#### **Request Summary:**

The Department of Labor and Employment (CDLE) is requesting a revision to the letternote for the Division of Labor's Long Bill line item titled "Program Costs". The request will add an additional funding source to the letternote to show that funds are available to pay for the line item from the Employment Verification Cash Fund. This request does not change the overall appropriation or the FTE.

This request allows the Department to offset some of its expenses for employment verification activities with fines collected from employers. Currently, there is funding available in the Employment Verification Cash Fund for these purposes, which the Department does not have an appropriation for. This Fund receives fines placed on employers for supplying falsified employment information or failing to submit employment information and is intended to offset the Department's costs for implementing employment verification activities.

HB06S-1017 requires Colorado employers to examine and affirm the legal work status of newly-hired employees. Duties include ensuring that copies of documents required by the I-9 employment eligibility verification form are retained, that an employer has not altered or falsified employee identification documents and that an employer has not knowingly hired an unauthorized alien. The Division of Labor is authorized to conduct random audits on employers to verify compliance. Additionally, documentation may be requested upon receipt of a credible complaint. In addition, one of the Department's primary focuses since enactment has been on educating the business community of the new program.

The Department began conducting these activities in 2007. Fine revenue, however, was not generated until June 2009 and has been slow to come into the Department. There is currently \$22,392 which can be used by the Department for employment verification activities

The Department would like to revise the letternote for the Division of Labor, Program Costs line item to read:

"Of this amount, it is estimated that \$1,148,664 shall be from the Employment Support Fund created in Section 8-77-109 (1), C.R.S. and it is estimated that \$42,392 shall be from the Employment Verification Cash Fund created in Section 8-2-122 (4), C.R.S."

#### **Anticipated Outcomes:**

The ability to utilize the Employment Verification Cash Fund would reduce the amount of funds currently being used from the Employment Support Fund to fund this activity. The Division can only expend as much as it collects in fines from the Employment Verification Fund per fiscal Year. At this time it is still unknown if the Division can collect enough fines to fully offset its annual expenses or meet its appropriated level. However, any revenue received will be used for its anticipated purpose.

#### **Assumptions for Calculations:**

Division's expenses for Employment The Verification activities are comingled within other employment expenses and are not tracked separately. The Division estimated administrative costs for this program to be \$202,864 in the fiscal note for this bill. The fund balance for this new cash fund cannot support this full estimate and will not support it for some time. \$22,392 is currently available though to offset these costs. It is difficult to estimate the number of fines issued and collected in a given year. Currently it is estimated that the Division will collect \$20,000 in fines for the 2011-12 FY. Therefore, it is requested that the letternote indicate that the amount available from the two funds are estimates.

#### **Consequences if not Funded:**

If this request is not approved the Division will be unable to offset the administrative costs with the fines collected which was the intent of the legislation.

#### **Cash Fund Projections:**

In Fiscal Year 2009-10, the cash balance of the fund was \$17,377. The Division had a cash balance at the end of FY 2010-11 of \$22,392.

# Current Statutory Authority or Needed Statutory Change:

C.R.S. 8-2-122 (2011) Employment verification requirements. (4) An employer who, with reckless disregard, fails to submit the documentation required by this section, or who, with reckless disregard, submits false or fraudulent documentation, shall be subject to a fine of not more than five thousand dollars for the first offense and not more than twenty-five thousand dollars for the second and any subsequent offense. The moneys collected pursuant to this subsection (4) shall be deposited in the employment verification cash fund, which is hereby created in the state treasury. The moneys in the fund shall be appropriated to the department of labor and employment for the purpose of implementing, administering, and enforcing this section. The moneys in the fund shall remain in the fund and not revert to the general fund or any other fund at the end of any fiscal year.

C.R.S. 8-77-109 (2011) Employment Support Fund - employment and training technology fund. (1) There is hereby established the employment support fund... (2) (a) Moneys collected pursuant to this section shall be credited by the state treasurer to the employment support fund, created in subsection (1) of this section. Moneys in the employment support fund shall be annually appropriated by the general assembly to the department of labor and employment: (II) (A) To fund labor standards, labor relations, and the Colorado works grievance procedure under the provisions of articles 1 to 6, 9, 10, 12, and 13 of this title and section 26-2-716 (3) (b), C.R.S.
