




Duplicate reports

Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported, and they indicate a healthy culture of reporting safety concerns in a community. 2,220 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year; 221 duplicates were reported in November alone—a 44% decrease compared to October.

96.5% Valid reports



96.5% of reports received during the 2024-2025 school year, which began August 1, 2024, were determined to be valid. Valid reports are those requiring a response, and that are made with the intent to protect, prevent harm, or help.

Sample reports

Correct use of Safe2Tell

A person reported a student was couch hopping because they were being abused at home. School teams and local law enforcement conducted a welfare check. The student is getting counseling, and the Department of Human Services is involved.

Correct use of Safe2Tell

A person reported a student expressed suicidal ideation. Local law enforcement spoke with the student and their parents, the student confirmed having thoughts of ending their life, and the student is receiving counseling services in and outside of school.
