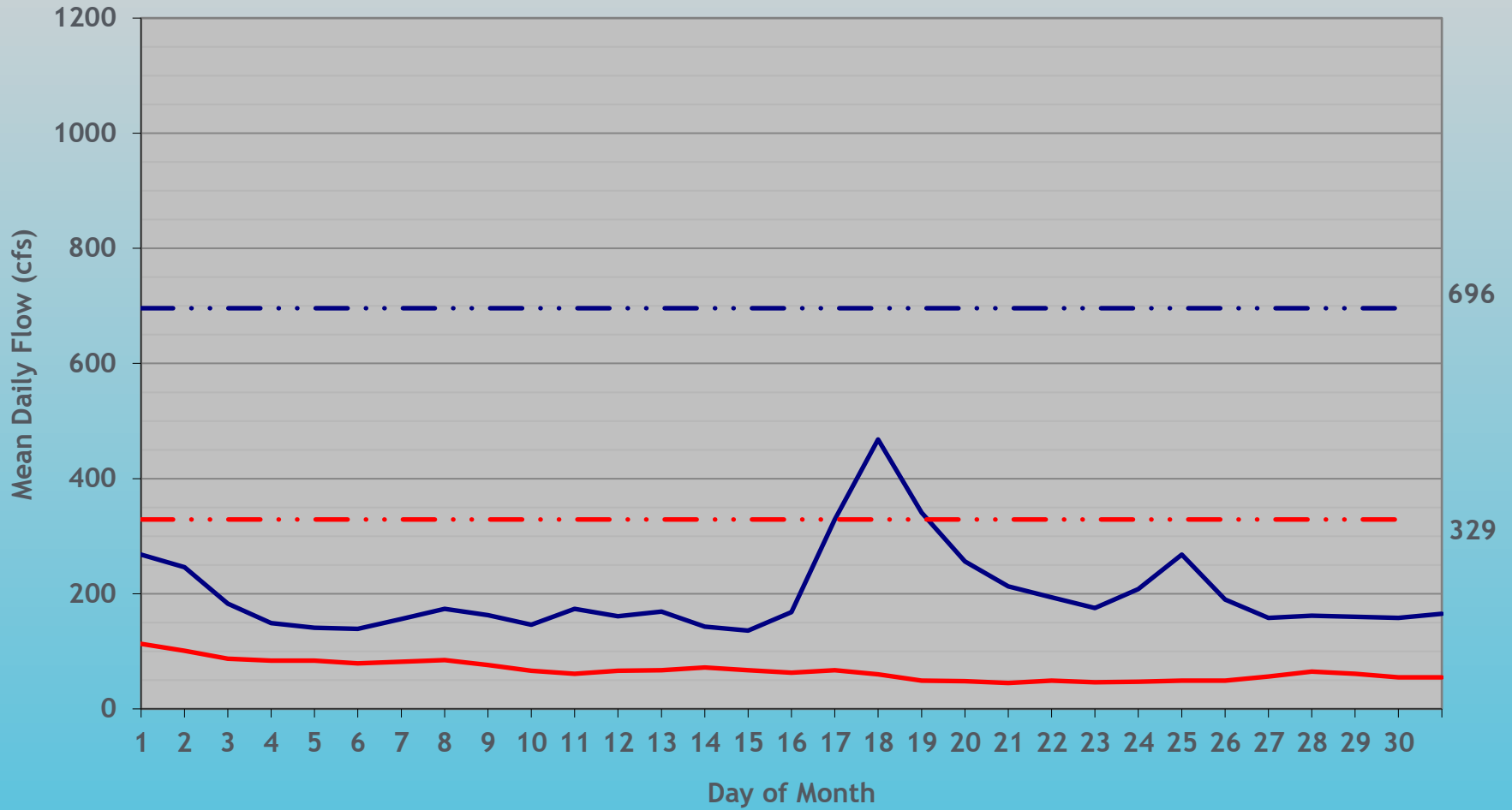

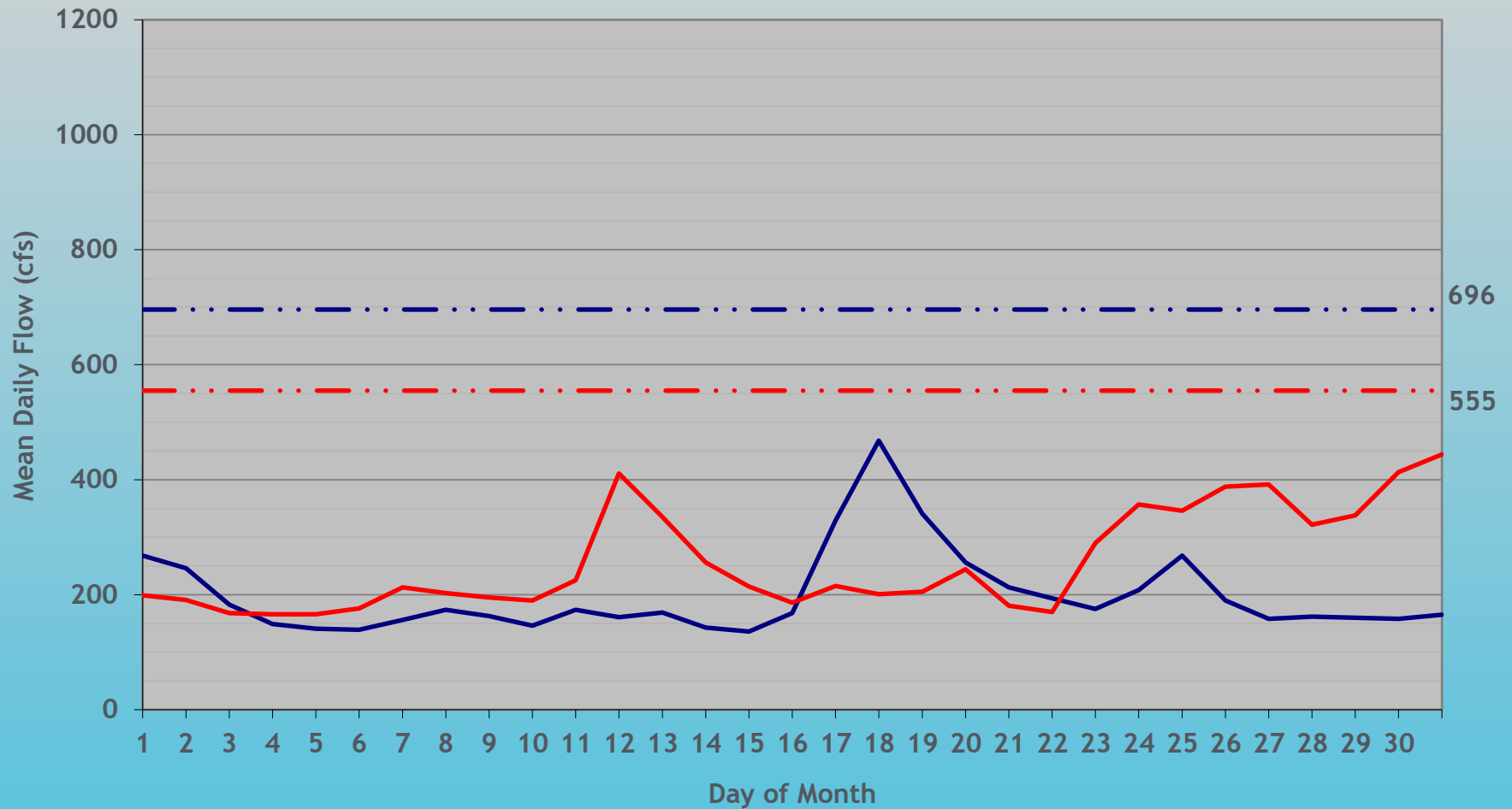

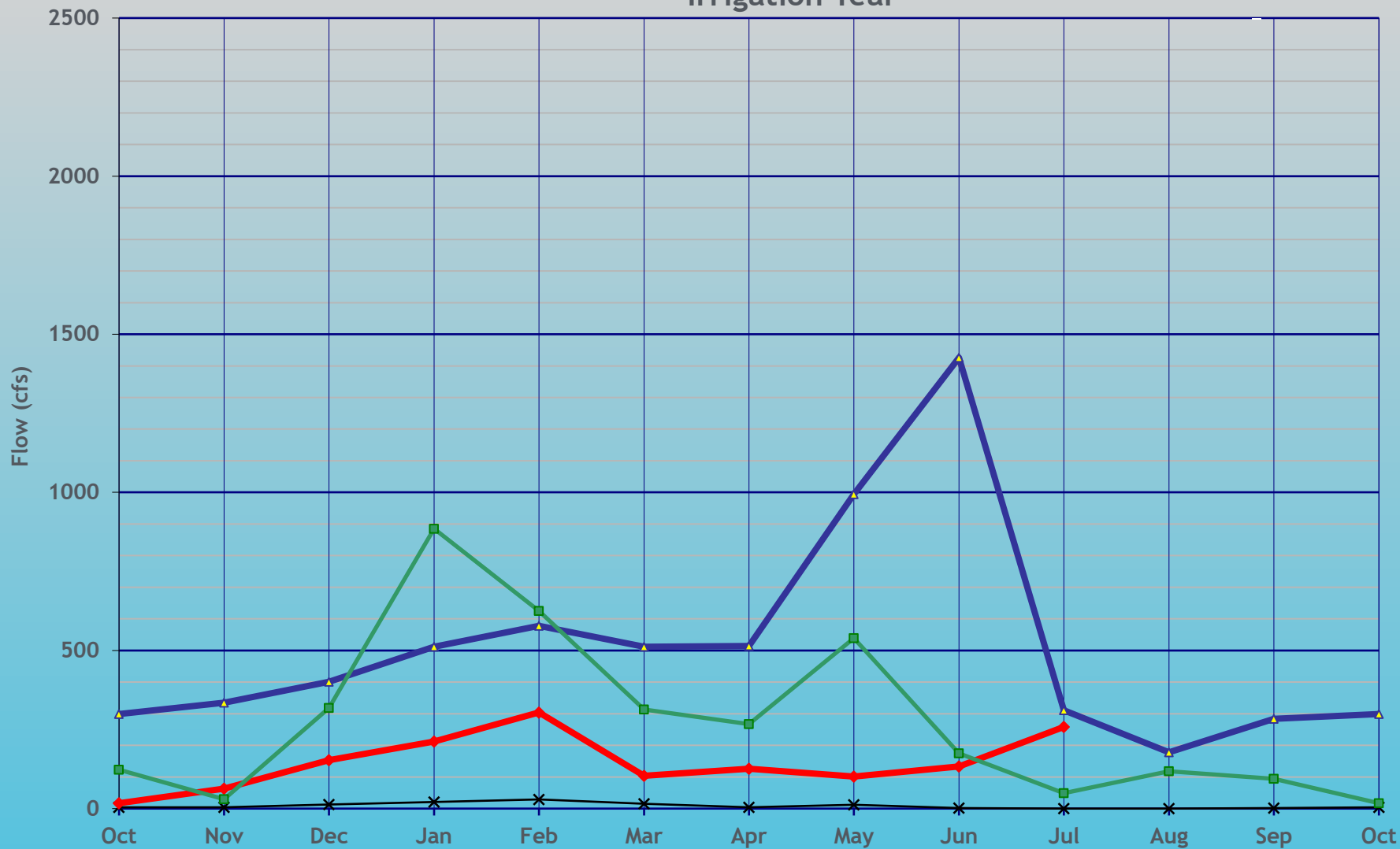

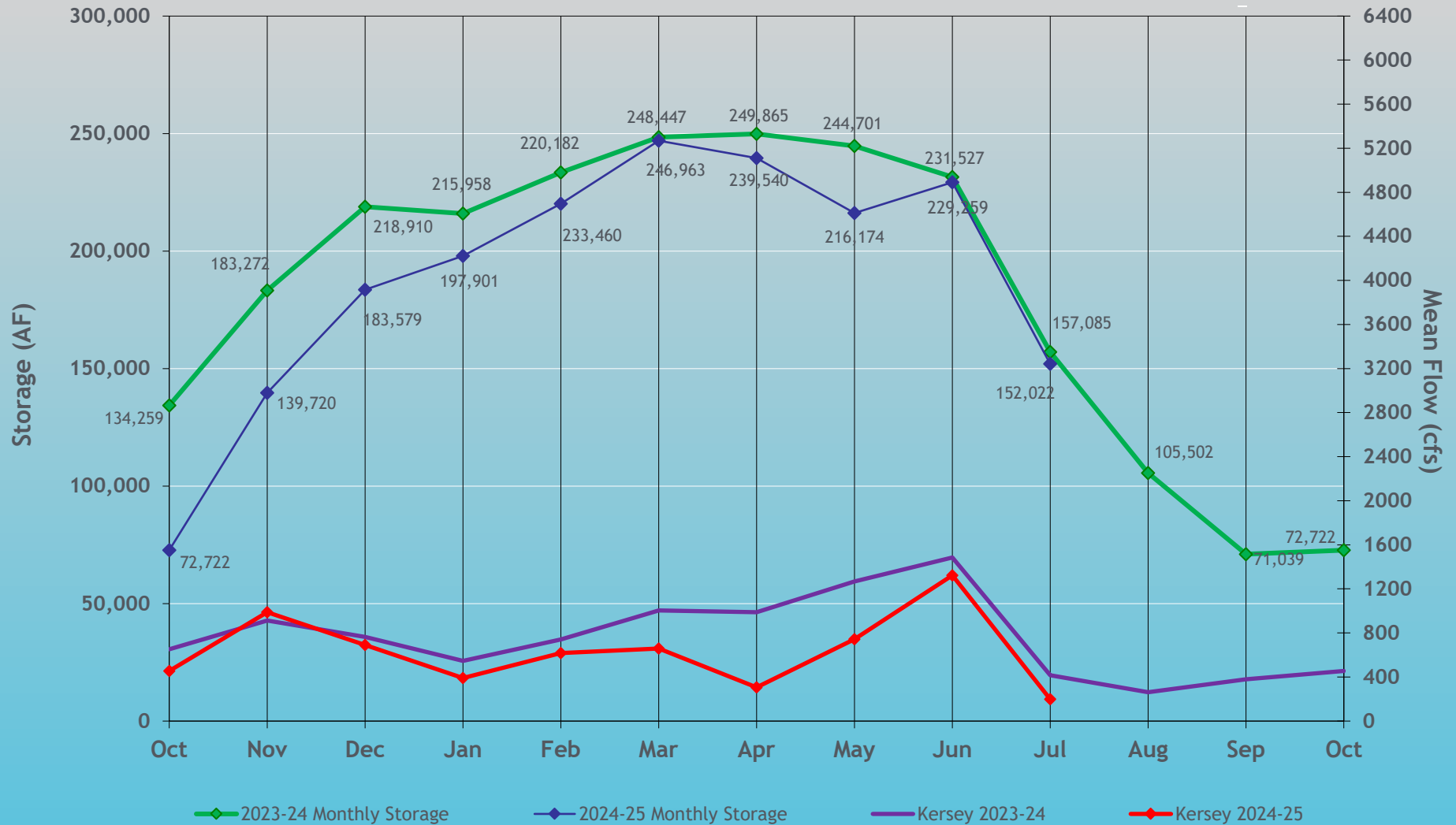

