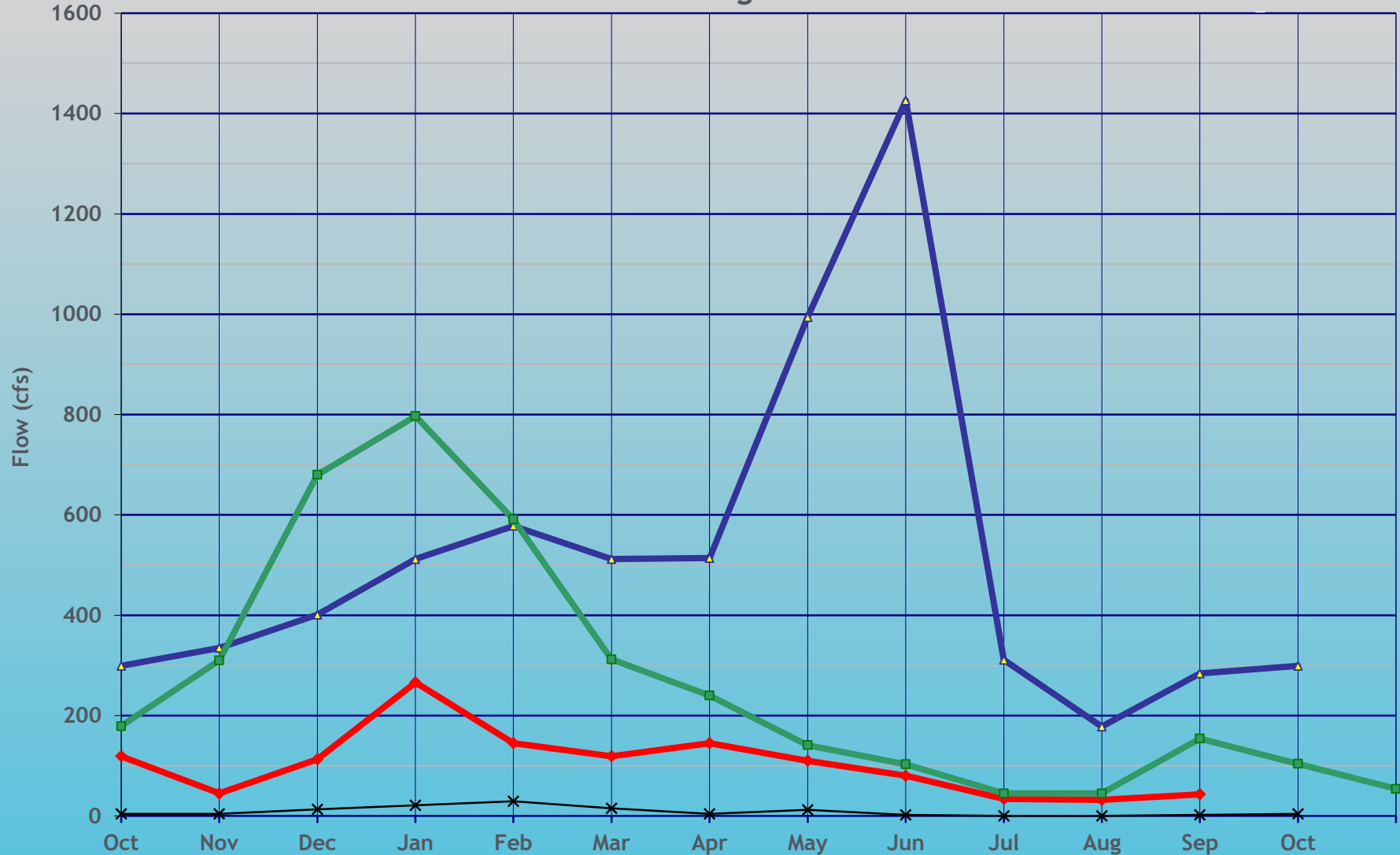

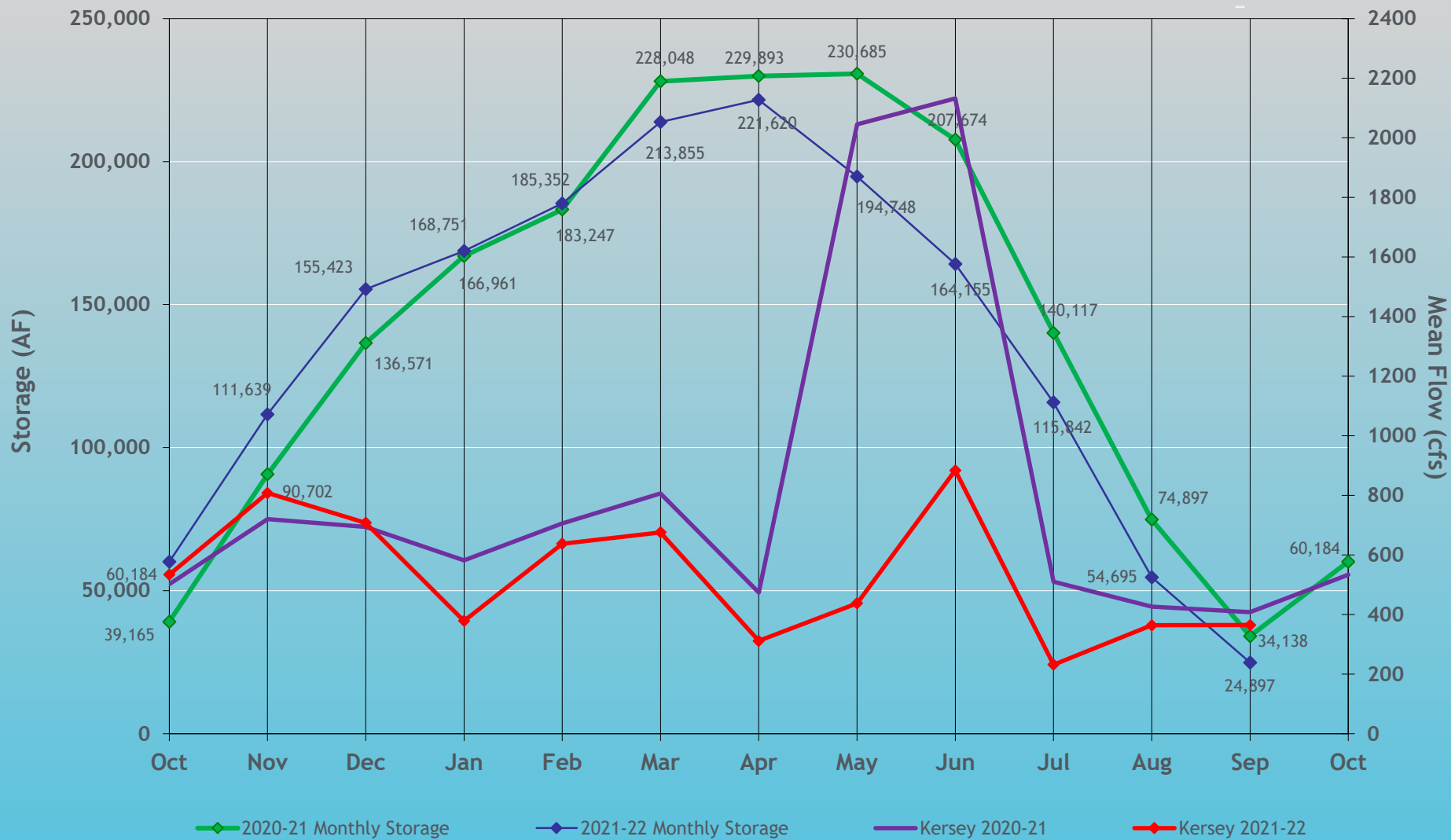

