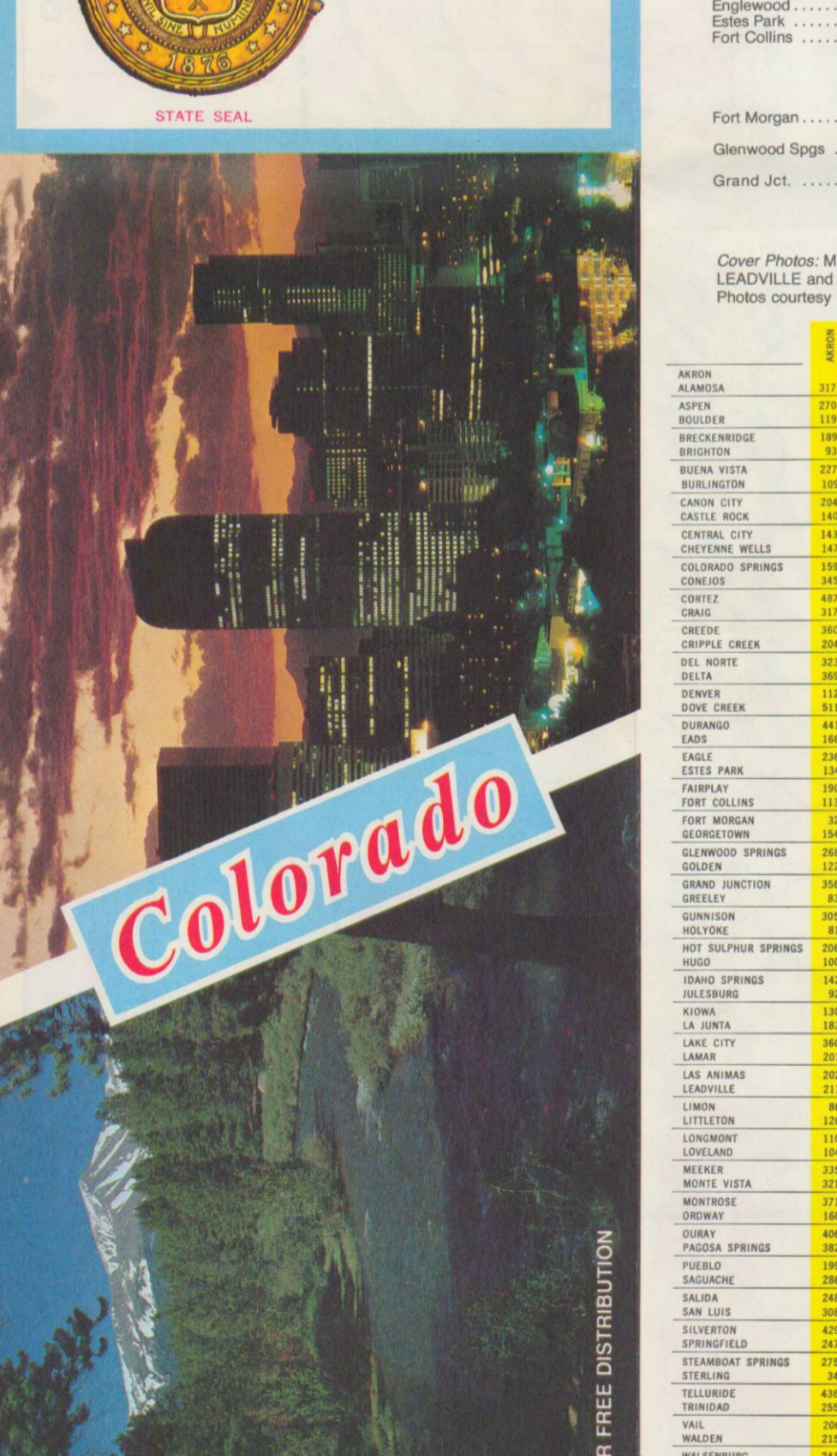