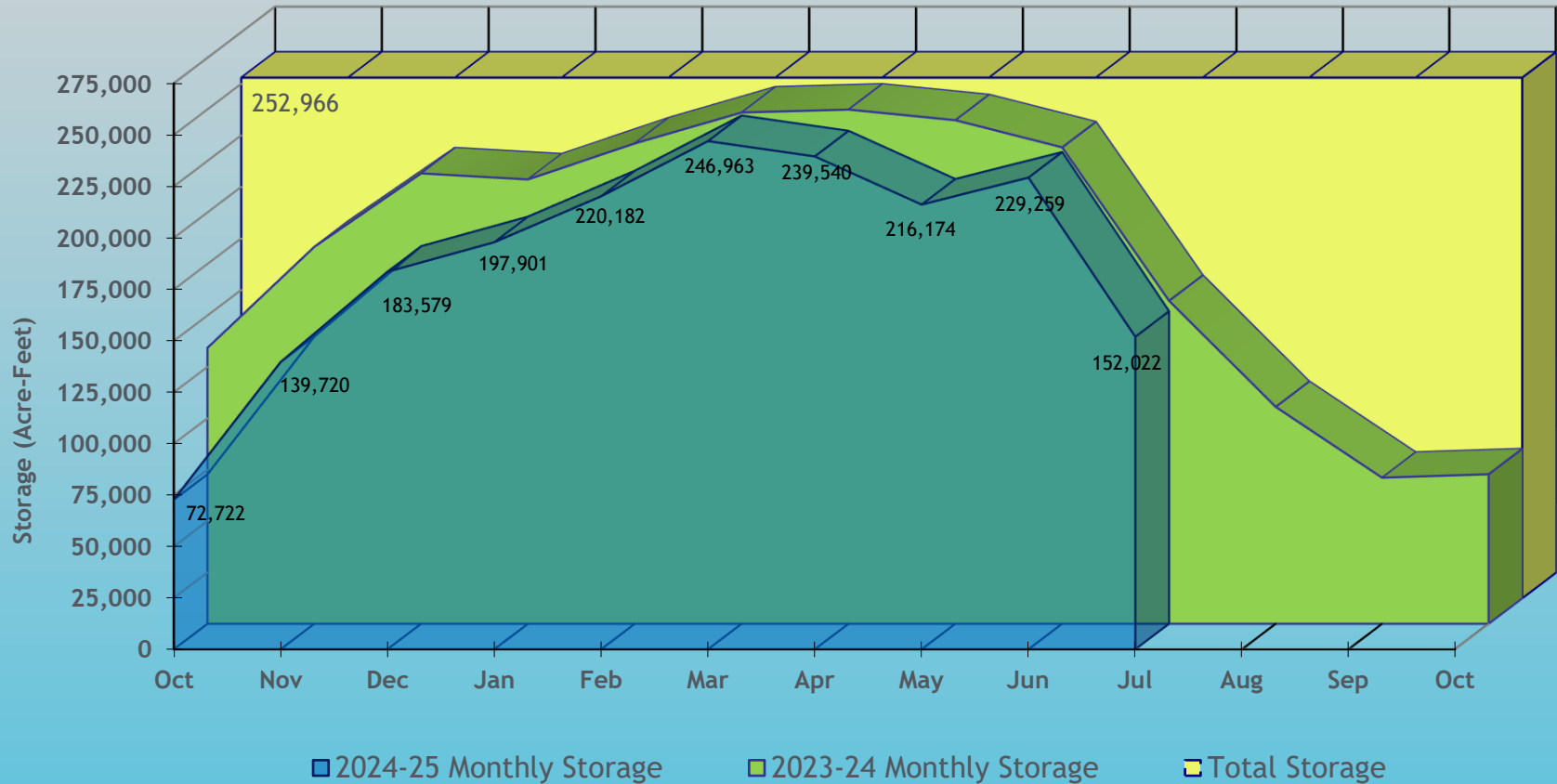

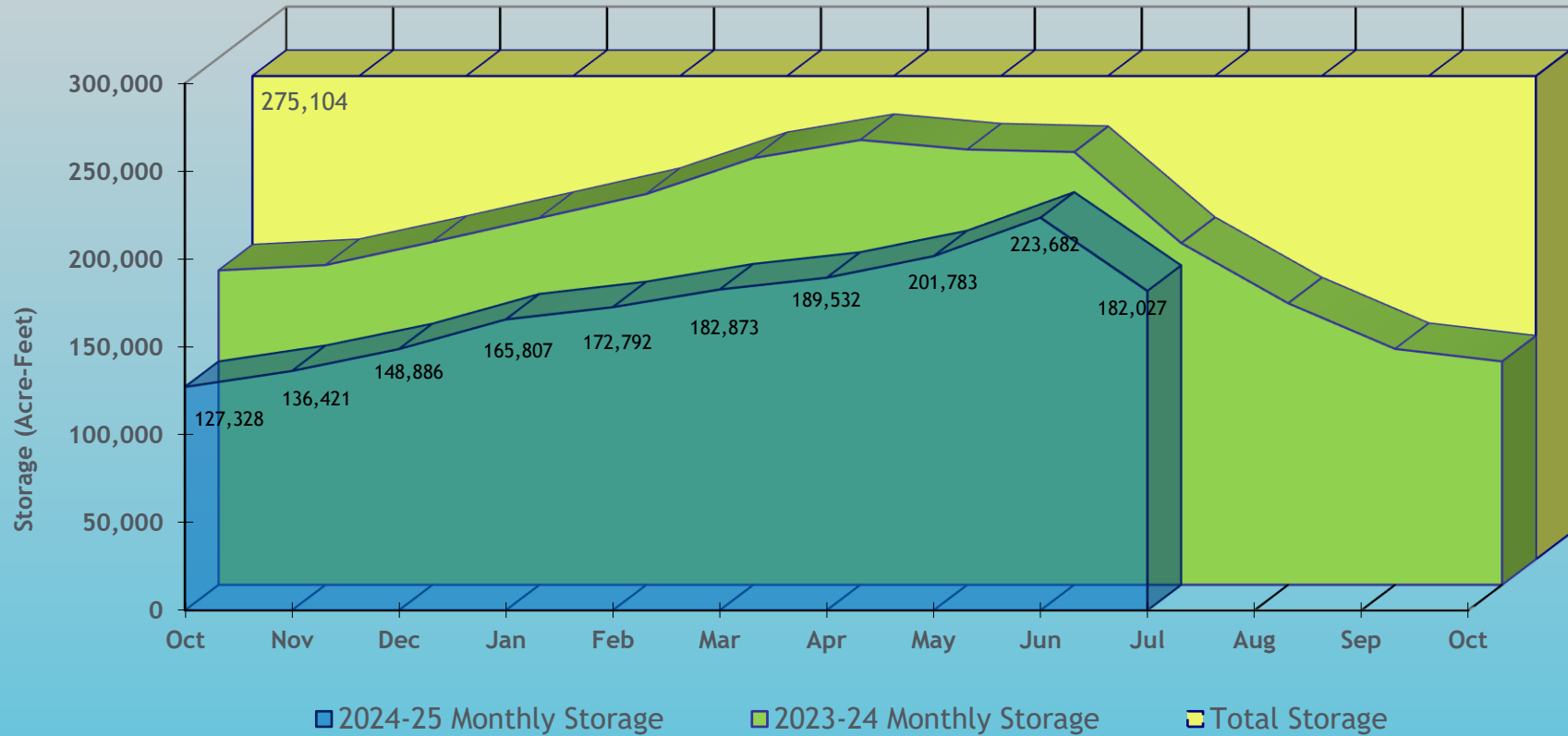

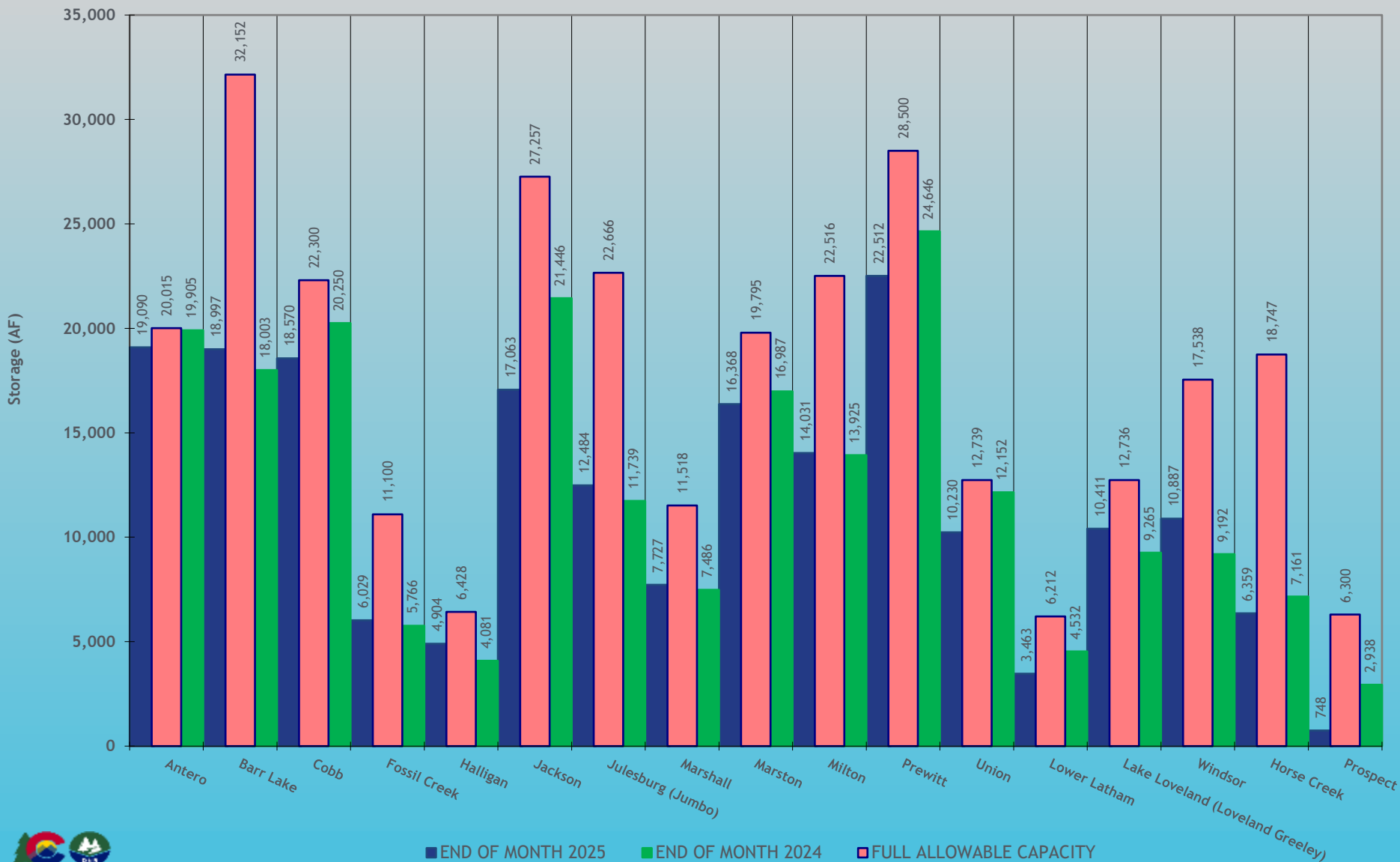
South Platte Reservoir Storage above Kersey*



