Market Rate Survey of Child Care Providers

Summary and Methodology

Introduction

Qualistar Early Learning developed a market rate survey of licensed child care centers, family child care providers, and school age child care facilities in January of 2009 for the Colorado Department of Human Services, Division of Child Care. Qualistar Early Learning manages a network of child care resource and referral (CCR&R) partners that serve all 64 Colorado counties. CCR&Rs collect costs of child care on a semi-annual basis in a networked database called NACCRAware. Data from Colorado's NACCRAware database was utilized to complete this survey.

Methodology

The rate information collected and maintained by CCR&Rs is entered into the NACCRAware database as a full time weekly rate. Rates not reported by the child care program as full time weekly rates are converted to full time weekly rates according to the following standardized formulas: Monthly rates are divided by 4.33. Daily rates are multiplied by 5. Hourly rates are multiplied by 45. Hourly rates for before and after school programs are multiplied by 17.5.

Survey Target Facilities - The target facilities for this survey were child care centers, family child care homes, and school age child care facilities that serve children full time and that operate with a market price. Child care programs that meet those criteria and that had reported their rates between August 1, 2008 and January 5, 2009 were included in the survey.

Rates for the following age groups were pulled: Infants (0-12 months), Toddlers (1-2 years), Preschoolers (2-5 years), and School Agers (6+ years). For School Agers, both full day out of school rates and before and after school rates were pulled.

Survey Target Facilities Refinement - After the data was compiled from NACCRAware, all of the records that had incomplete data, such as programs with missing license numbers, were taken out of the survey. Additionally, outlier rates that were identified through the Interquartile Range Computation were removed. Interquartile Range: If Q1 is the 25th percentile, Q3 is the 75th percentile, and IQR is the interquartile range, meaning the difference between Q1 and Q3, then an outlier is anything lying outside $Q1 - (1.5 * IQR)$ and $Q3 + (1.5 * IQR)$.

The final response rate was 80.1%. (See Response Rate chart)

The average, median, minimum, maximum, 75th percentile, and mode were calculated for each county according to type of care and age group. Counties were color-coded to further define how the Colorado Department of Human Services designates counties.

Summary

Colorado is unable to determine rate variances from the previous Market Rate Survey (MRS) (conducted November 2006, adopted April 2007)) due to changes in the MRS methodology.

- 1) Prior to 2009, the 0-12 Month rates and the 1-2 Year rates were averaged and reported as the 0-2 Years rate. In an effort to better reflect the significant differences in infant (0-12 Month) rates and toddler (1-2 Years) rates that exist in many child care programs, these two rate categories have been kept separate in the 2009 MRS.
- 2) Also a change in the 2009 MRS methodology is the exclusion of the 5-6 Years rate. In the past, rates for this age category were averaged with the 2-5 Years rate, resulting in a reported 2-6 Years rate. The 5-6 Years rate has been excluded because of the inconsistency with which it is applied in programs. That is, because some 5-6 year olds are not yet in school, some are in part day kindergarten, and others are in full day school, child care programs often have multiple rates for children of these ages and it is therefore not truly a disparate rate category.
- 3) The previous MRS did not define the survey targeted facilities as those that operated with a market price. The inclusion of facilities that did not have a market price led to mis-information related to market rates in Colorado.
- 4) Previous MRS versions did not remove Outlier Rates as defined above in SurveyTarget Facilities Refinement.
- 5) The 2009 MRS is the first to indicate the true 75th percentile at the County Designation level. All rates for each rate category within the County Designation were ordered and the 75th percentile was calculated. In the past two iterations of the MRS, the 75th percentile was calculated for each county; those county-level 75th percentiles were then *averaged* and reported as the 75th percentile for the County Designation. The current approach yields a truer 75th percentile for the County Designation.

6) The previous MRS captured data that was in the system at a point in time without reference to when the data was collected. As noted previously, the current MRS only included providers whose rates were reported between August 1, 2008 and January 5, 2009. The begin date of this period was reflective of the fact that most providers make rate changes in August or September of the year and by including this cohort only, the State was assured of have more current rates in the survey.

While these methodology changes preclude Colorado from comparing rates to those in previous MRS versions, they are design improvements that better reflect child care prices and will become the baseline figures for more meaningful comparisons in future MRS iterations.

State Recommended Provider Reimbursement Rates

The State Recommended Provider Reimbursement Rates are determined to address the federal Child Care Development Fund (CCDF) regulation that requires states to certify that the payment rates for subsidized child care services are sufficient to ensure equal access to child care services for eligible and non-eligible families. The methodology used is the following –

In each county designation category (see information below regarding county designation categories of A, B, C, D), the 75th percentile of all rates in that category is calculated to reach the State Recommended Provider Reimbursement Rates.

Under Colorado's welfare reform legislation, county departments of social services/human services have the flexibility to set their own rates. Therefore, the State Recommended Provider Reimbursement Rates are for informational and reference purposes to be used by counties as guidance to provide equal access as described above.

County Designation Procedure or Information:

Market Rate Survey results were aggregated into four market areas called "Designations."

- County Designation is determined by the following Criteria:

 - (1) Population (over 35,000 and under 35,000) as determined by census reporting;
 - (a) County combined average child care provider market rate;
 - (b) Household income as determined by census reporting; and,
 - (c) The Basic Industries Group Tourism Commuter Index.

Each county fits into a designation by applying the following standards:

Designation A: County has population greater than 35,000 and is higher than the median in two of three categories (a - c).

Designation B: County has population greater than 35,000 and is NOT higher than the median in two of three categories (a - c)

Designation C: County has population below 35,000 and is higher than the median in two of three categories (a - c).

Designation D: County has population below 35,000 and is NOT higher than the median in two of three categories (a - c).

Data Comparison of 2009 to 2007 State Recommended Rates

Colorado is unable to do a rate analysis to determine rate variances from the previous Market Rate Survey (MRS) (conducted November 2006, adopted April 2007) due to changes in the MRS methodology. (See Summary and Methodology Worksheet)
