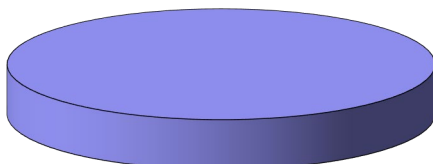

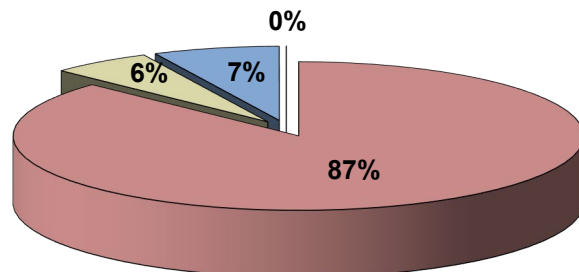

Year to Date<sup>1</sup>



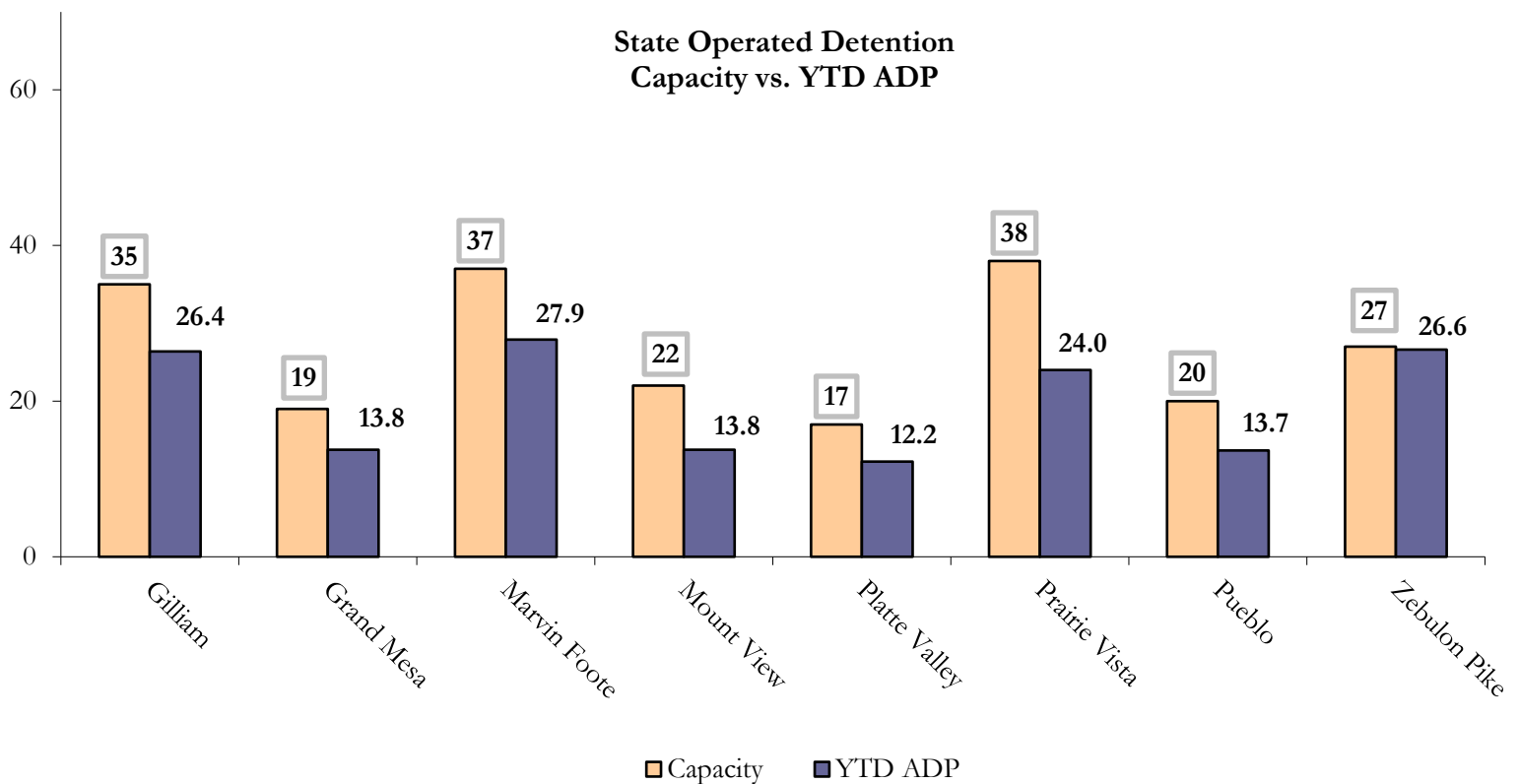
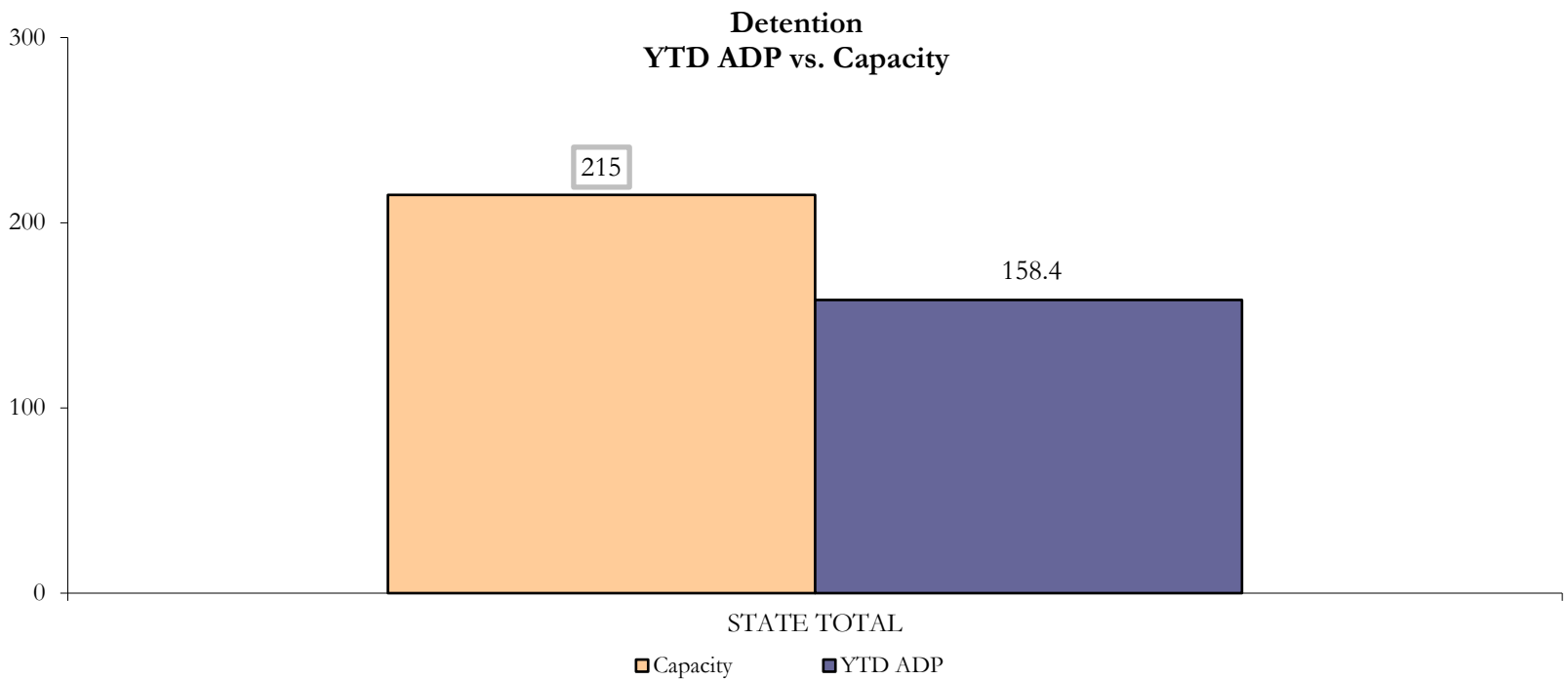