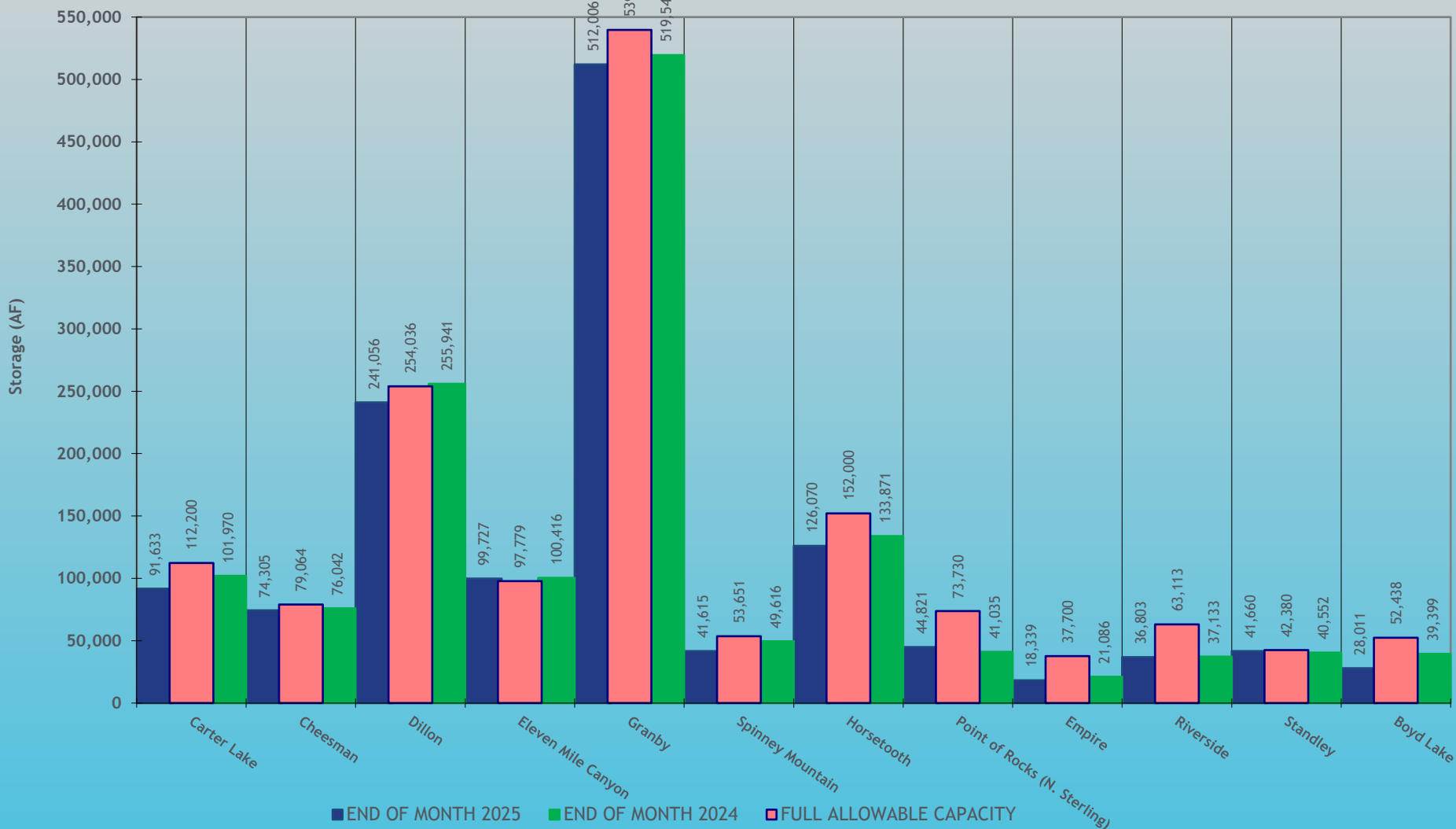

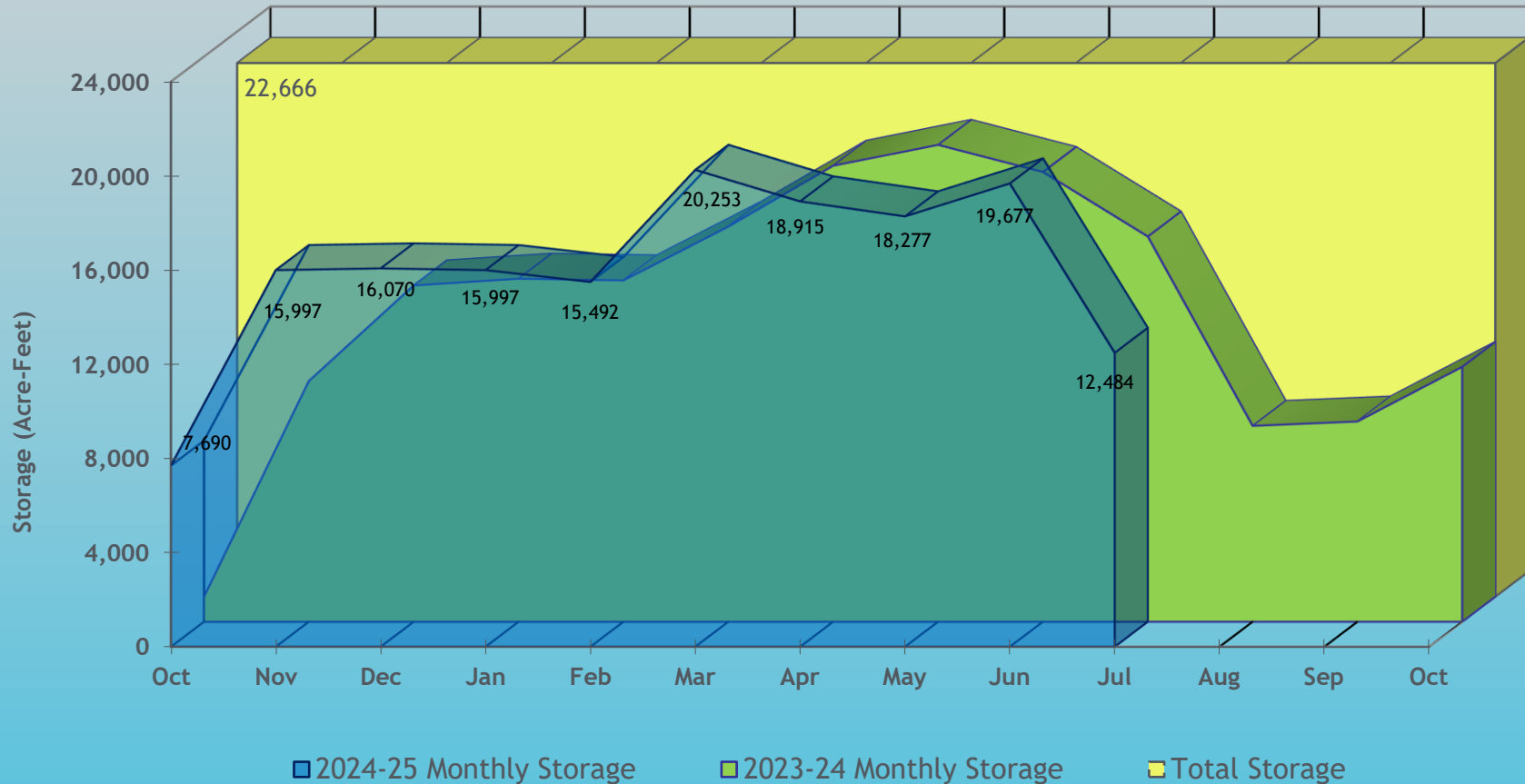
July Reservoir Change in Storage IY2024 versus IY2025



