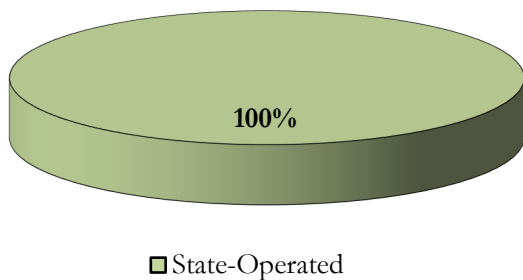

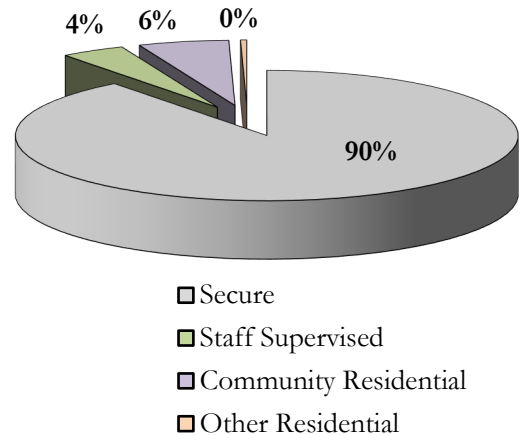

Commitment ADP YTD¹

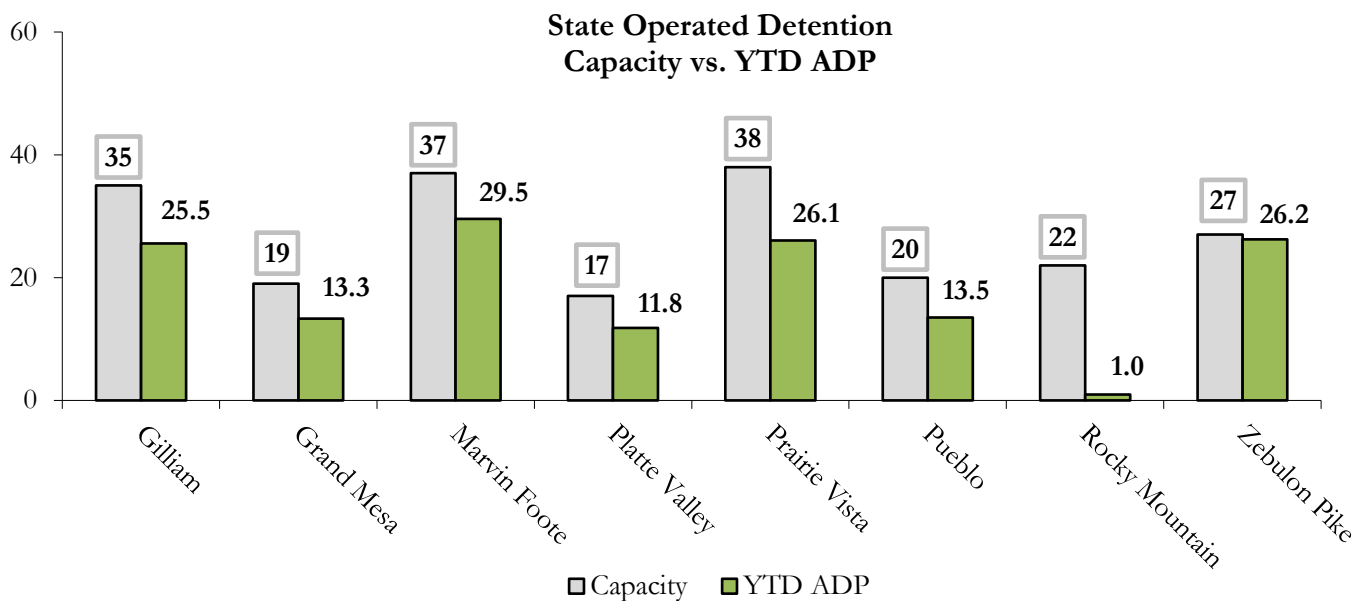
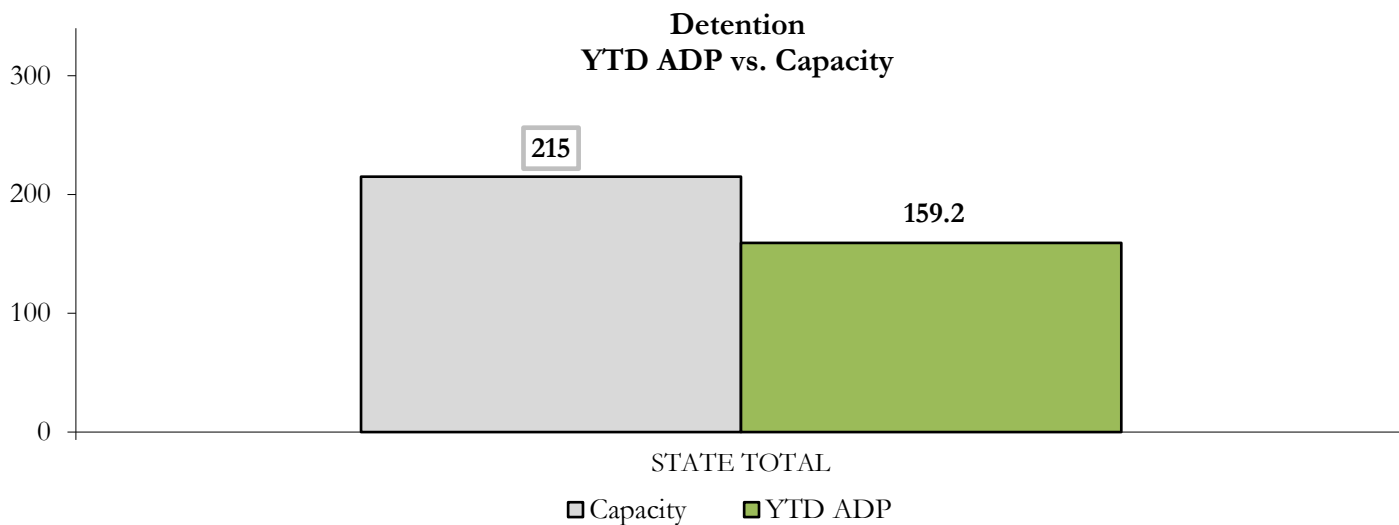
