1,035

1,035 tips were received in March 2021. This is a **41% decrease** in tip volume from March 2020.

7,786

7,786 tips were received from August 1, 2020 through March 31, 2021. This is a **56% decrease** compared to last school year and is related to delayed school openings and distance learning practices due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Approximately 1.5% of tips received during the 2020-2021 school year, which began August 1, 2020, were determined to be false. False tips are reports made with the intent to bully, injure, or harm another person.

DUPLICATE TIPS

Duplicate tips are reports made regarding a concern or event that has already been reported and are an indicator of a healthy reporting culture within a community. **567 duplicate tips have been reported during the current school year.**