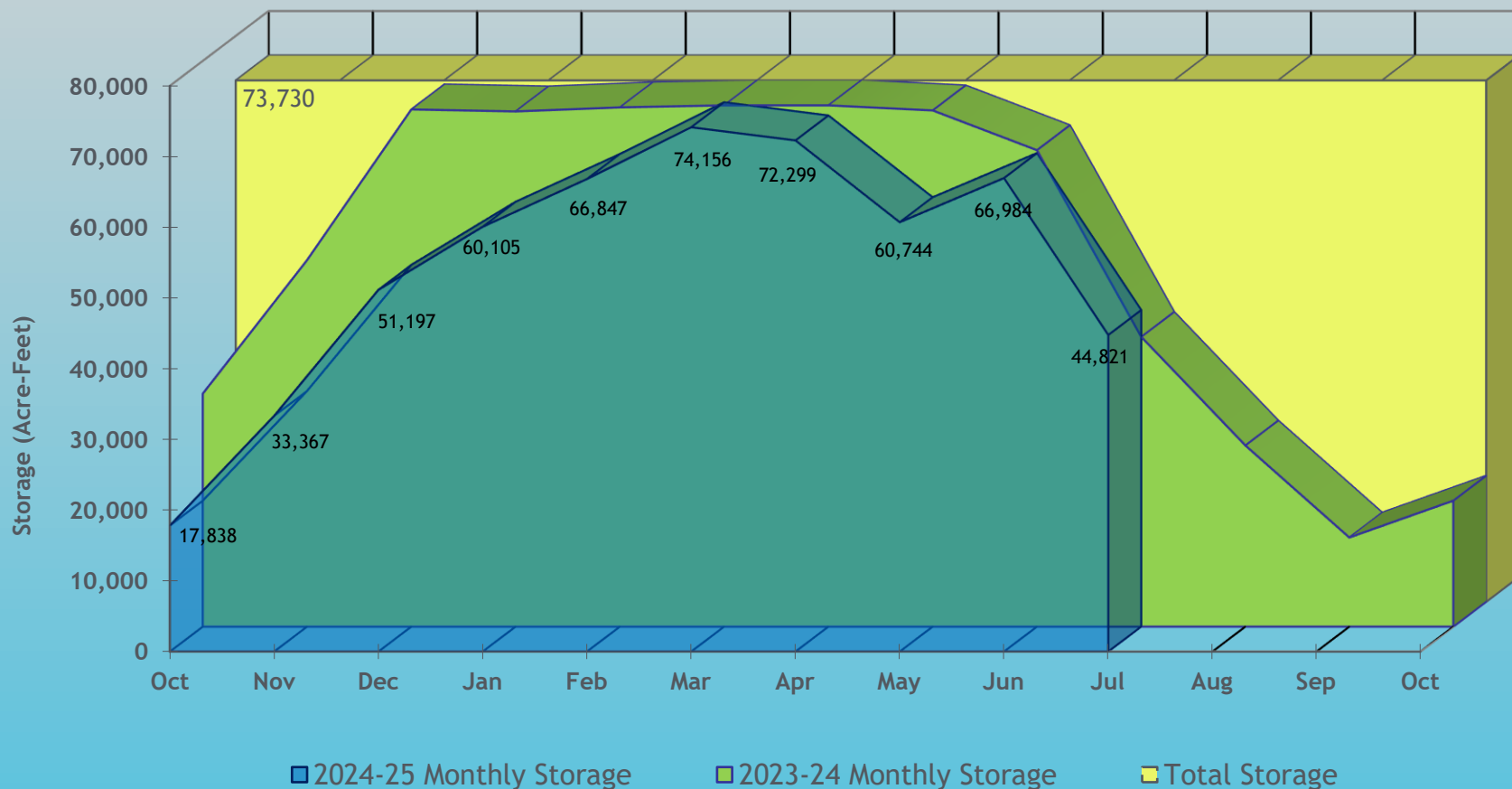

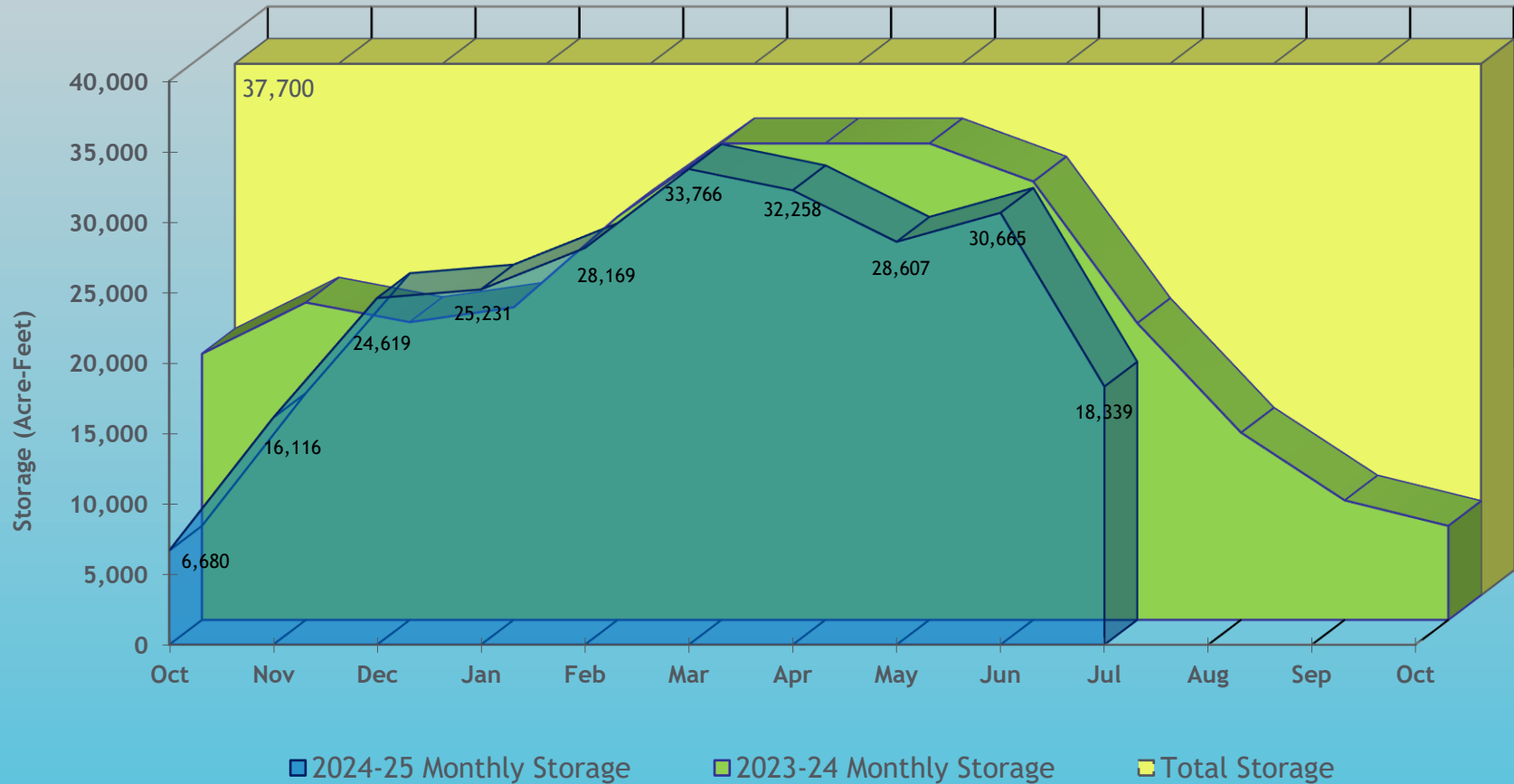

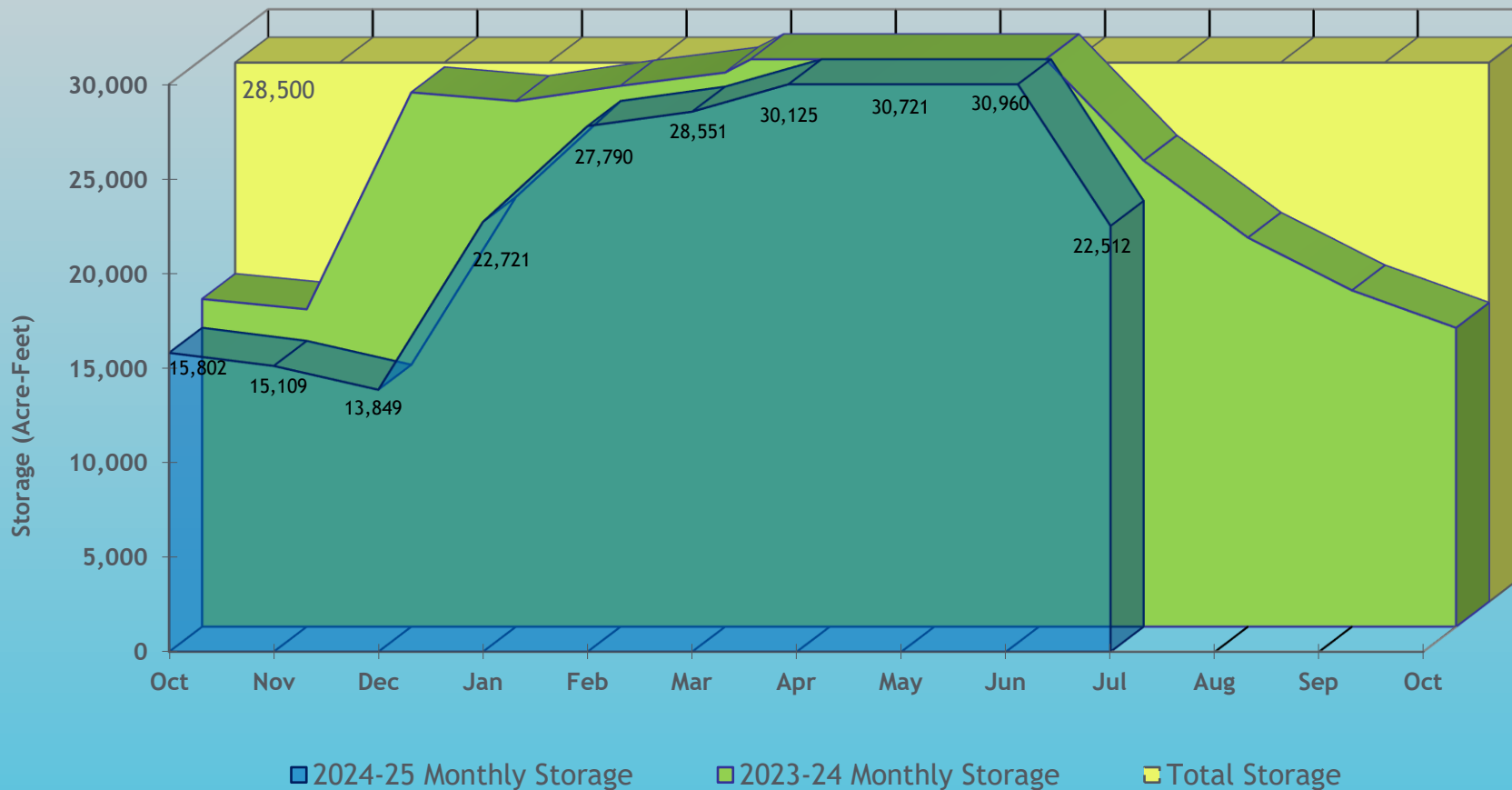

