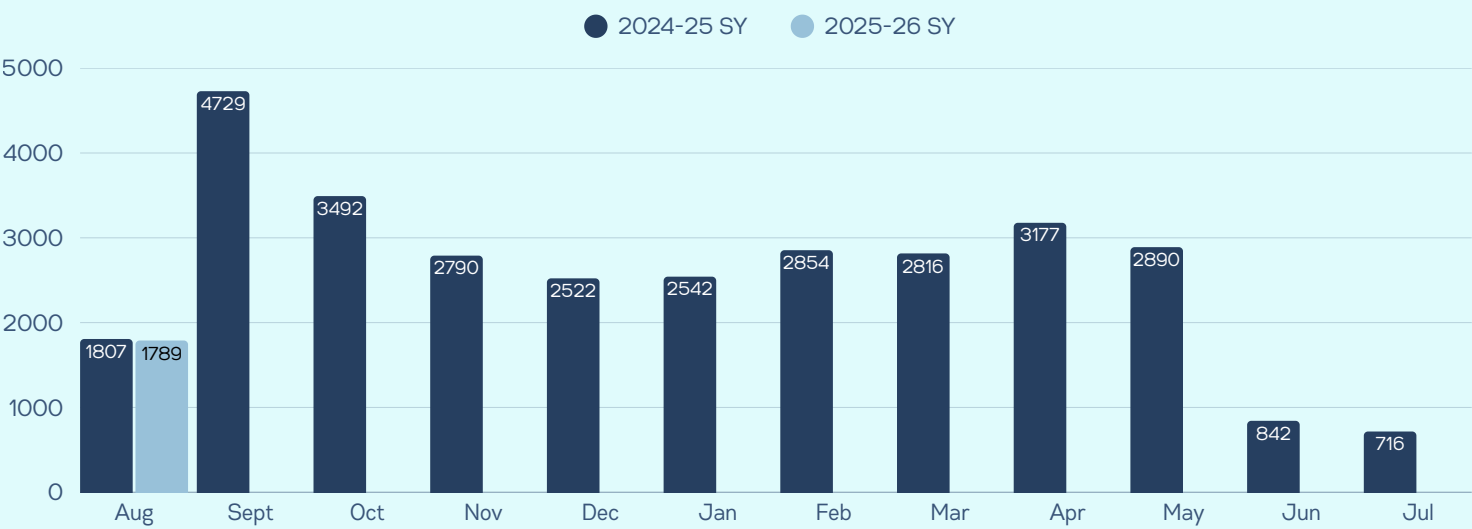

1,789 reports were received in August 2025. August is the first month of the reporting school year.

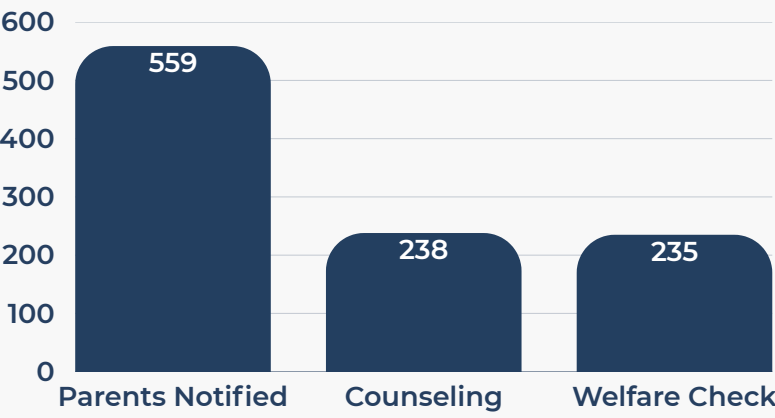

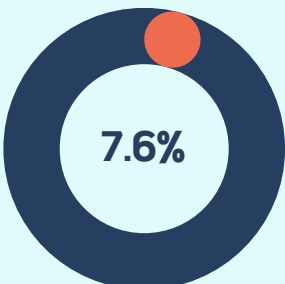

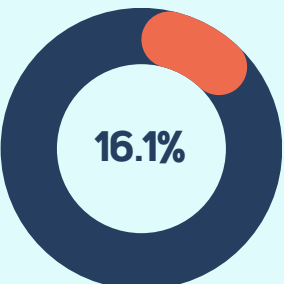

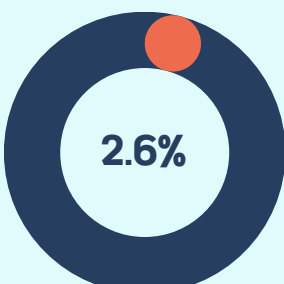

A person reported a student was bullying other students and making hurtful statements. School teams investigated, had a restorative conversation with the student, and then administered school disciplinary action.

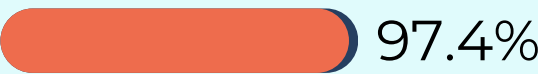


Duplicate Reports this SY



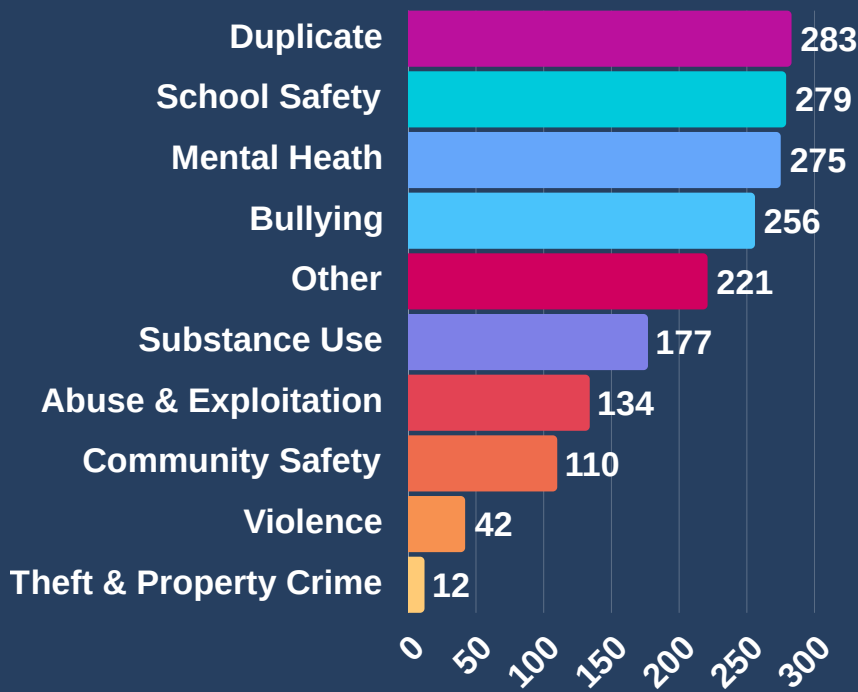
283 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

Valid reports during this SY



97.4% of reports received during the 25-26 school year, which began 8/1/25, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 1.2%, and false reports were 1.3%

August Reporting Themes



Report Example

A person reported a student was harassing another student via social media. Law enforcement conducted a welfare check and spoke with the student who made the posts and their parents. The student claimed ownership of the social media posts but stated they were joking and had no intention of harming their peer. School teams had a restorative conversation with the student, with attention to the seriousness of their posts. School teams will continue to monitor the student.
