

Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported, and they indicate a healthy culture of reporting safety concerns in a community. 1,248 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year; 202 duplicates were reported in January alone—a 6% decrease compared to December.


Sample reports

Correct use of Safe2Tell A person reported their friends were being verbally and physically abused by another student. School teams investigated and spoke the individuals involved, which resulted in the student's parents being notified, a restorative conversation, and a suspension.

Correct use of Safe2Tell

A person reported a student flashing a knife to other students. Local teams investigated and the School Resource Officer found a weapon on the student. School disciplinary action was taken.