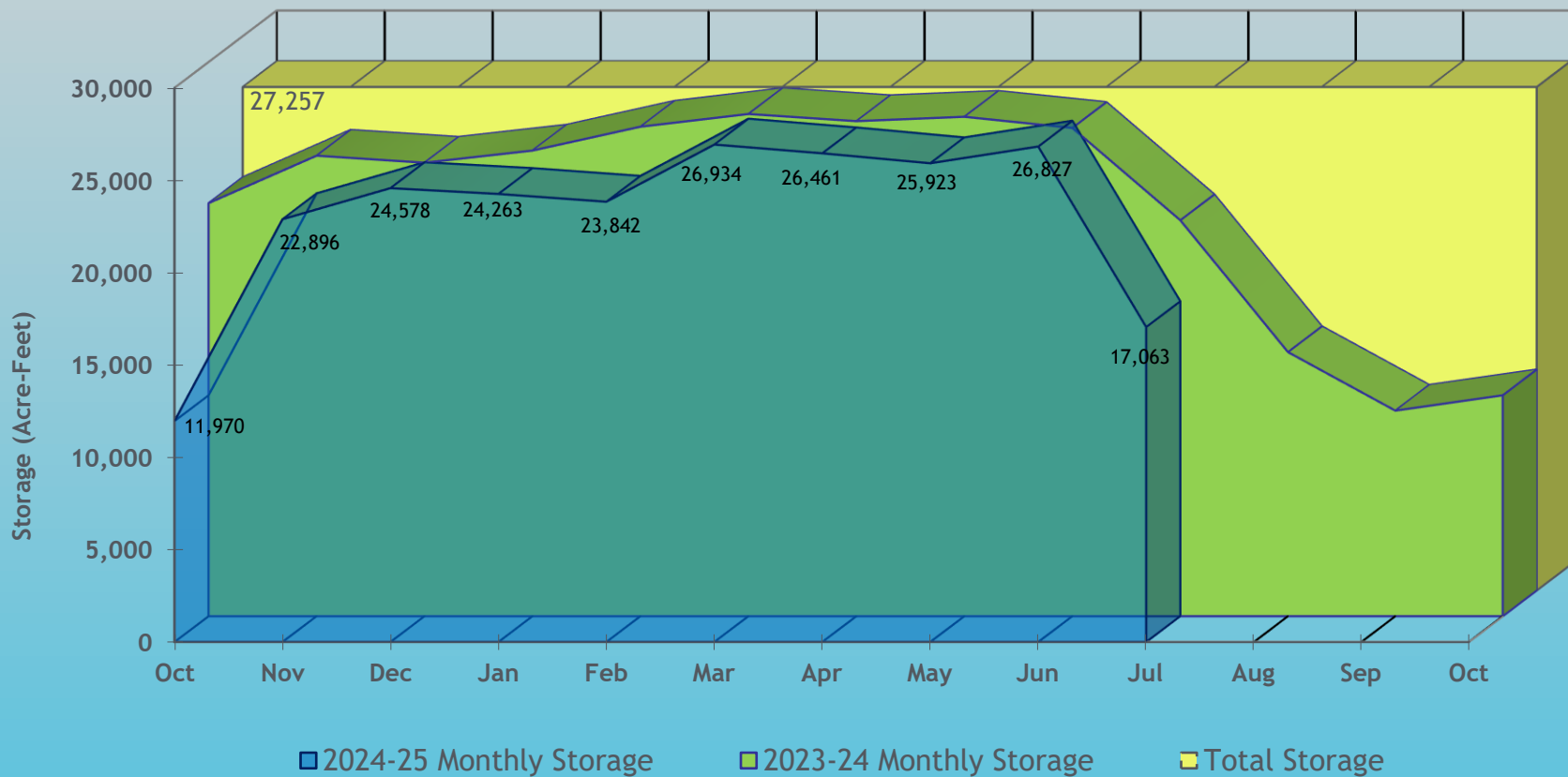

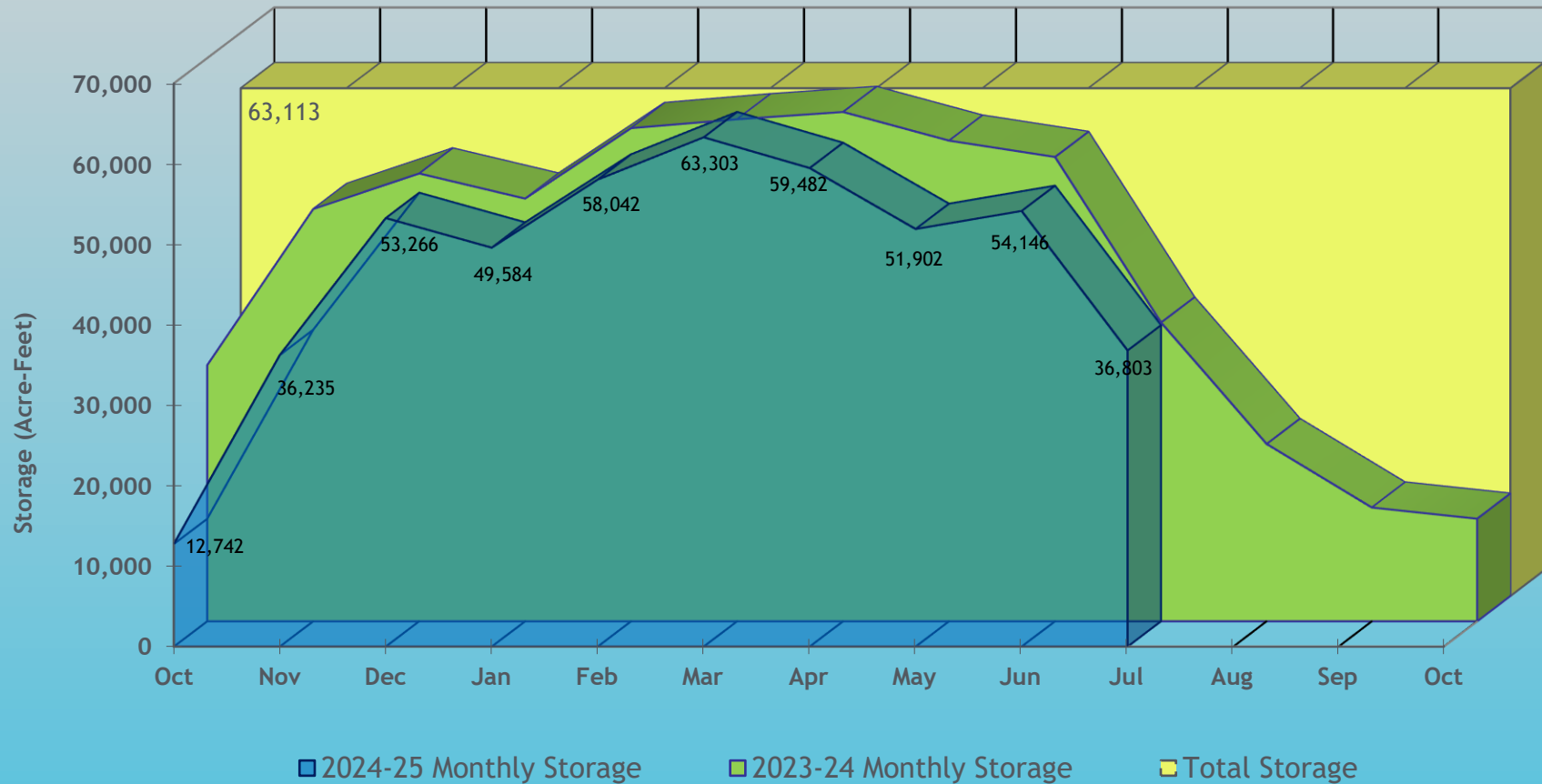

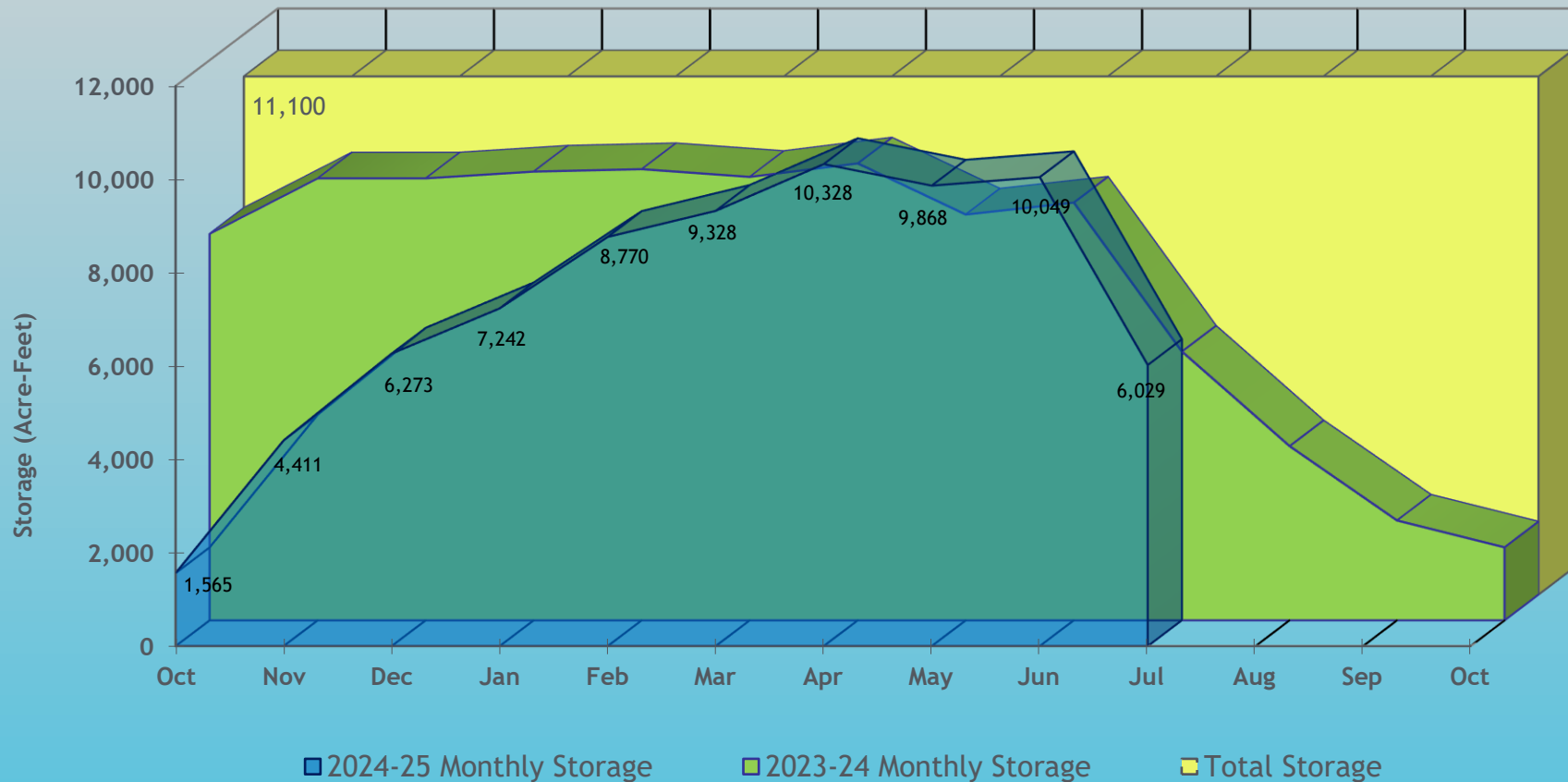

