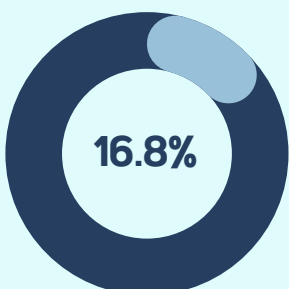
2,854 reports were received in February 2025,
and 20,736 reports were received to date for the current school year.



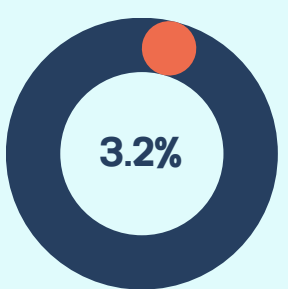
JANUARY REPORT TYPES

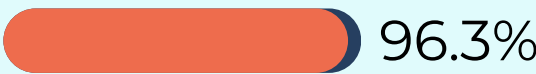


Duplicate Reports this SY



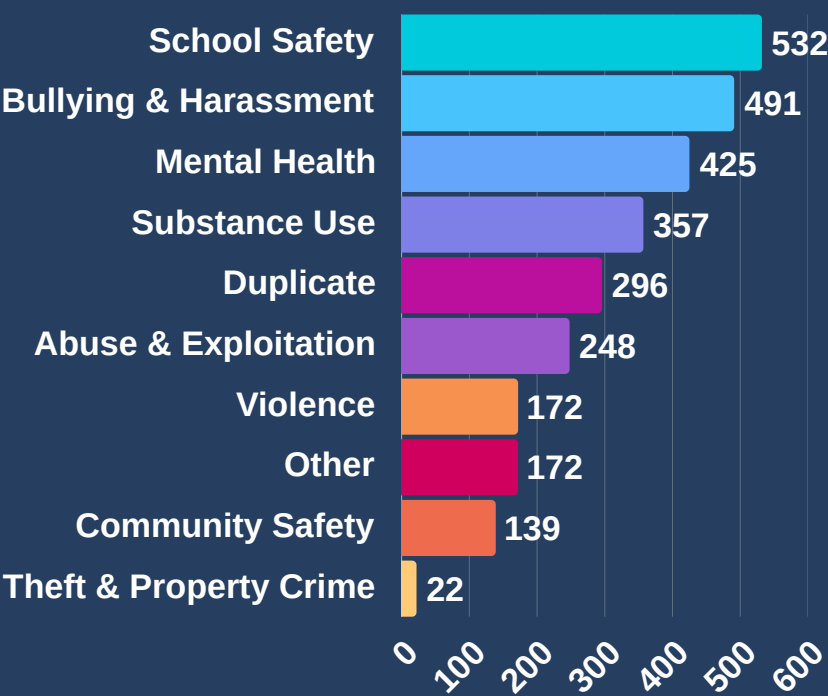
2,995 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

Valid reports during this SY



96.3% of reports received during the 24-25 school year, which began 8/1/24, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 1.5%, and false reports were 2.2%

January Reporting Themes



Report Example

A person reported a student made physical contact with another student without their consent several times. School teams and the School Resource Officer investigated and spoke with the students involved. The school took disciplinary action against the student who made physical contact, the victim is receiving counseling, and the school contacted both sets of parents.