Reservoir Storage below Kersey

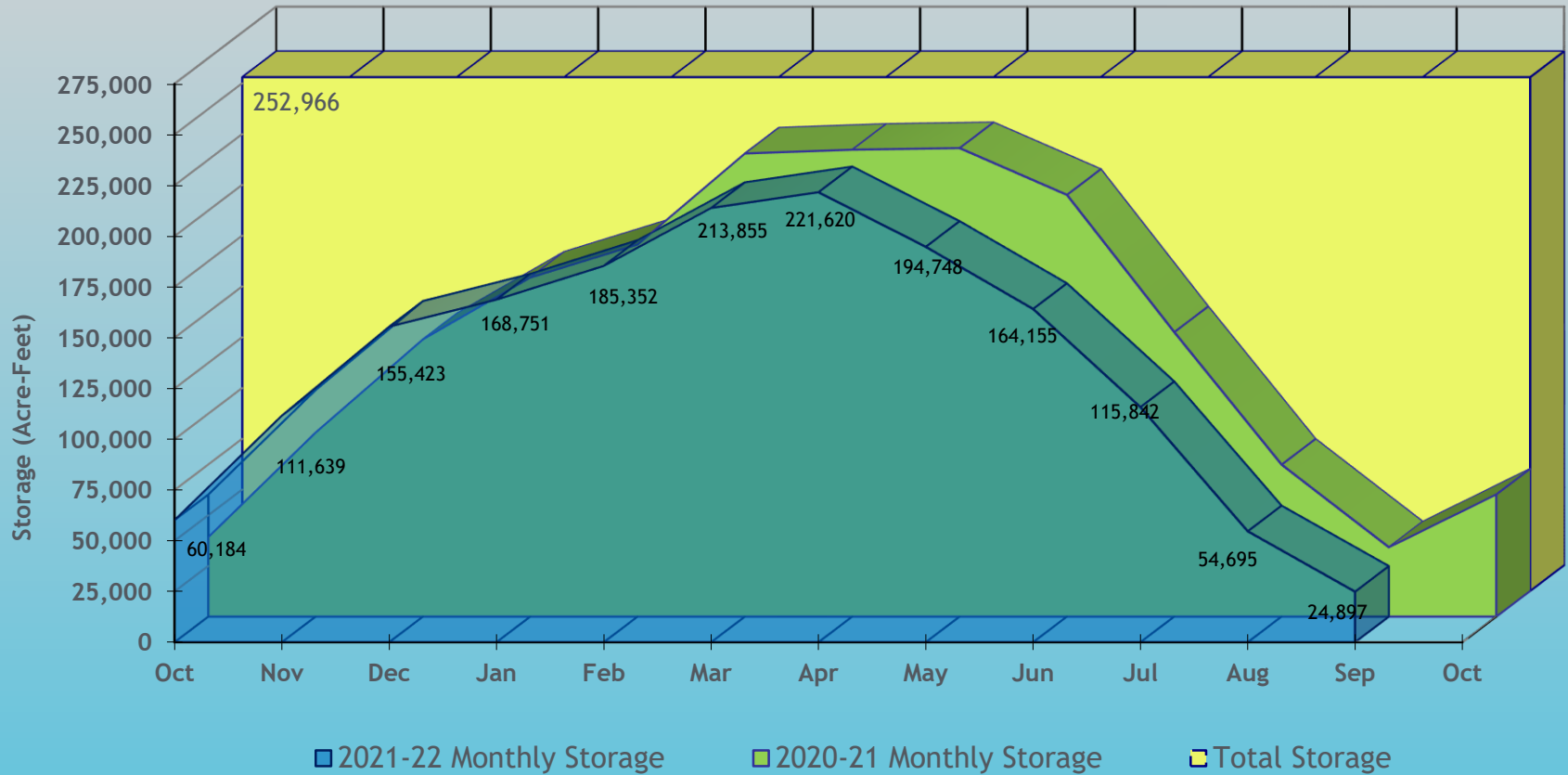

