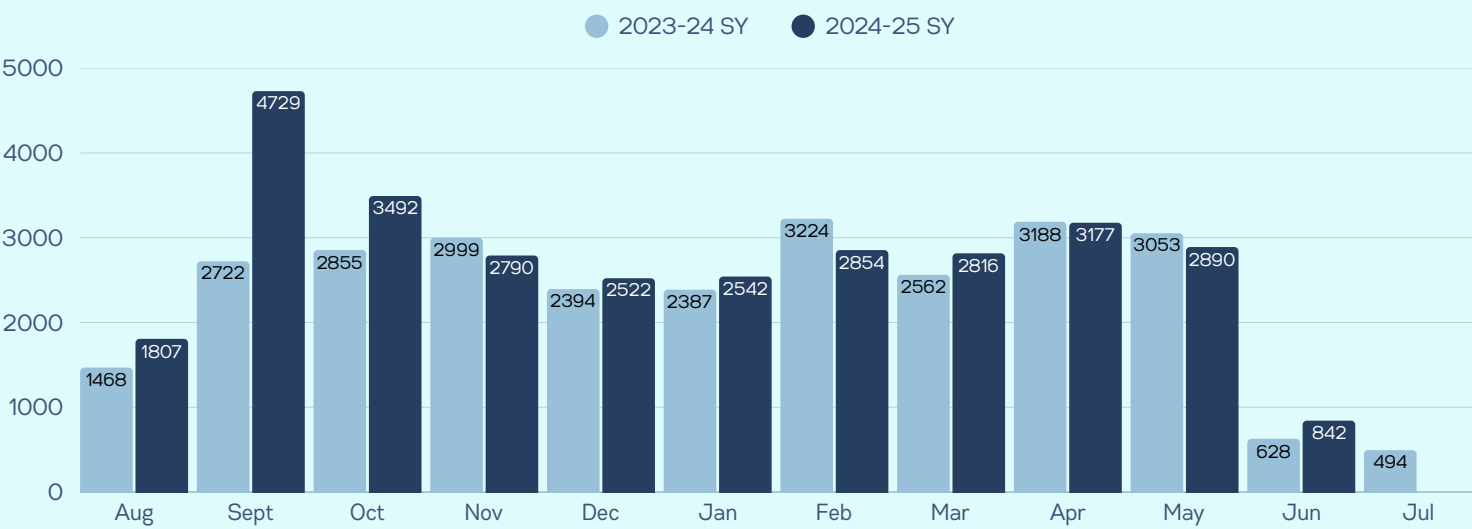

and 30,461 reports were received to date for the current school year.

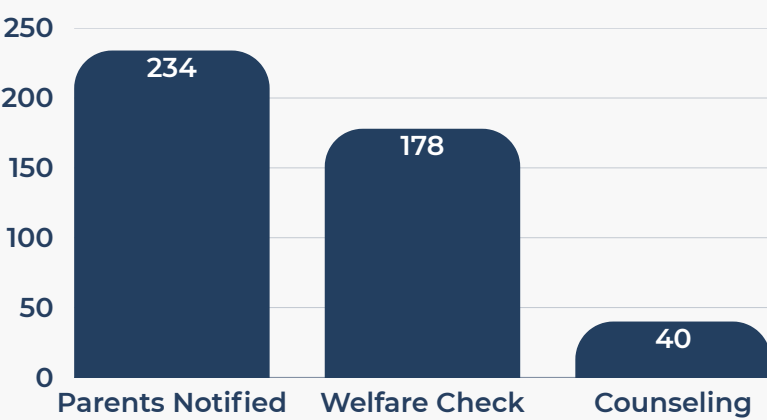

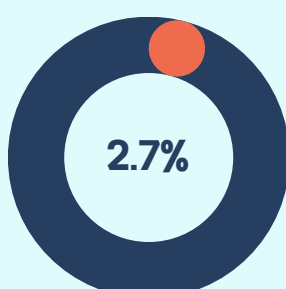

A person reported that a student who self-harmed in the past recently sent a text about suicidal ideation. Local law enforcement contacted the student's parents and also conducted a welfare check. The student said the text was a joke. The parents will resume therapy for their student.

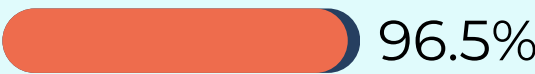


Duplicate Reports this SY



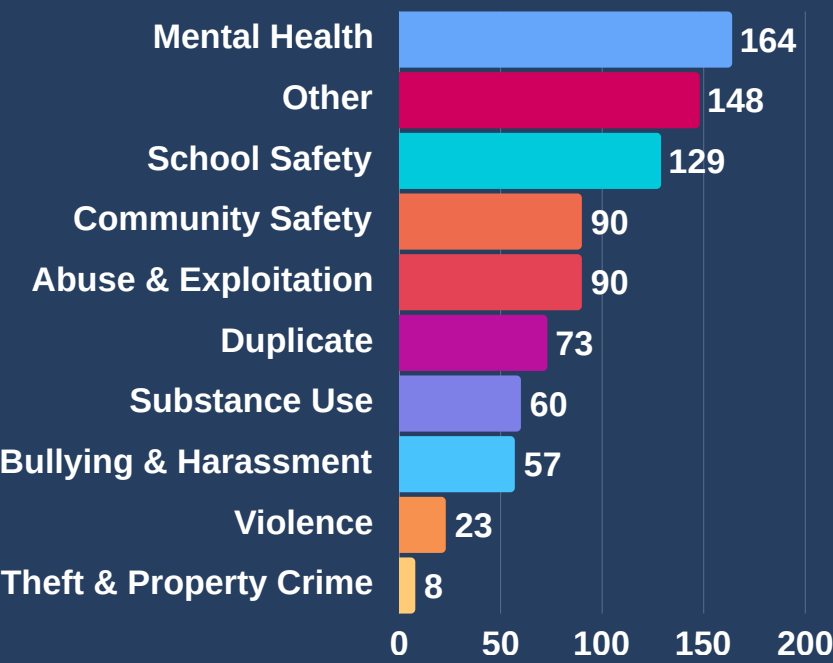
3,867 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

96.5% of reports received during the 24-25 school year, which began 8/1/24, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 1.3%, and false reports were 2.2%

Report Example

A person reported a student was harassing a sibling. Local law enforcement conducted a welfare check, which resulted in steps to ensure the safety of the sibling and the provision of mental health services.
