Short Summary of Request:	This technical request totaling \$434,089, includes \$1,477,778 Cash Funds and (\$1,043,689) Reappropriated Funds, corrects the tobacco litigation settlement appropriation and revises the letternotes in the Long Bill for FY 2008-09 and FY 2009-10.
Background and Appropriation History:	The State of Colorado receives two types of tobacco settlement payments (perpetual base payments and strategic contribution payments) under the terms of the Master Settlement Agreement.
	Tobacco settlement supported programs are identified as either Tier 1 or Tier 2 programs pursuant to Section 24-75-1104.5, C.R.S., (2008). The funding allocation for Tier 1 programs equals the base payment received in the prior fiscal year plus \$15.4 million of the strategic contribution payment received in the current fiscal year. The balance of the Tier 1 funding allocation that is not utilized is distributed to Tier 2 programs based on established percentages. The Department's Tier 2 programs include Mental Health Services for Juvenile and Adult Offenders and Alcohol and Drug Abuse Programs.

The Alcohol and Drug Abuse Division receives three percent of the settlement monies which is transferred to the Short-term Innovative Health Program Grant Fund for the Juvenile Justice Family Advocacy Program and the Veteran's Mental Health Services Pilot Program.

#### General Description of Request:

The request corrects the appropriation of the tobacco settlement monies pursuant to special bill legislation concerning the allocation of tobacco litigation settlement monies for the following Mental Health and Alcohol and Drug Abuse Services line items:

(1.5) (a) For the 2007-08 fiscal year and for each fiscal year thereafter, the following programs, services, and funds shall receive the following specified amounts from the portion of any strategic contribution fund moneys received by the state in the current fiscal year that remains after the programs, services, and funds receiving strategic contribution fund moneys pursuant to subsection (1) of this section have been fully funded, and the portion of all other settlement moneys received by the state in the preceding fiscal year that remains after the programs, services, and funds receiving such other settlement moneys pursuant to subsection (1) of this section have been fully funded

and all overexpenditures and supplemental appropriations allowed for the 2006-07, 2007-08, and 2008-09 fiscal years pursuant to section  $\underline{24-22-115}$  (4) have been made:

(VIII) The division of alcohol and drug abuse in the department of human services shall receive three percent of the settlement moneys, which shall be transferred by the state treasurer to the alcohol and drug abuse community prevention and treatment fund, which is hereby created in the state treasury. Interest and income earned on the deposit and investment of moneys in the fund shall be credited to the fund and shall remain in the fund until the end of the fiscal year in which credited, when it shall be transferred to the short-term innovative health program grant fund created in section 25-36-101 (2), C.R.S., in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection (1.5). The principal of the fund shall be subject to annual appropriation by the general assembly to provide or purchase community prevention and treatment services in accordance with section 25-1-206, C.R.S.; except that, at the end of the 2007-08 fiscal year and at the end of each fiscal year thereafter, all unexpended and unencumbered principal of the fund shall be transferred to the short-term innovative health program grant fund created in section 25-36-101 (2), C.R.S., in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection (1.5).
