NUMBER OF TIPS RECEIVED

1,189

1,189 tips were received from October 1 through 31, 2020. This is a **55% decrease** in tip volume from October 2019.

2,974

2,974 tips were received from August 1, 2020 through October 31, 2020. This is a **56% decrease** compared to last school year and is related to delayed school openings and distance learning practices due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Approximately **1.7% of tips received during the 2020-2021 school year, which began August 1, 2020, were determined to be false.** False tips are reports made with the intent to bully, injure, or harm another person.

DUPLICATE TIPS

Duplicate tips are reports made regarding a concern or event that has already been reported and are an indicator of a healthy reporting culture within a community. **215 duplicate tips have been reported during the current school year.**
