#### MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



DOLA Executive Director

The Colorado Department of Local Affairs in partnership with the Energy and Mineral Impact Advisory Committee annually distributes revenue derived from energy and mineral extraction statewide. These revenues come from State Severance Tax receipts and Federal Mineral Lease non-bonus payments.

Effective July 1, 2008, the General Assembly passed and Gov. Ritter signed SB08-218 and HB08-1083, which authorized this current method and formula to determine the direct distribution of energy impact dollars from the severance tax, as well as federal mineral

leases. The legislation also established this Biennial Report to the General Assembly on the Direct Distribution.

The following factors are considered in the formulaic distribution: permits, production, employee residence, as well as, for sub-county distribution, population and highway user miles (HUTF). The 2012 distribution came to a total of \$26,687,870 for Severance Tax and \$35,252,380 for Federal Mineral Lease Revenue. With lower natural gas prices along with more property tax credits taken, the amount in Severance Tax Direct Distribution going to local communities in 2013 was \$22,297,004. The total for the Federal Mineral Lease Revenue Direct Distribution to counties, federal mineral lease districts, municipalities and school districts was \$25,107,247. Lower commodity prices, Federal Sequestration and coal producers renegotiating royalty rates with the Bureau of Land Management contributed to the decline in the Federal Mineral Lease distribution amount from 2012 to 2013.

The dollars distributed through this program are vital to helping communities provide services to Colorado citizens. We are committed to working with our local government and association partners and legislators in advocating for the preservation of this critically important source of funding.

#### INTRODUCTION

This biennial report evaluates the effectiveness of the allocation and distribution of moneys from the Severance Tax Local Impact Fund to counties and municipalities impacted by mineral and mineral fuel development. The report is submitted to the General Assembly pursuant to C.R.S. 39-29-110(1)(c)(VI). The report also evaluates the direct distribution of federal mineral lease (FML) moneys from the Local Government Impact Fund.

#### BACKGROUND

#### Severance Tax Direct Distribution

HB08-1083 made significant changes to the state severance tax direct distribution formula and was based on recommendations by the 2007 Interim Committee on Severance Tax and Federal Mineral Lease Revenue Allocation through collaboration with stakeholders and the Department of Local Affairs (Department). This legislation also altered the composition and role of the Energy and Mineral Impact Assistance Advisory Committee and changed the guidelines, reporting and accountability of the distribution of state grants by the Department.

Prior to the 2009 direct distribution, a count of energy industry employees was the sole factor used to determine the distribution. In order to better measure the social or economic impacts of energy and mineral development, processing, or energy conversion of minerals and mineral fuels on communities, the 2008 legislation refined the industry employee resident count and added other impact measure factors including mining and well permits, mineral production, population and road miles to the formula. The moneys are first allocated by factor into county pools and these pools are then distributed to the municipalities and county government within each county. 
#### Federal Mineral Lease Receipts Direct Distribution

SB08-218 added new factors to the formulaic distribution of non-bonus FML revenues. Revenue generated under the Federal Mineral Leasing Act within each county, population, and road miles were added to the formula. Prior to 2009, the count of industry employee residents conducted for the severance tax direct distribution was the sole metric used to determine the FML distribution. Like the severance tax direct distribution, the moneys are first allocated into county pools and then distributed to the municipalities and county government or school district within each county. #### Distribution Trends

Due to high commodity prices, primarily oil and natural gas, the 2009 direct distributions of both severance tax proceeds and federal mineral lease revenue were significantly higher than previous

years. As a result of property tax credits taken and lower commodity prices, the distributions have returned to a lower level since then.



Total Direct Distribution to Counties and Municipalities 2009-2013


#### SEVERANCE TAX DIRECT DISTRIBUTION

Thirty percent of the severance tax revenue credited to the Local Impact Fund from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012 resulted in the total distribution of \$26,687,869.76 to 327 counties and municipalities. For the 2013 state fiscal year, \$22,297,004.05 was distributed to 330 counties and municipalities. 
Moneys were first allocated into "county pools" based on each county's proportion of industry employee residents, mining and well permits and mineral production compared to the totals statewide. CRS 39-29-110(1)(c)(II)(B) directs each factor to be weighed 30% and the Executive Director, in consultation with the Energy and Mineral Impact Assistance Advisory Committee, determine the assignment of the remaining 10%. The county pool factors were weighed in 2012 and 2013 as follows:



The Department then distributed each county pool to the county government and each municipality therein based on the unincorporated or municipal proportions of employee residents, population, and road miles compared to the total in the county. Statute directs the Executive Director, in consultation with the Energy and Mineral Impact Advisory Committee, to set the weights of these factors statewide. The Executive Director set the factor weights as follows:

The Executive Director may accept a memorandum of understanding (MOU) from the county and all municipalities therein requesting an alternative distribution and/or factor weights for a "subcounty" pool. The Department did not receive any MOUs for the 2012 or 2013 distributions.