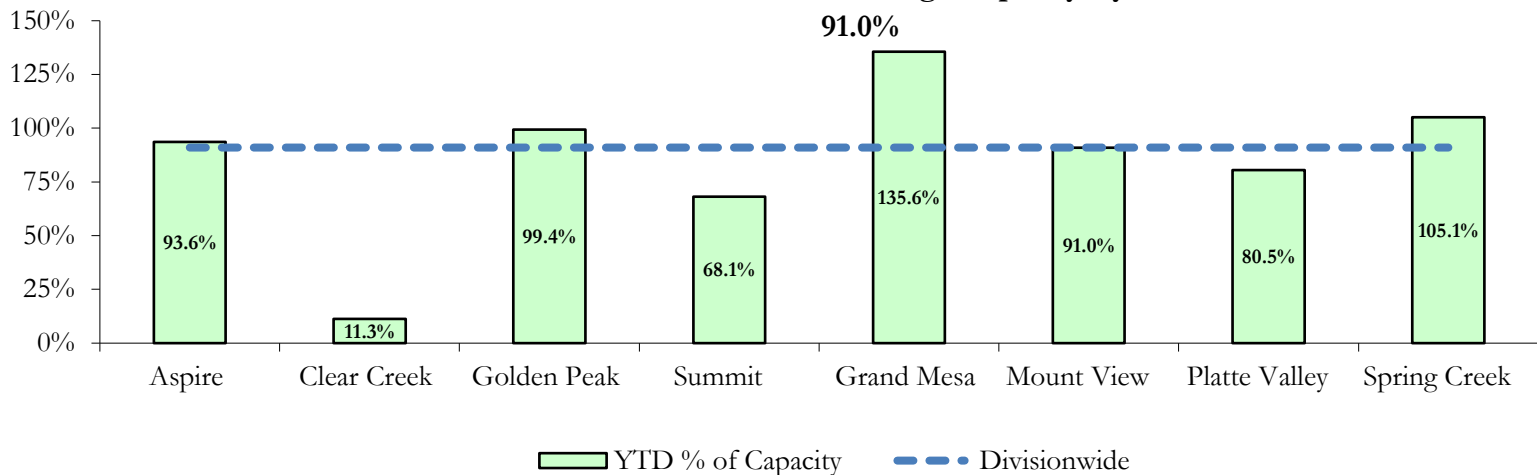
