

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WORKERS' COMPENSATION COSTS IN COLORADO - 2009

INTRODUCTION

The Colorado Division of Workers' Compensation prepared this report to provide cost information on work-related injuries, occupational illnesses and fatalities based on information provided by insurers through the filing of a Final Pay Notice (FPN) during calendar year 2009. The information is intended to answer some of the most frequently asked questions about work-related injury costs.

This report is based on lost time and settled claims. A lost time claim is one in which the worker misses more than three days or three shifts of work because of the work-related injury or illness. The Division generally tracks only claims involving lost-time. Medical only claims are not included in this report unless final settlement concluded the claim. Final Payment Notices are required to be filed following a final admission, full and final settlement, or after a final order in which no issues remain to be addressed. Occasionally a claim may reopen after the FPN has been filed.

Not all claim costs are reported here. We generally receive indemnity, medical and certain "other" costs only. Indemnity costs include temporary or permanent disability payments, or fatal payments, or settlement amounts. Medical costs include amounts reported for hospital costs, doctor costs, vocational rehabilitation or vocational maintenance, and "other medical" costs. "Other" costs include legal costs, funeral benefits, penalties, and interest.

Costs are reported as received on the FPN except in a limited number of cases where obvious errors (typos) occurred. No adjustments were made to bring dollar costs to a constant year basis. Some costs presented in this report were also reported in prior calendar years' FPN reports. This factor is somewhat offset by the fact that some of these claims will incur and report future costs in a subsequent FPN.

The characteristics of the injury or illness are derived from the first report of injury¹ filed by the employer or worker, and in most cases, the report is not based on a medical diagnosis. The final pay notice is generally filed by the insurance carrier or third party adjuster.


In many exhibits we present both the mean and median cost to better capture the "typical case". A few very high cost claims can drive the mean cost up while the median will present a better picture of where the data is centered.

The distribution of FPN receipts (of all claim types) for 2009:

- 25% of FPNs were received in the year of injury.
- 50% of FPNs were received one year after the year of injury.
- 15% of FPNs were received two years after the year of injury.
- About 10% were received more than two years after the year of injury.




The lower number of claims filed compared to previous years has been attributed to a number of causes, which are beyond the scope of this report. Some of these include: the off shoring of manufacturing jobs, increasing reliance on technology, the economic downturn, & better safety programs.



State of Colorado








Claim Severity & Claim Cost - Calendar Years 2007-2009







Mean & Median Reported Cost by Body Part – Calendar Year 2009