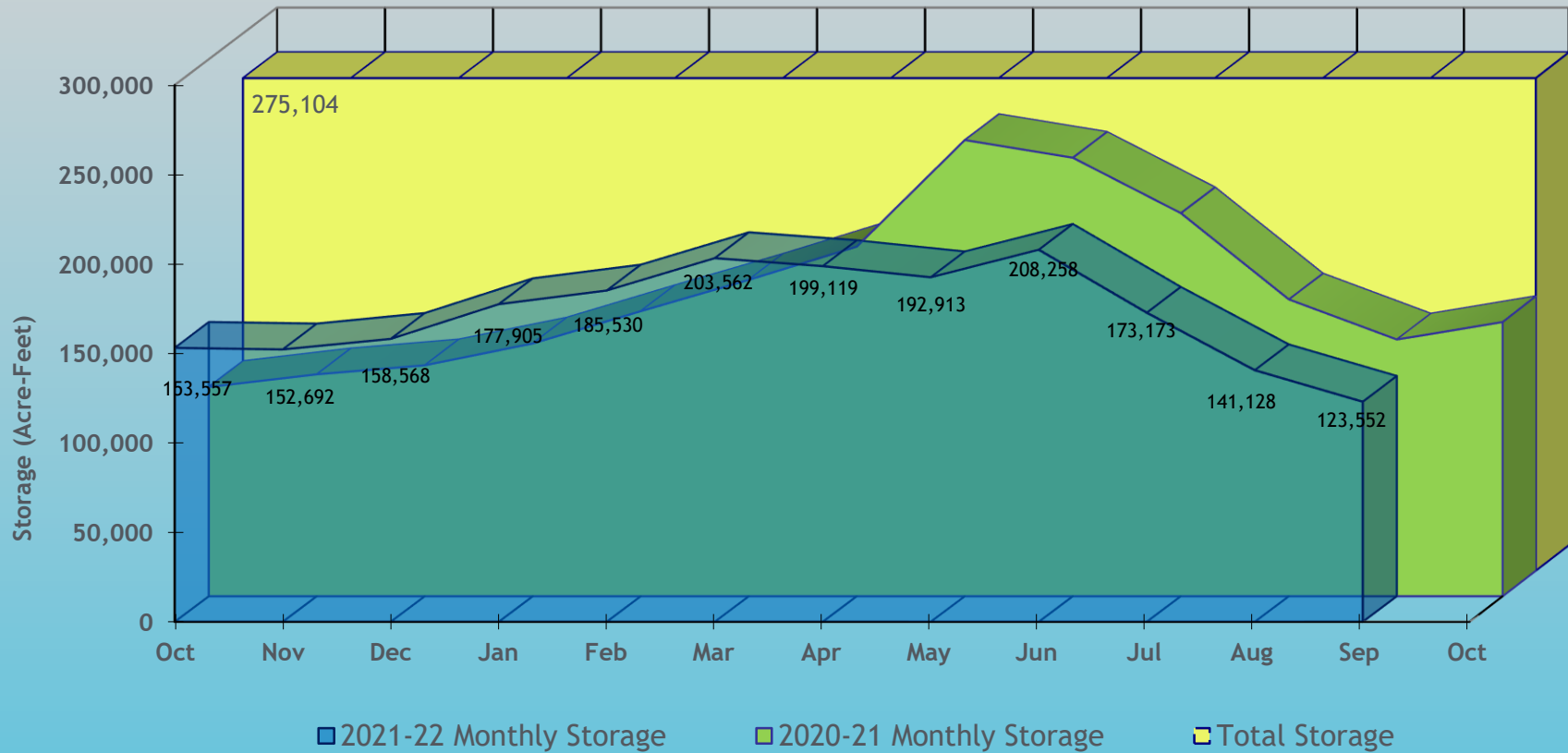


South Platte Reservoir Storage below Kersey*

