

The Colorado Main Street team has continued the efforts to strengthen and grow the program to meet community needs.

INVESTED DIRECTLY IN COMMUNITIES to help them grow their capacity and implement priority projects.

- Over \$48K in scholarships
- Nearly \$82K in mini-grants, matched with over \$107K in local dollars
- More than \$330K in consultant services

PROVIDED CONSTANT SUPPORT through over 40 trainings which reached almost 1,000 participants. The team also provided technical assistance, visits, consultations and more.

MAINTAINED GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT to support more Colorado communities in their downtown revitalization efforts.
