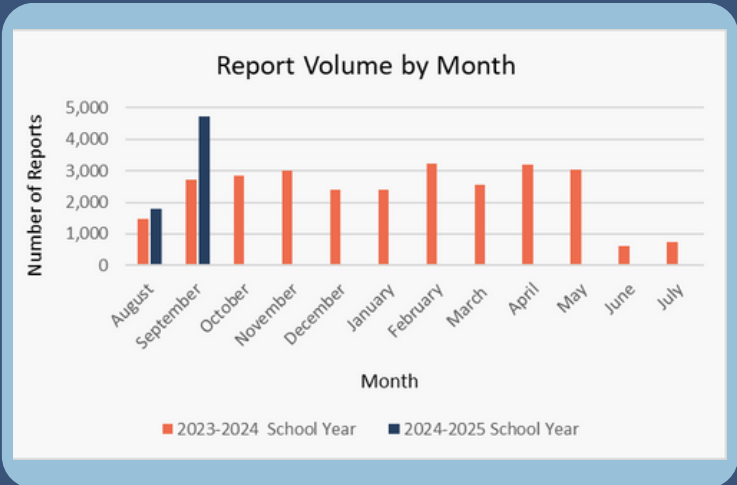

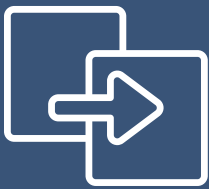

Duplicate reports

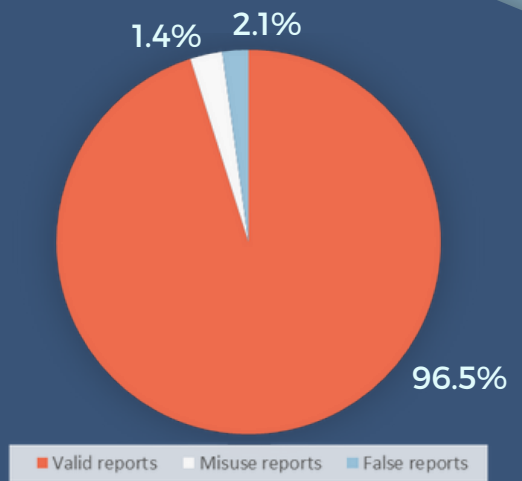


Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported, and they indicate a healthy culture of reporting safety concerns in a community. 1,438 duplicates were reported in September alone—an 885% increase compared to August.

96.5% Valid reports



96.5% of reports received during the 2024-2025 school year, which began August 1, 2024, were determined to be valid. Valid reports are those requiring a response, and that are made with the intent to protect, prevent harm, or help.

Sample reports

- Correct use of Safe2Tell** — A person reported that a student threw a knife at another student and almost harmed that individual. Local teams investigated and contacted the student's parent, in addition to placing them on a plan to ensure the safety of all students.
- Correct use of Safe2Tell** — A person reported seeing a social media post by a peer that mentioned explosives in their classroom and threatened students not to go to school. Local law enforcement conducted an investigation and arrested the student who made the social media post, in addition to reporting the account where threats were made to the social media platform.