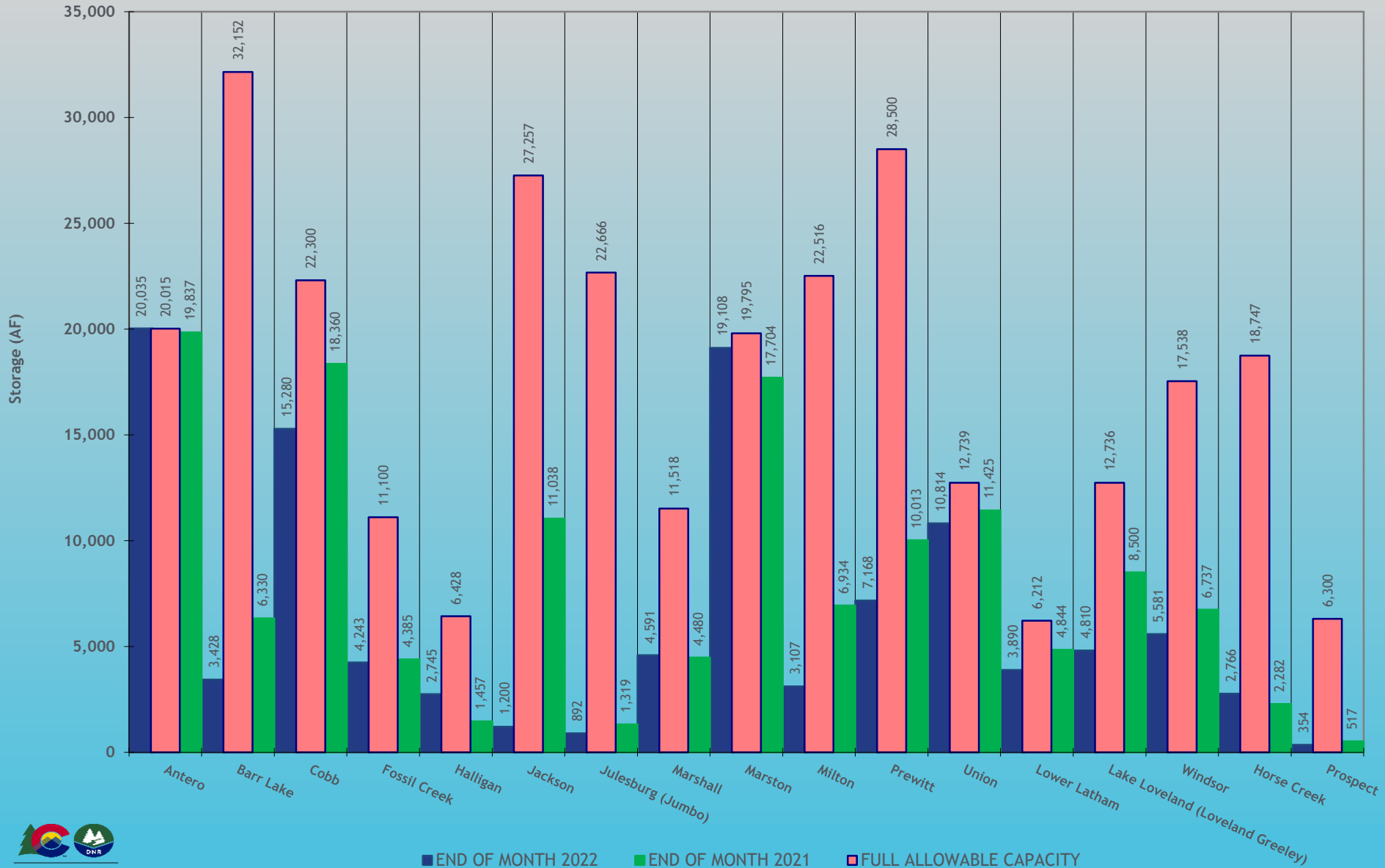
South Platte Reservoir Storage above Kersey*