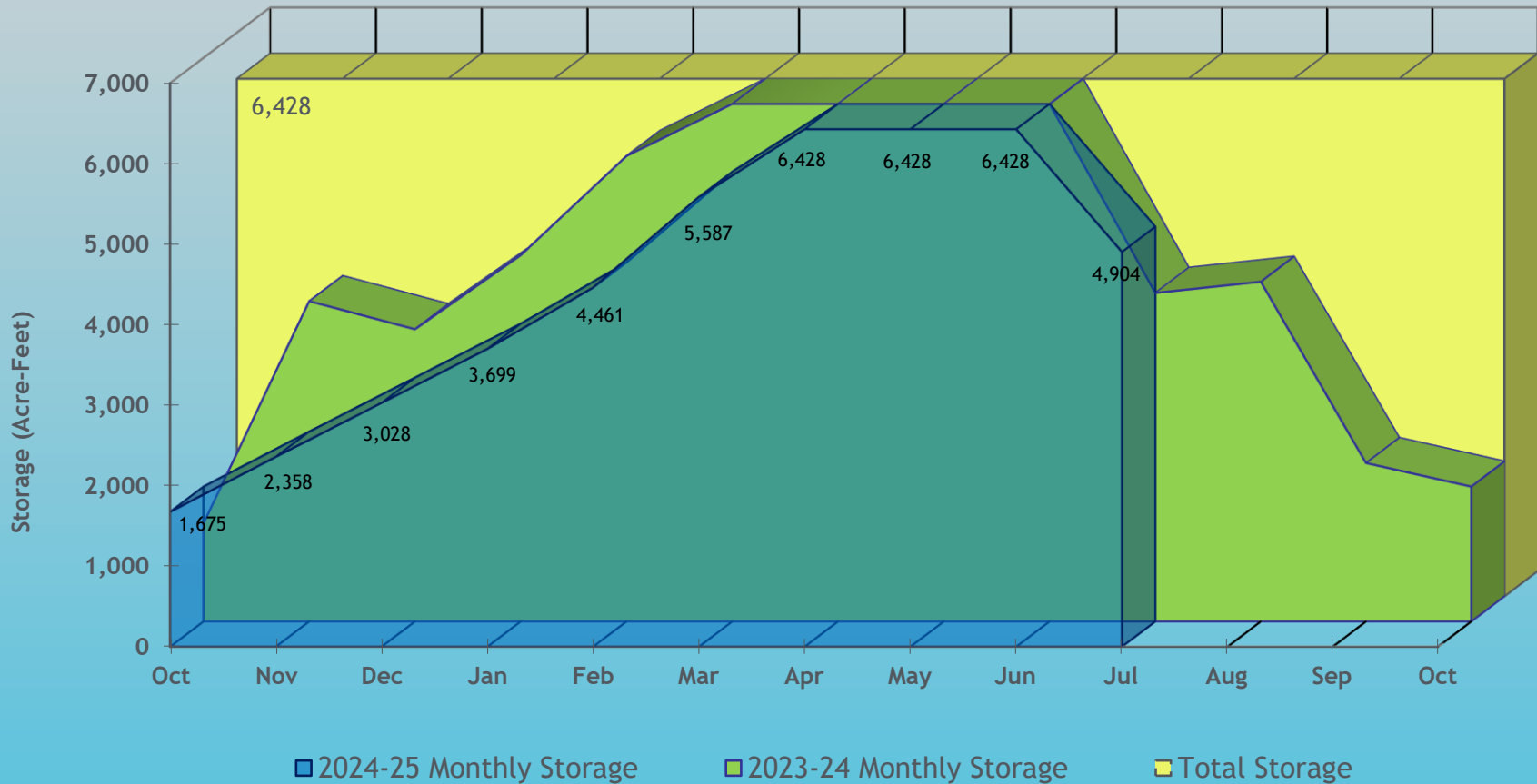

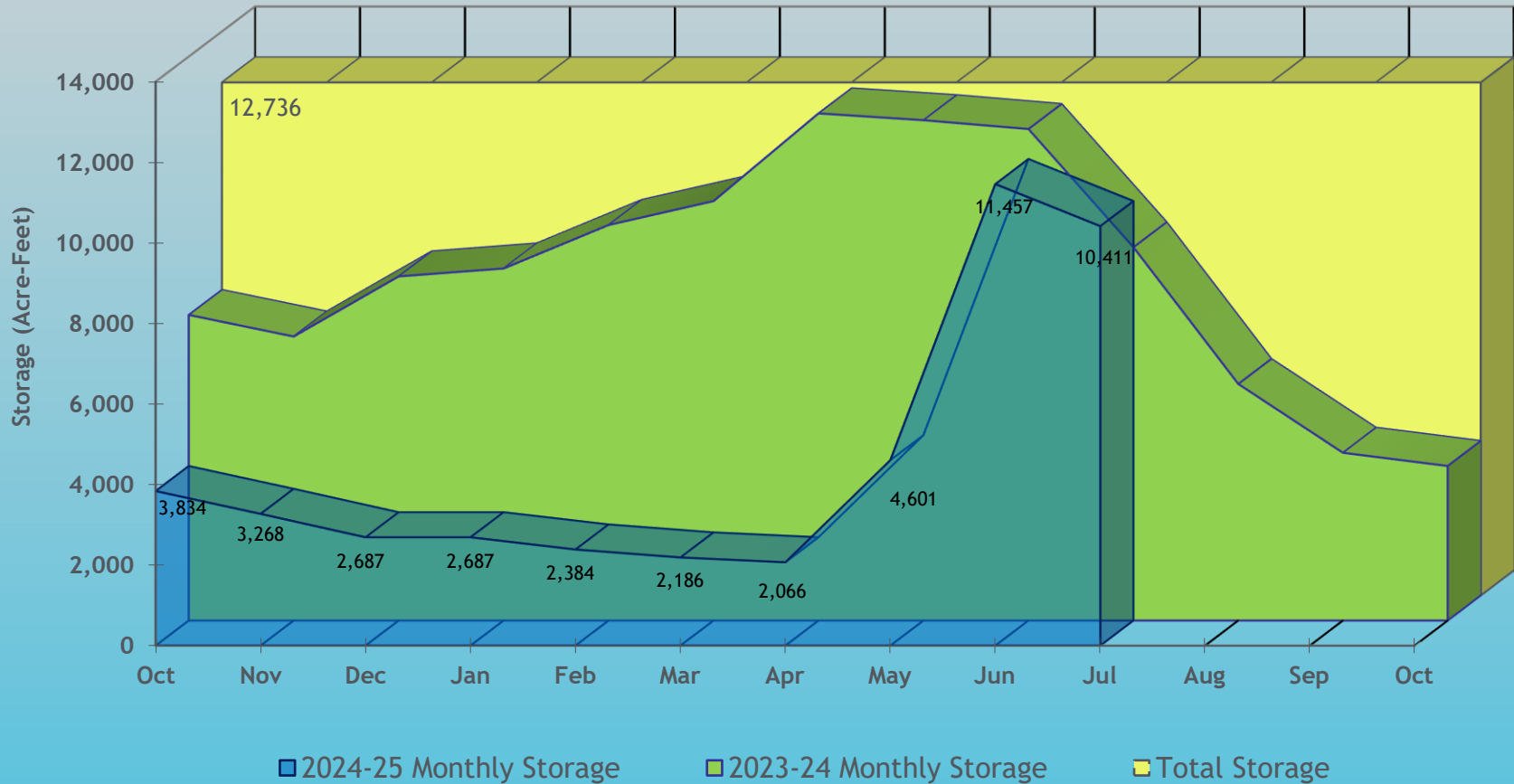

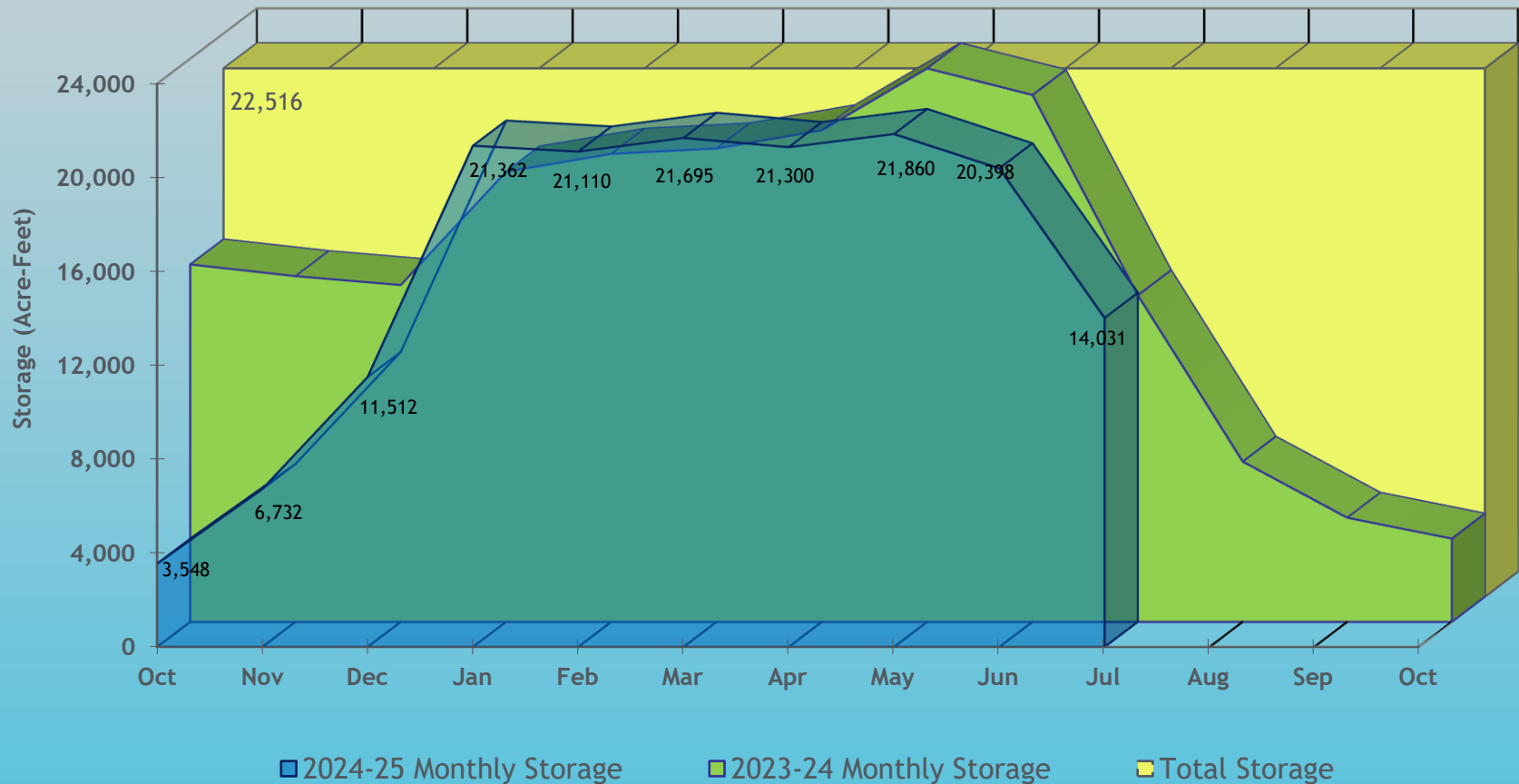

