

► **LICENSE APPLICATIONS ARE NOW PAPERLESS:** All license applications, for all species, must now be completed online using the integrated system, cpw.state.co.us/CPWshop, or by phone at 1-800-244-5613. *Paper applications are no longer available.*

► **LICENSE FEES NO LONGER DUE AT THE TIME YOU SUBMIT YOUR DRAW APPLICATION:** Instead of paying all of the fees up front when applying, you will now **ONLY** pay the \$3 application processing fee, *per species*. If you are 18-64, you will need a 2018 Habitat Stamp (\$10); one will be automatically added to your application if you haven't purchased one already. You will be charged the license price and Wildlife Education and Search-and-Rescue fees **ONLY** if you receive a license from the draw. The preference point fee will still be charged if you are unsuccessful in the draw and do not meet the exemption criteria (see pages 2 and 18). *You'll need to enter credit card information in your account, to be kept on file for draw license and preference point payments.*

► **MANDATORY CHRONIC WASTING DISEASE (CWD) TESTING IN SELECT GMUs:** In 2018, CPW will require mandatory submission of CWD test samples (heads) from all buck deer harvested during rifle seasons from select GMUs. Hunters that harvest a buck deer in the specified hunt codes (pages 19-29) will be required to submit their deer head to a CPW submission site for testing (any regional or area office, listed at left). There will be no charge for mandatory testing. Get more information about where and how to submit a CWD sample at cpw.state.co.us/CWD.

SPECIAL PERMITS

HUNTERS WITH DISABILITIES

Accommodation permits are available to hunters with disabilities.

1. Hunters must have a temporary or permanent disability that significantly impairs major life functions and the ability to hunt. Shooting from public roads is not allowed. All wildlife laws must be observed.
2. Permits from other states are not honored here.
3. Apply for a permit at least 30 days before hunting. Applications are available at CPW locations, on the website or call 303-297-1192.

HUNTERS WITH MOBILITY IMPAIRMENTS

1. Some doe deer, cow elk and doe pronghorn licenses are offered to hunters with mobility impairments. Hunters must have a mobility impairment resulting from permanent medical conditions, making it physically impossible to hunt without someone else's help. Evidence includes, but is not limited to, prescribed equipment such as a wheelchair, shoulder or arm crutches, walker or two canes.
2. Applications are available at CPW locations and must be mailed with license fees to CPW, Limited License, 6060 Broadway, Denver, CO 80216. Applications accepted from the Monday after the Parks and Wildlife Commission meeting in May through the end of rifle seasons. Licenses are first-come, first-served until unit and program caps are reached.



WHAT ARE OVER-THE-COUNTER LICENSES? HOW DO YOU GET ONE?



Archery, muzzleloading and some rifle bear licenses are sold over the counter with a cap on the number of licenses available. These are either-sex licenses.

These licenses are **NOT** available through the draw. If you apply for these hunt codes in the draw, your application will be disqualified. **NOTE:** to participate in the over-the-counter with caps rifle bear season, a hunter must also hold a deer or elk license that overlaps with that rifle bear tag by at least one day of the season. These licenses can be purchased at authorized sales agents, by phone and online through **OCT. 13**. Then, they are **only** available at CPW offices.

“with caps” means there are a preset number of these licenses available on a first-come, first-served basis starting at **9 A.M. AUG 9**. Get them at CPW locations, authorized sales agents, via telephone at 1-800-244-5613 or online at cpw.state.co.us/CPWshop.

The Parks and Wildlife Commission sets the number of “with cap” licenses in May.