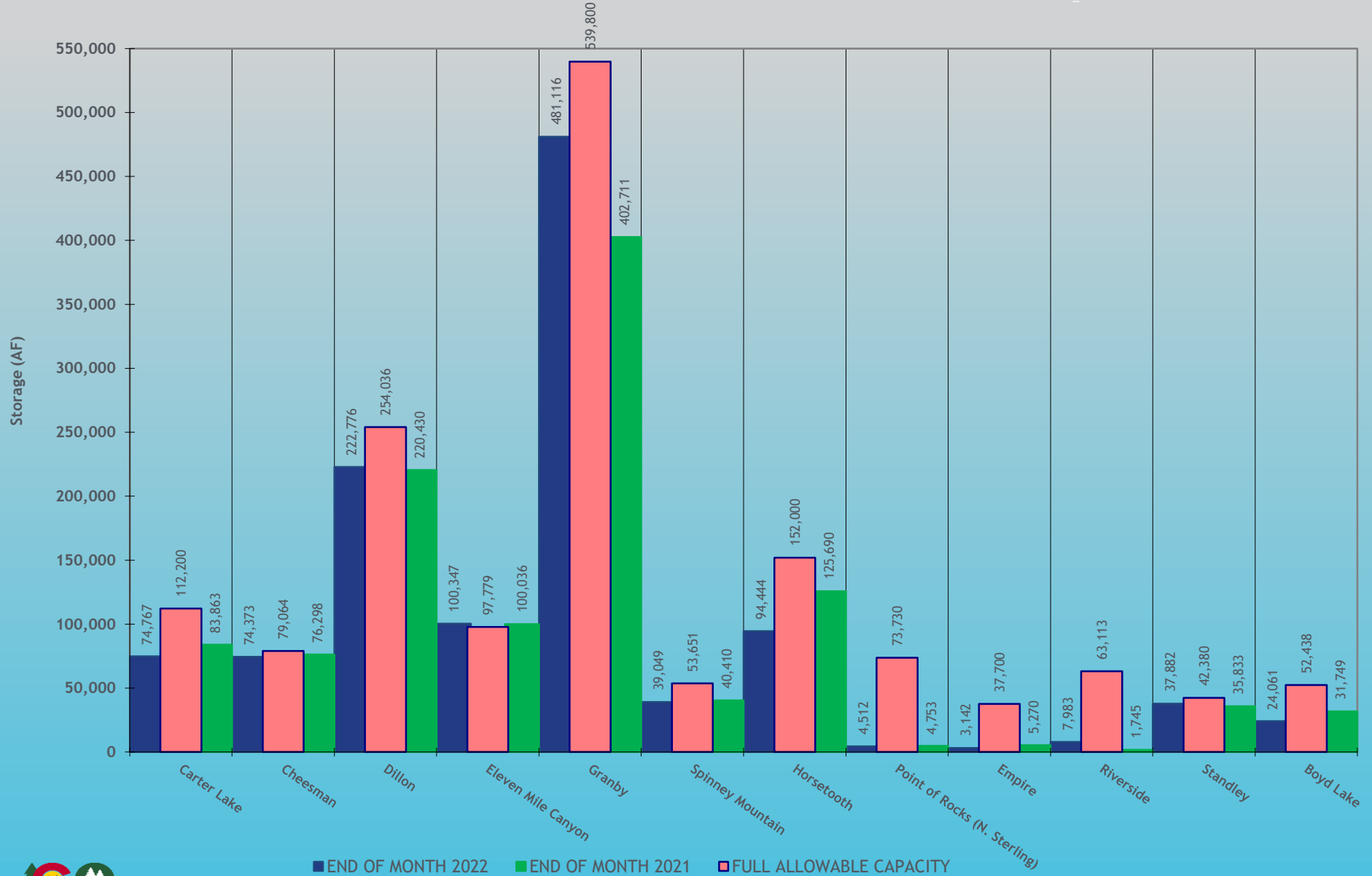


September Reservoir Change in Storage