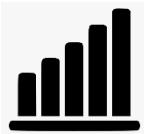
### NUMBER OF REPORTS RECEIVED

**TOTAL REPORTS RECEIVED SINCE 2004**

Safe2Tell has received 105,188 reports since its inception in 2004. This number excludes duplicate reports, pranks, hang-ups, and test reports.

**DUPLICATE REPORTS**

Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported. **1,743 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year**; 112 duplicates were reported in March alone—a 29% decrease compared to February.
