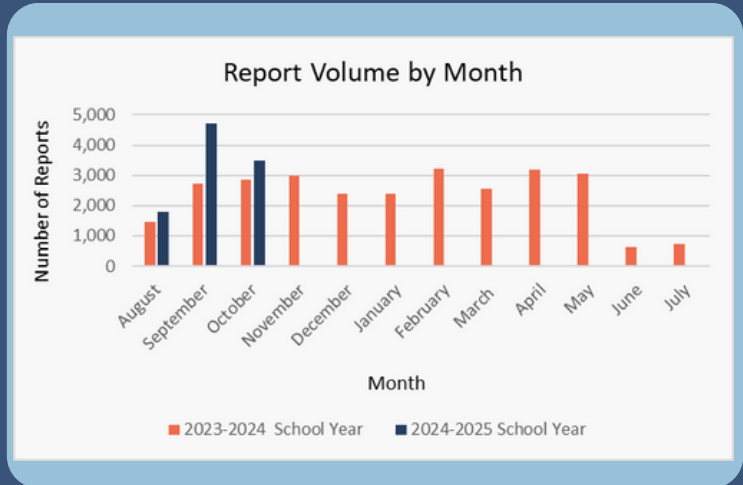

## Duplicate reports

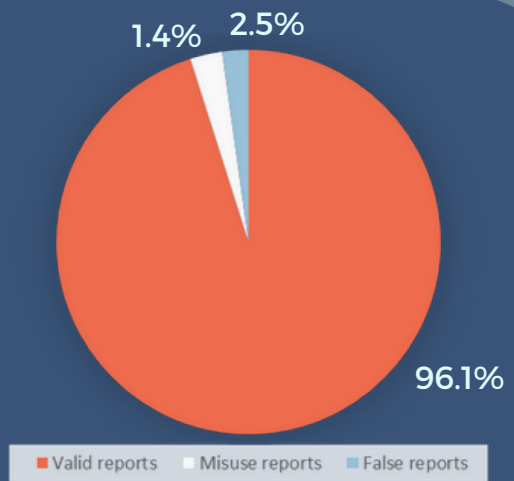


Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported, and they indicate a healthy culture of reporting safety concerns in a community. 1,997 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year; 394 duplicates were reported in October alone—a 73% decrease compared to September.

## 96.1% Valid reports



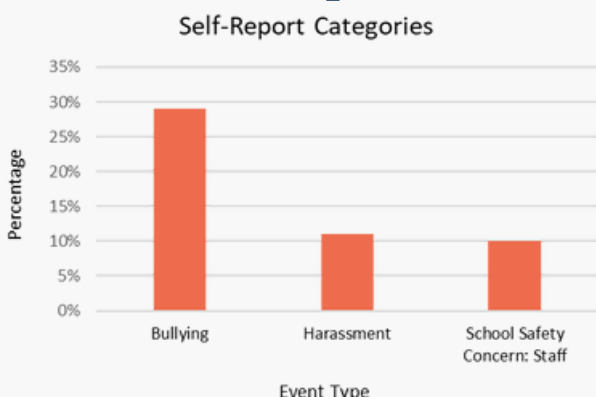
96.1% of reports received during the 2024-2025 school year, which began August 1, 2024, were determined to be valid. Valid reports are those requiring a response, and that are made with the intent to protect, prevent harm, or help.

## Sample reports

- Correct use of Safe2Tell: A person reported a student was self-harming and that they saw marks on the student's body. School teams investigated and met with the student and parent. The student is attending weekly counseling sessions.
- Correct use of Safe2Tell: A person reported a student was verbally inappropriate and sexually assaulting peers in their class. School teams investigated the situation and had a restorative conversation with the student, notified their parents, and took school disciplinary action.