IY2021 versus IY2022

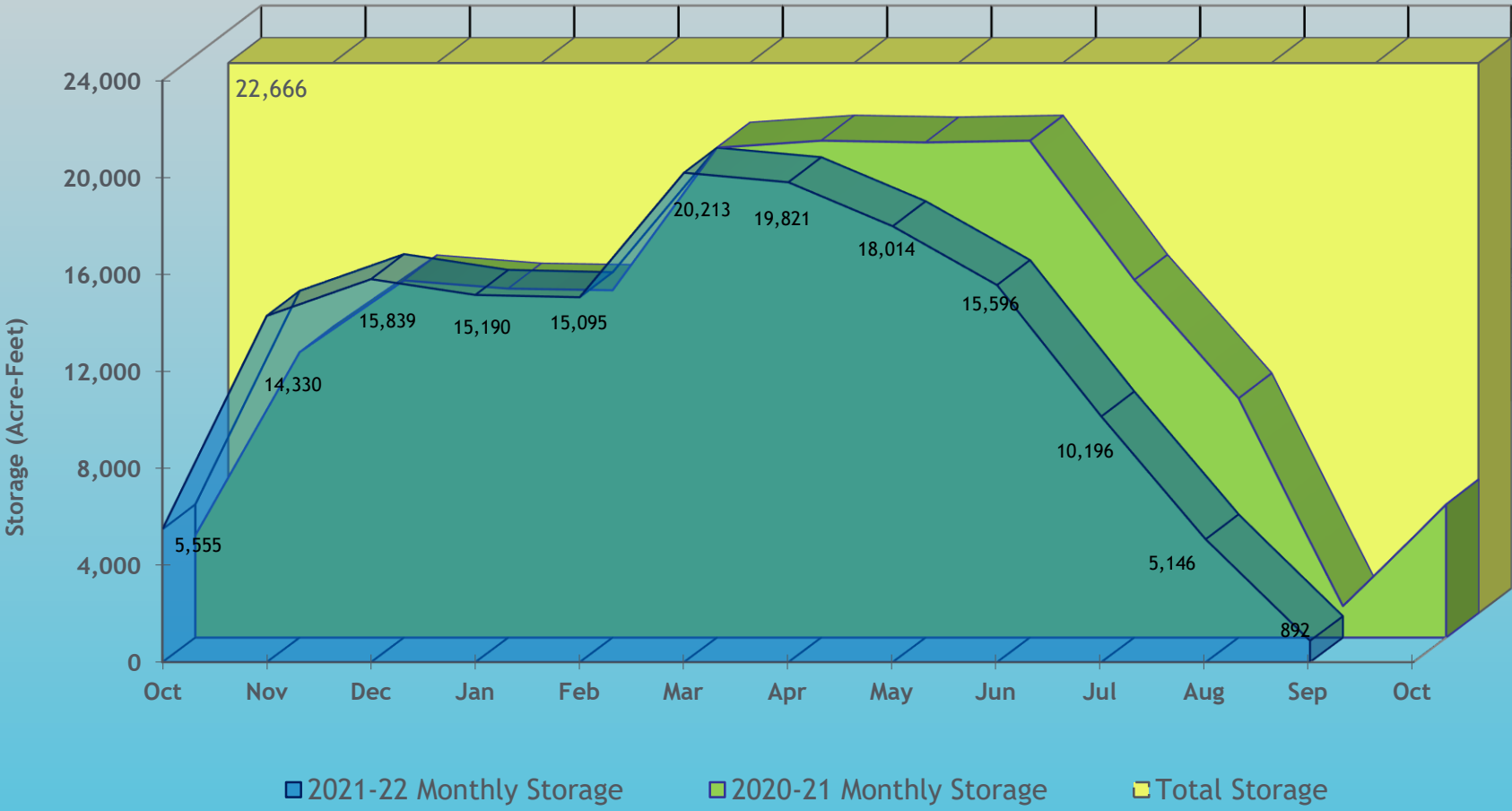
September Reservoir