Short Summary of Request:The Department requests to move the 1.0 FTE and associated General Fund from the (5)
Civil Air Patrol, Personal Services line item into the (1) Executive Director and Army
National Guard, Personal Services line item. The Department also requests to merge the
Civil Air Patrol Operating Expenses and Aircraft Maintenance lines into a new line titled
Civil Air Patrol Operations.

This request is also to combine the four lines within the (4) Federal Funded Programs Long Bill Group into one new line titled Federal Funded Programs Operations. The Civil Air Patrol Long Bill Group contains three line item appropriations consisting of Personal Services including 1.0 FTE, Operating Expenses, and Aircraft Maintenance. Prior to the FY 2008-09 Long Bill (H.B. 08-1375) these line items were bottom line funded which allowed the Division flexibility in allocating funds between the line items to meet the needs of the Civil Air Patrol.

Federal Funded Programs

The Federal Funded Programs represent the total federal funds that contribute to the operations and maintenance of the Colorado National Guard. These funds do not flow through the State financial system and are reported in the Long Bill for informational purposes only.

General Description of Request:

Civil Air Patrol

The Department requests two changes to the Civil Air Patrol Long Bill Group. The first is to move the 1.0 FTE and associated General Fund from the Personal Services line and into the Executive Director's Office and Army National Guard Personal Services Line. With only one FTE in the current Civil Air Patrol Personal Services Line it is impossible to achieve vacancy savings that allow for unexpected payouts such as sick and annual leave. By merging the FTE into the Executive Director's Office and Army National Guard Personal Services line, the Department will have greater flexibility to manage salary and payout costs for this 1.0 FTE.

The second change to the Civil Air Patrol Long Bill Group is to combine the Operating Expenses and Aircraft Maintenance lines into one new line titled Civil Air Patrol Operating. This move would allow the Division flexibility between general administration of the Civil Air Patrol and the need to maintain aircraft. See table 1 for details.

Federal Funded Programs

The Department request to merge this Long Bill Group into one new line is for efficiency. Each year, the Department must enter an Appropriations Document into the State financial system for each line item funded within the Long Bill. Currently, the Department must enter and validate four separate documents, route them to the State Controllers Office for approval, then restrict all four funding levels within the documents since the funds never flow through the State accounting system. However, by merging these lines into one new line, only one Appropriations Document would be needed which would cover all four Long Bill line items. This method would streamline the process of "booking" the Long Bill, allowing the Department and the State Controllers Office to focus on other high priority appropriations. See table 2 for details.

Consequences if Not Funded:

Civil Air Patrol

The Division will manage as is, with no ability to manage funds between line items within the Long Bill Group. Unforeseen personal services expenses will be funded using POTS allocations. However, with Pay for Performance and Salary Survey remaining unfunded, it will be increasingly difficult to cover these expenses. The Department's requirements for aircraft maintenance and operations expenses will also be impacted as some requirements may go unfunded and postponed into the next fiscal year when funds become available in those respective line items.

The Department and State Controllers Office will continue to have to process four separate Appropriations Documents to establish and restrict the Long Bill funding.

	This request will not require an increase to any fund source. The benefit to the division is the ability to manage for the need instead of managing to the limited appropriations. This flexibility will provide the ability to address current needs in operating and aircraft maintenance whereas currently the Division must postpone operations and aircraft maintenance needs which could result in higher costs in the out years.
	Federal Funded Programs
	The amounts in this Long Bill Group do not flow through the State accounting system therefore there is no expenditure of funds by the State. However, there is a level of effort by the Department and State Controllers Office to input and process Appropriation Documents into the accounting system. Reducing the number of entries from four to one