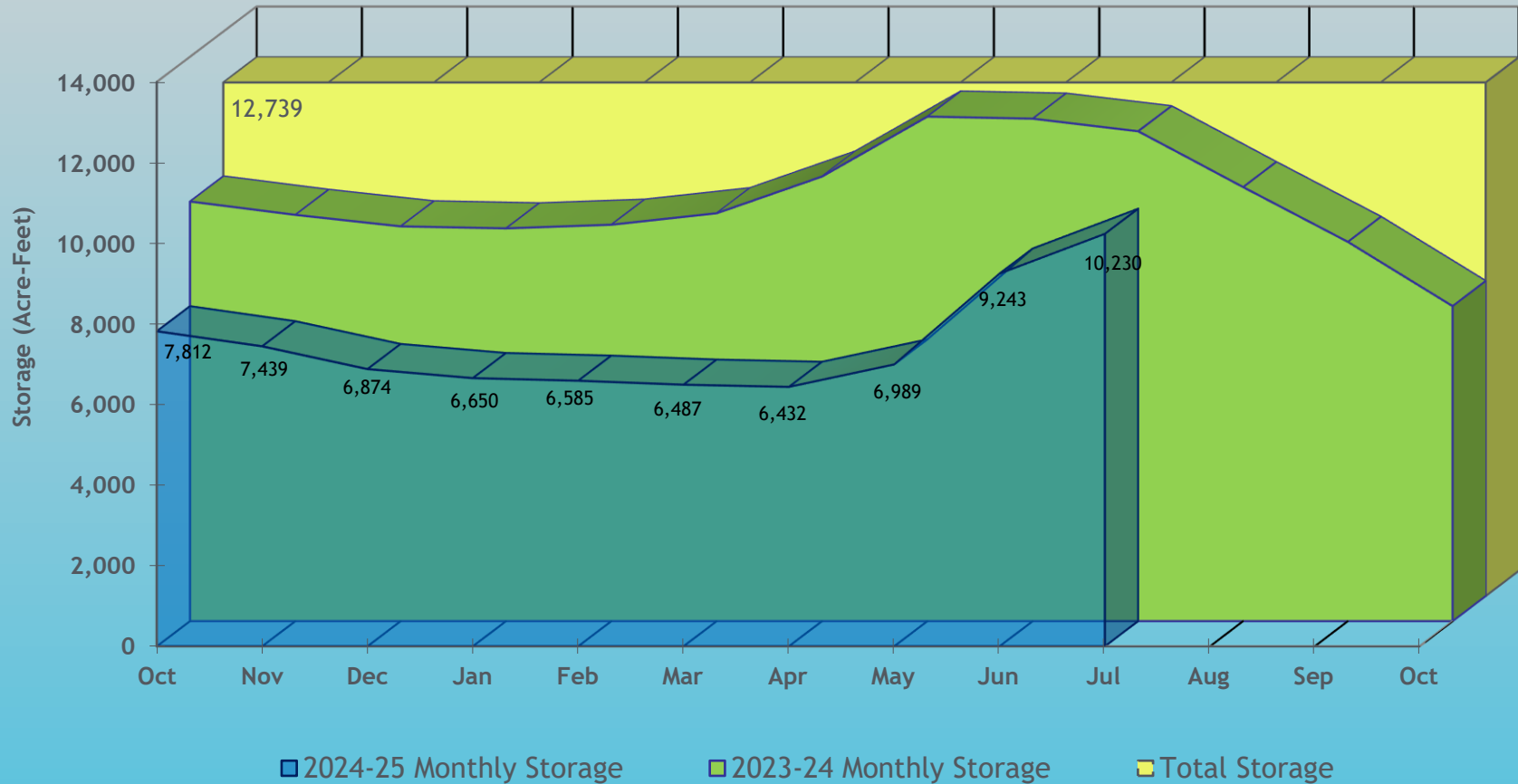

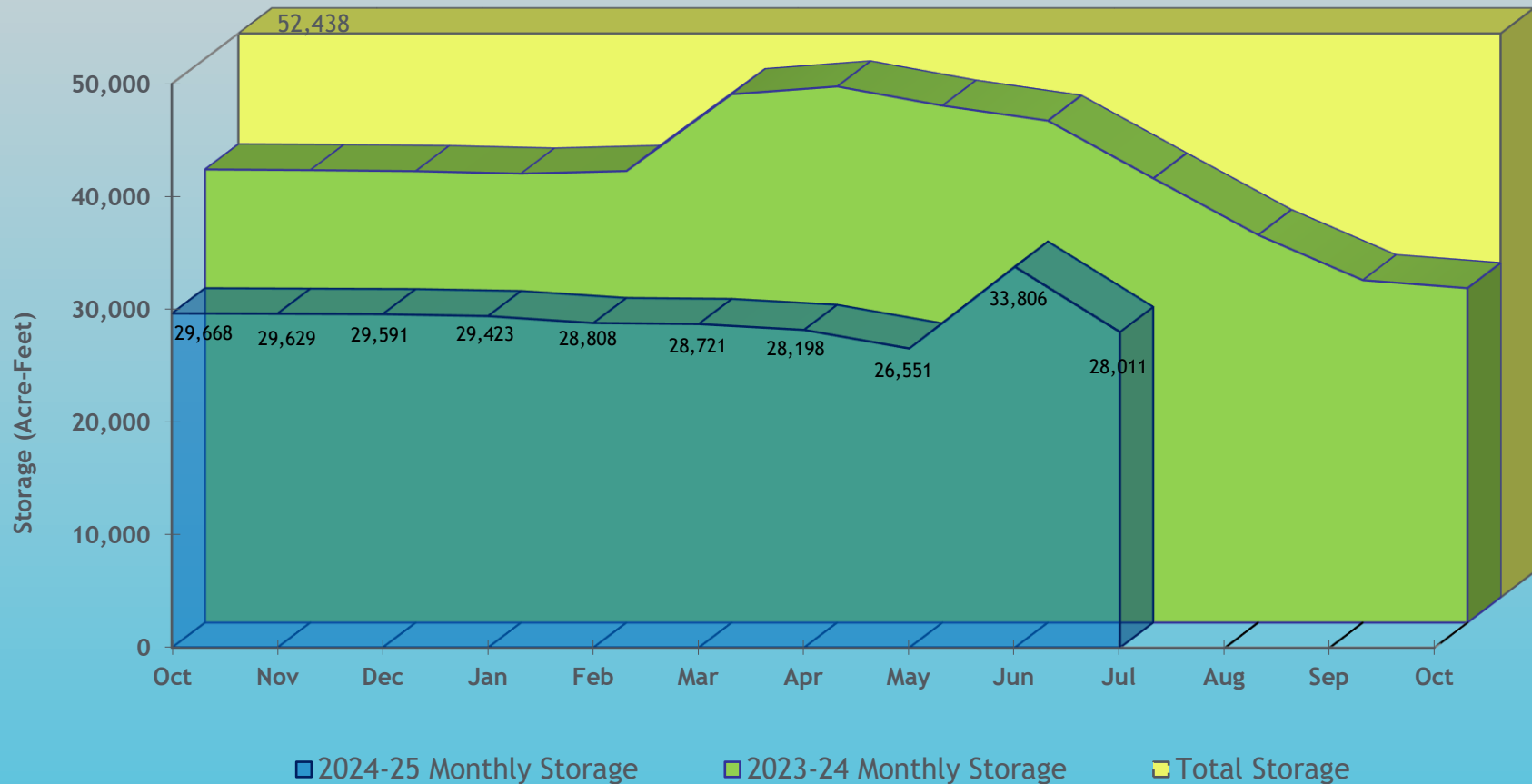

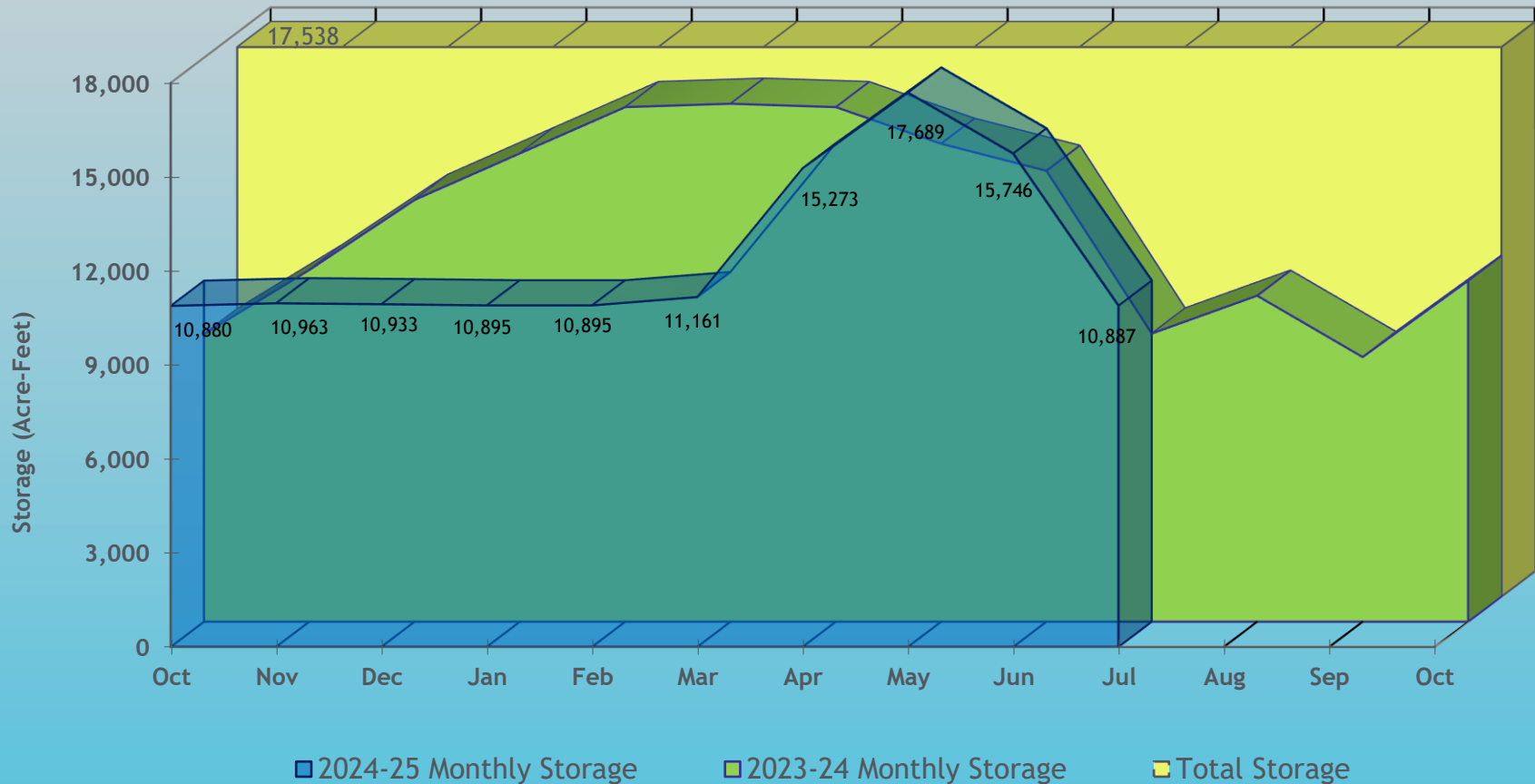