Change in Storage IY2021 versus IY2022



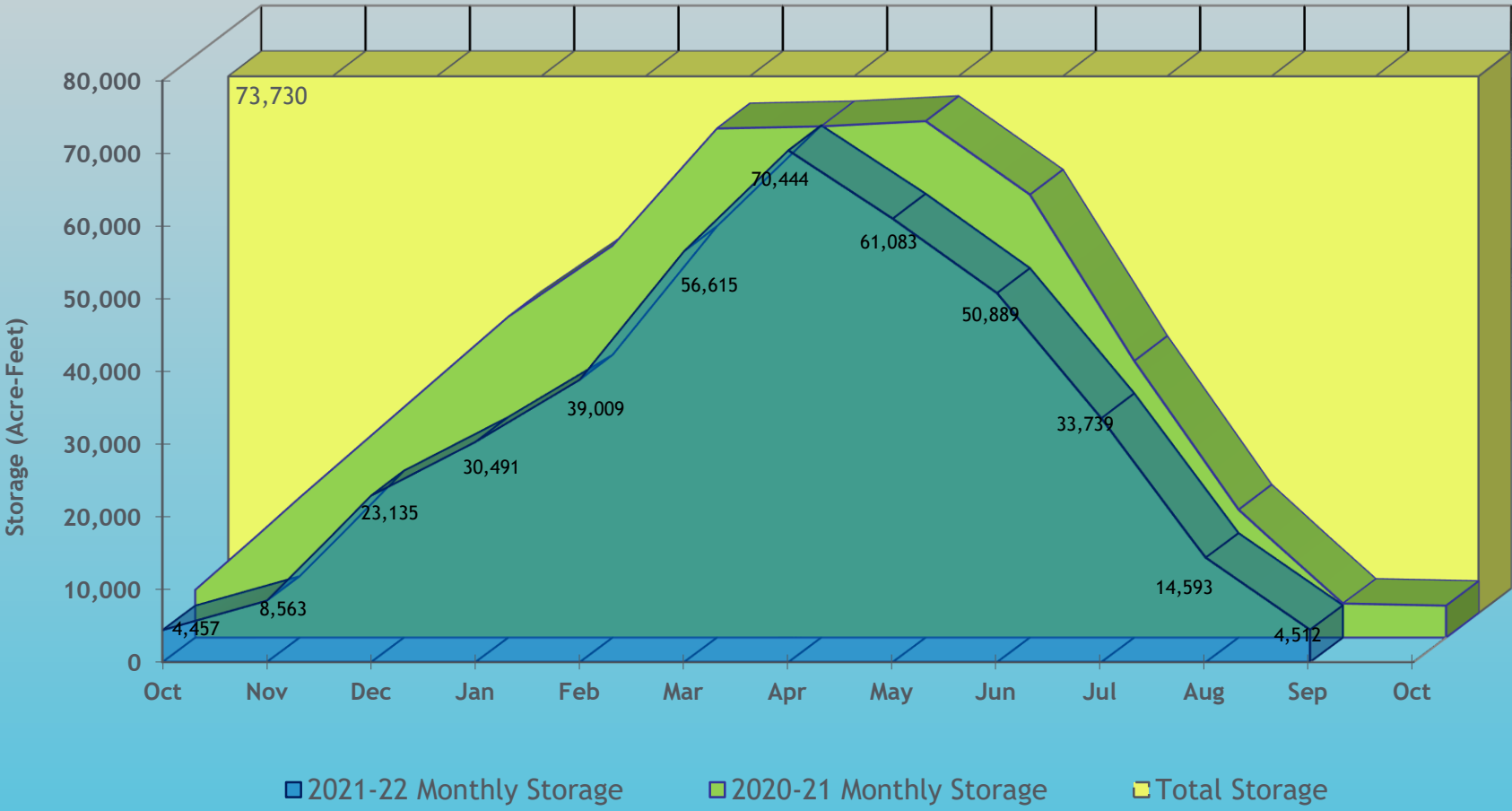

