


Duplicate reports

Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported, and they indicate a healthy culture of reporting safety concerns in a community. 2,452 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year; 231 duplicates were reported in December alone—a 4.5% increase compared to November.

96.3% Valid reports



96.3% of reports received during the 2024-2025 school year, which began August 1, 2024, were determined to be valid. Valid reports are those requiring a response, and that are made with the intent to protect, prevent harm, or help.

Correct use of Safe2Tell

A person reported a student shared their plans to run away. The student was located and school teams are working with the family to support the student.

Correct use of Safe2Tell

A person reported a student threatened to harm other students in class, and that they were harassing their peers. School teams investigated and spoke with the student. The school notified the student's parents and implemented disciplinary action. The student is also receiving counseling services.
