3,846 reports were received in September 2025, and 5,635 reports were received to date for the current school year.





Report Example

A person reported seeing alcohol in a student's car and expressed concerns that the student was drinking and driving. School teams investigated and it was determined that the student had alcohol in their car. The student's parents were notified, and school disciplinary action was taken.

Duplicate Reports this SY




1,161 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

97.1% of reports received during the 25-26 school year, which began 8/1/25, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 1.8%, and false reports were 1.1%

September Reporting Themes



Report Example

A person reported that student A was blackmailing student B, threatening to report them to law enforcement if student B didn't do what they asked. Local teams contacted student A's parents and spoke with student A, who admitted to blackmailing their peer. Student A agreed to stop contacting them and counseling services were provided to student B.