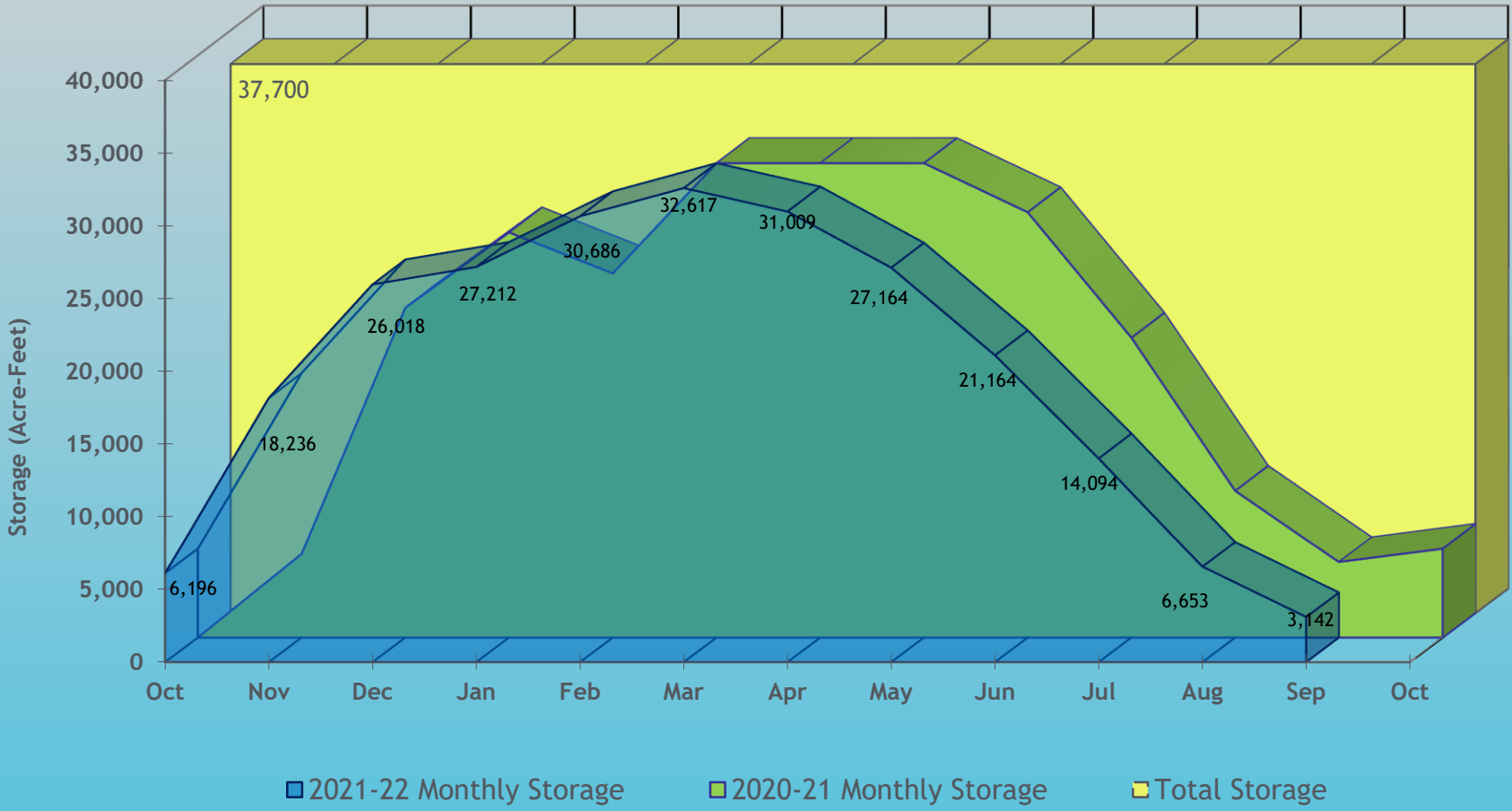

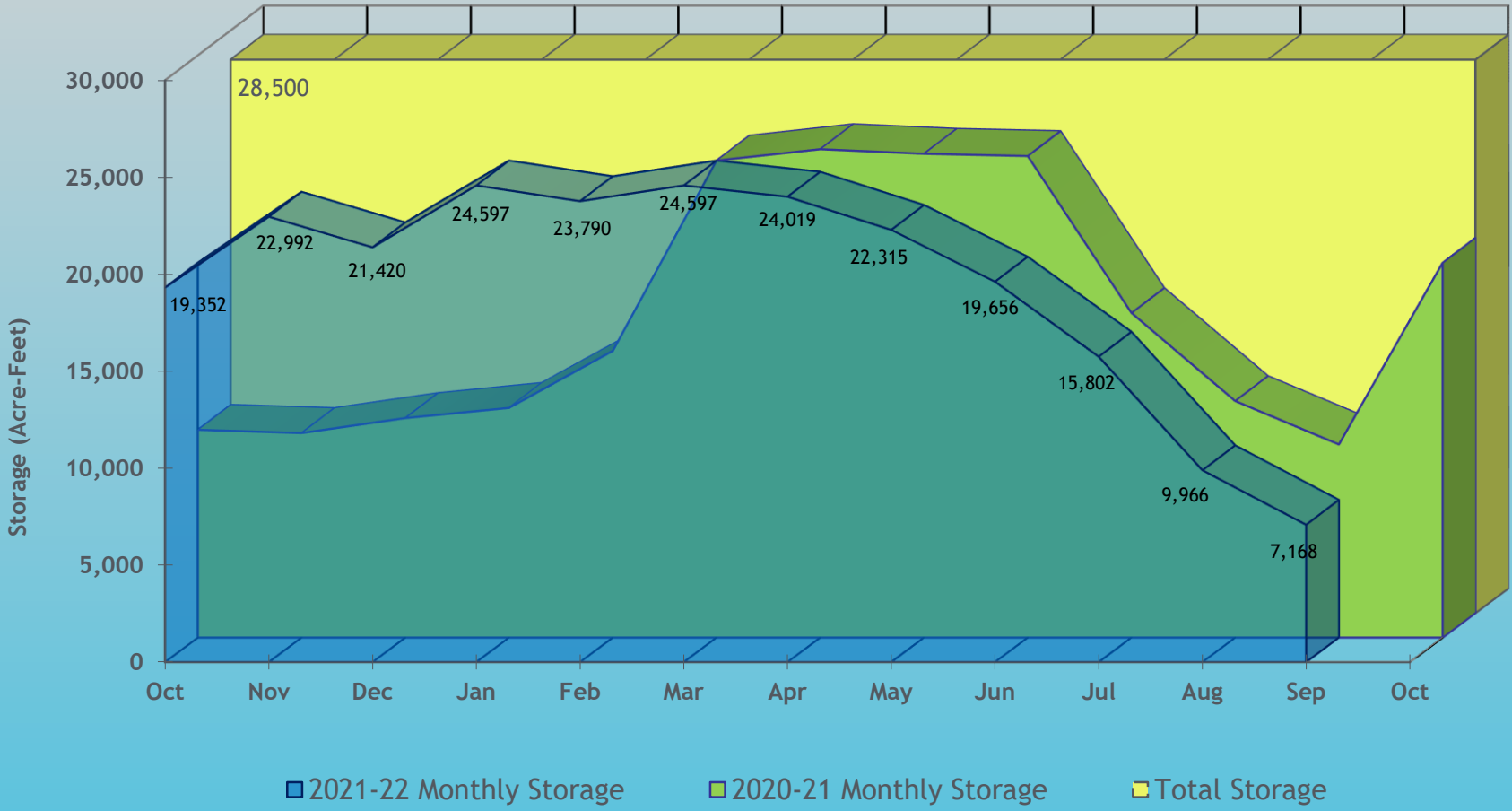
