3,038 reports were received in November 2025, and 12,013 reports were received to date for the current school year.







### Duplicate Reports this SY




2,251 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

### Valid reports during this SY



97.9% of reports received during the 25-26 school year, which began 8/1/25, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 0.7%, and false reports were 1.4%