#### FEDERAL MINERAL LEASE RECEIPTS DIRECT DISTRIBUTION


#### County and Municipal Direct Distribution


Fifty percent of the federal mineral lease revenue credited to the Local Government Mineral Impact Fund from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012 resulted in the total distribution of \$32,490,673.08 to 328 counties (or federal mineral lease districts) and municipalities. For the 2013 state fiscal year, \$23,140,319.93 was distributed to 331 counties and municipalities. See <a href="Exhibit E">Exhibit E</a> for the county pools and individual amounts of the sub county payments to counties and municipalities.

Moneys were first allocated into "county pools" based on each county's proportion of resident industry employees and federal mineral lease revenues generated compared to the totals statewide. CRS 34-63-102(5.4)(c)(III) specifies the employee residence report factor cannot be weighted more than 35%. The county pool factors were weighed by the Executive Director, in consultation with the Energy and Mineral Impact Advisory Committee as follows:

The Department is then directed to distribute each county pool to the county government and each municipality therein based on the unincorporated or municipal proportion of employee residents, population and road miles compared to the total in the county. Statute directs the Executive Director, in consultation with the Energy and Mineral Impact Advisory Committee, to set the weights of these factors statewide. The Executive Director set the factor weights as follows:

Like the severance tax distribution, the Executive Director may accept a memorandum of understanding (MOU) from the county and all municipalities therein requesting an alternative distribution and/or factor weights for a "subcounty" pool. The Department did not receive any MOUs for the 2012 or 2013 federal mineral lease distributions.

#### Federal Mineral Lease Districts

As the result of HB11-1218, counties may choose to create a federal mineral lease district for the purpose of re-directing federal mineral lease distribution payments in an effort to maximize the amount of PILT funding counties receive from the U.S. Department of Interior. This legislation did not change the direct distribution formula, but enables a county to instead direct the payment otherwise calculated for the county government to its federal mineral lease district.

For the 2013 Direct Distribution, four counties had FML distributions directed to federal mineral lease districts: Garfield, Mesa, Park and Weld. Direct Distribution payment details contained in <a href="Exhibit E">Exhibit E</a> include the payments to these districts. #### School District Direct Distribution

The school district distribution occurs in similar fashion to the county/municipal distribution. Statute directs the Department to calculate county pools based on the same weights set by the Executive Director for the county/municipal distribution. Each county pool is then distributed based on the proportion of each school district's pupil count to the total county pupil count. 
For 2012, \$2,761,707.20 was distributed to 175 school districts; \$1,966,927.19 was distributed to 177 school districts in 2013. See Exhibit F for details on the 2012 and 2013 payments to school districts.

#### **EFFECTIVENESS**

The statutory severance tax and federal mineral lease direct distribution formulas help provide an equitable system for allocating money to communities socially or economically impacted by energy and mineral development, processing, or energy conversion of minerals and mineral fuels. The combination of various measures of impact helps return severance tax and federal mineral lease revenues to the communities experiencing industry impacts. As illustrated by the maps of the factors and the distributions, communities in significantly impacted areas are receiving the greatest proportion of the distribution.

Both the severance tax and federal mineral lease statutory formulas allow for flexibility on a year by year basis for the continued pursuit of effective distribution. The Executive Director, in consultation with the Energy and Mineral Impact Advisory Committee, has discretion to adjust the weights of the factors in the formula each year. The Department continually evaluates these factors and solicits feedback from the Advisory Committee, local government recipients and the Mineral Production Employee Residence Report Oversight Committee. For the 2012 and 2013 distributions, these groups have supported the Department's implementation of statute and administration of the Direct Distribution Program. Furthermore, while each county and its municipalities have the ability to locally determine the most effective allocation of their county pool within their

community by means of an MOU, none exercised this option and instead elected to use the Department's statewide factors and weights.


