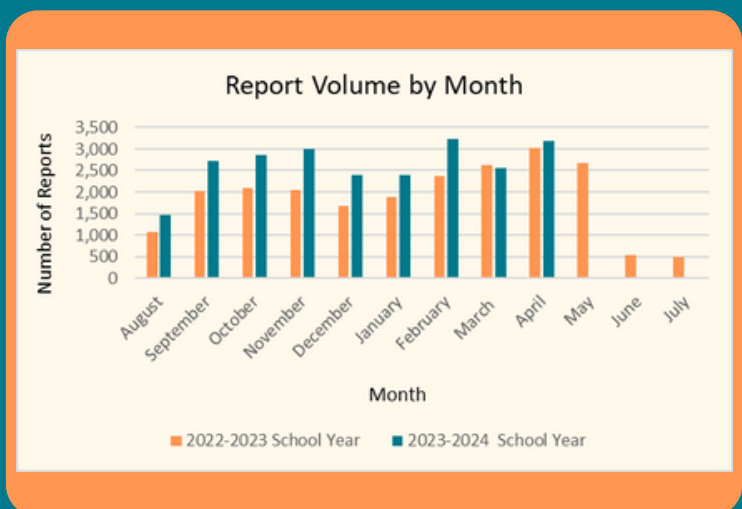

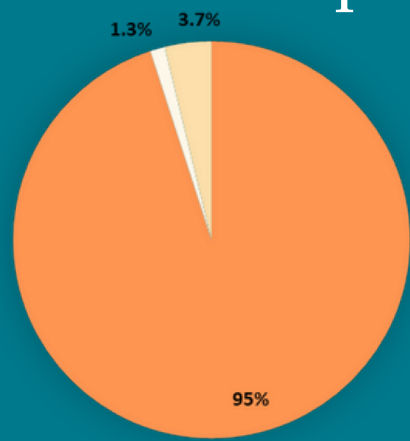
Duplicate reports



Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported, and they indicate a healthy culture of reporting safety concerns in a community. 1,989 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year; 266 duplicates were reported in April alone—a 34% increase compared to March.

95% of reports received during the 2023-2024 school year, which began August 1, 2023, were determined to be valid. Valid reports are those requiring a response, and that are made with the intent to protect, prevent harm, or help.

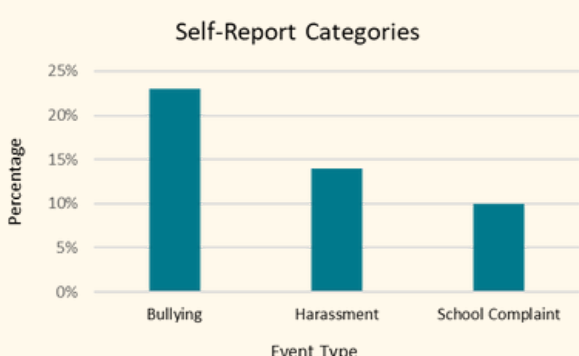
Sample reports

Correct use of Safe2Tell A person reported that a peer regularly brings their knife to school, and although they don't think the student is dangerous, it makes them uncomfortable. School teams investigated, confiscated the student's knife, contacted the parents, and took school disciplinary action.

Correct use of Safe2Tell A person reported a student was blackmailing a classmate and sending inappropriate photos of that classmate to their peers. School teams investigated, spoke with the student and their parent, took disciplinary action, facilitated a restorative conversation with the student, and arranged counseling for them.