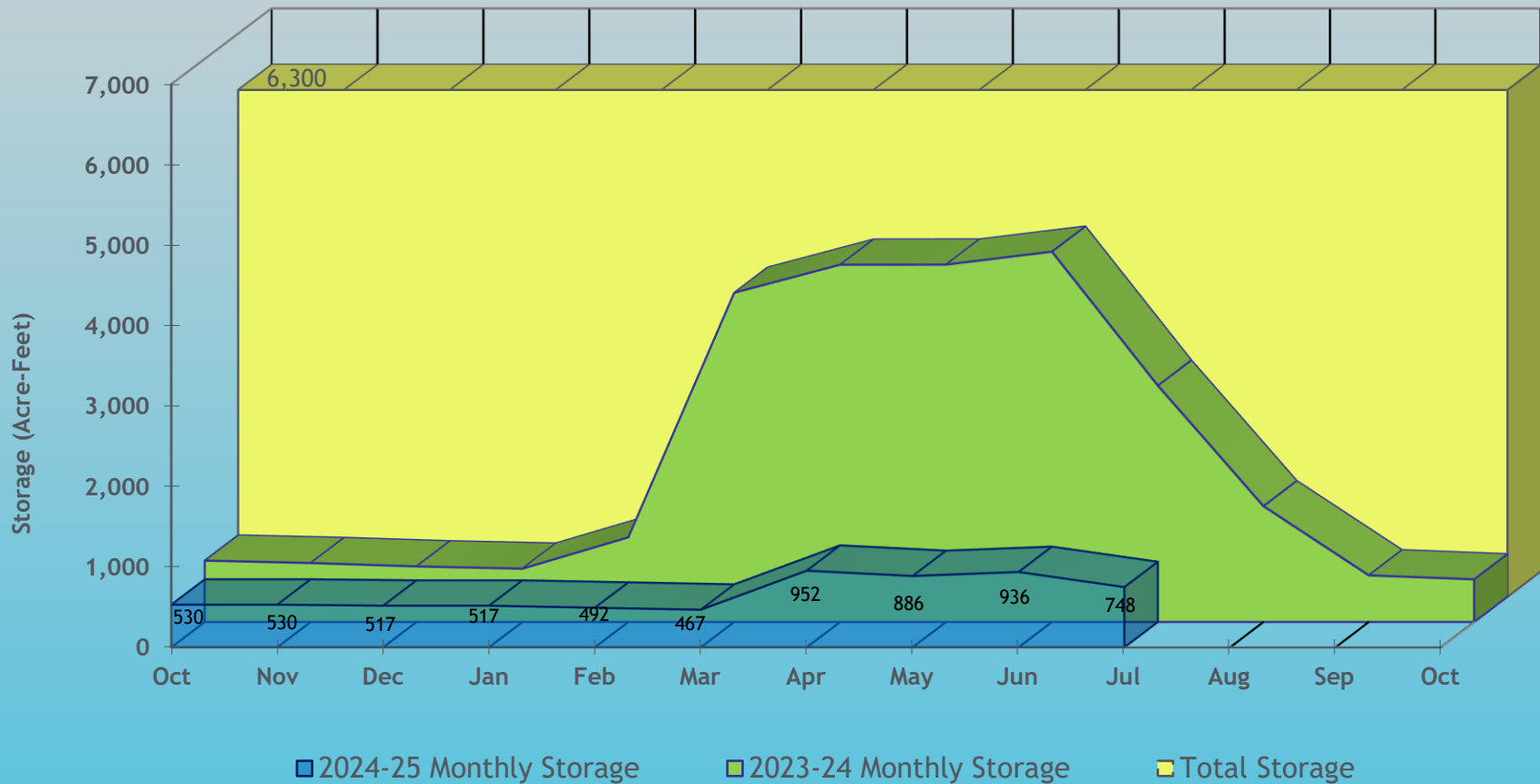

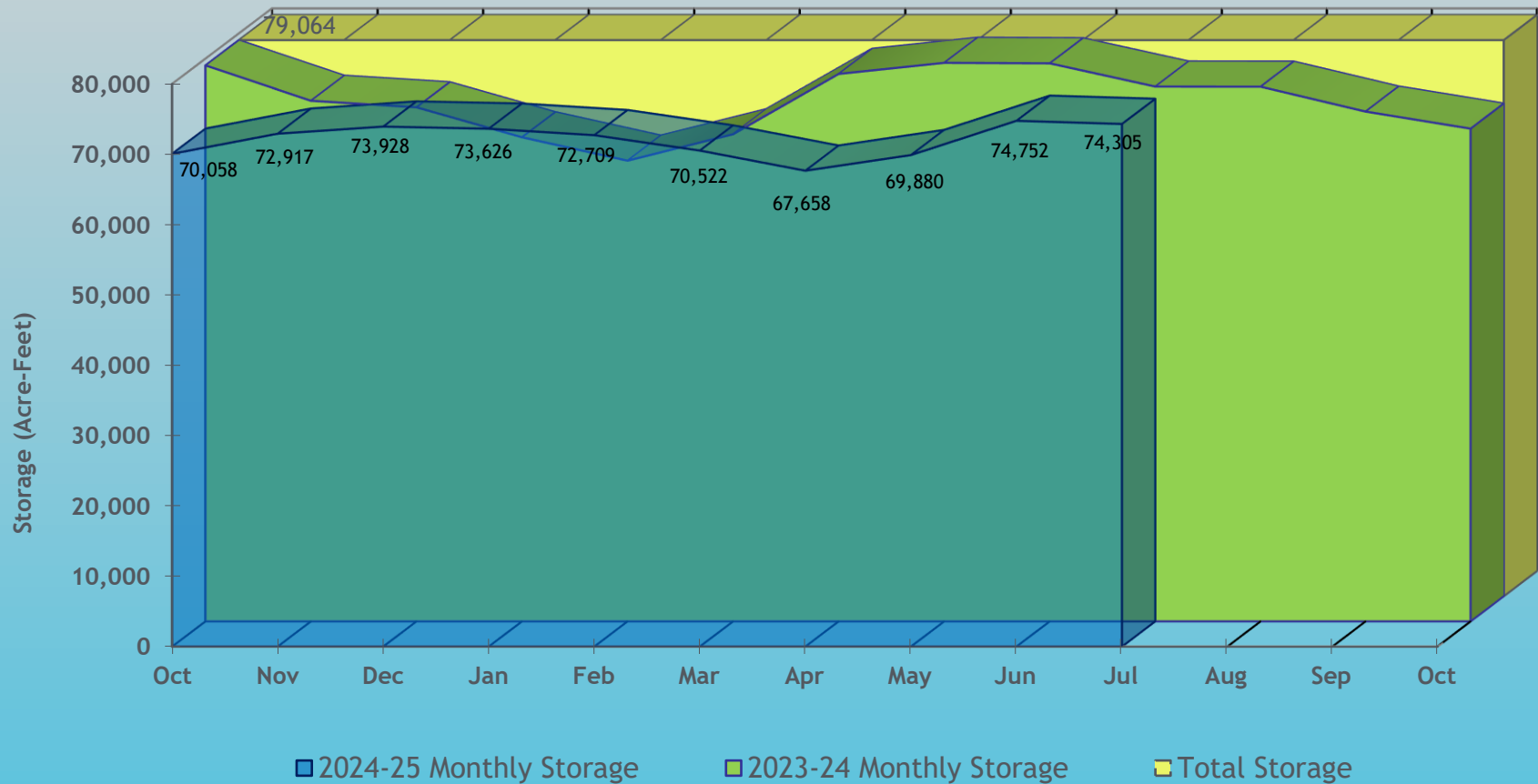

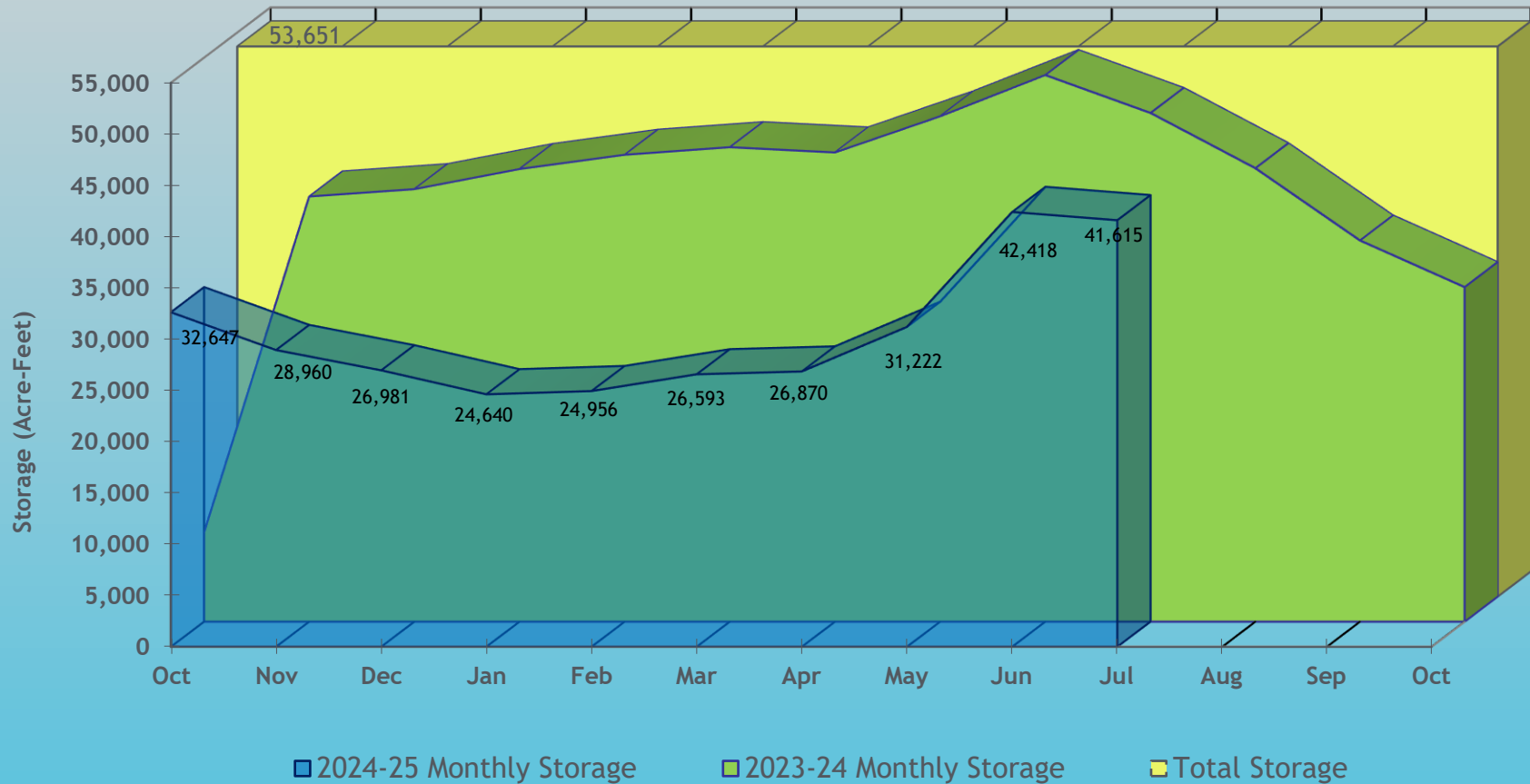

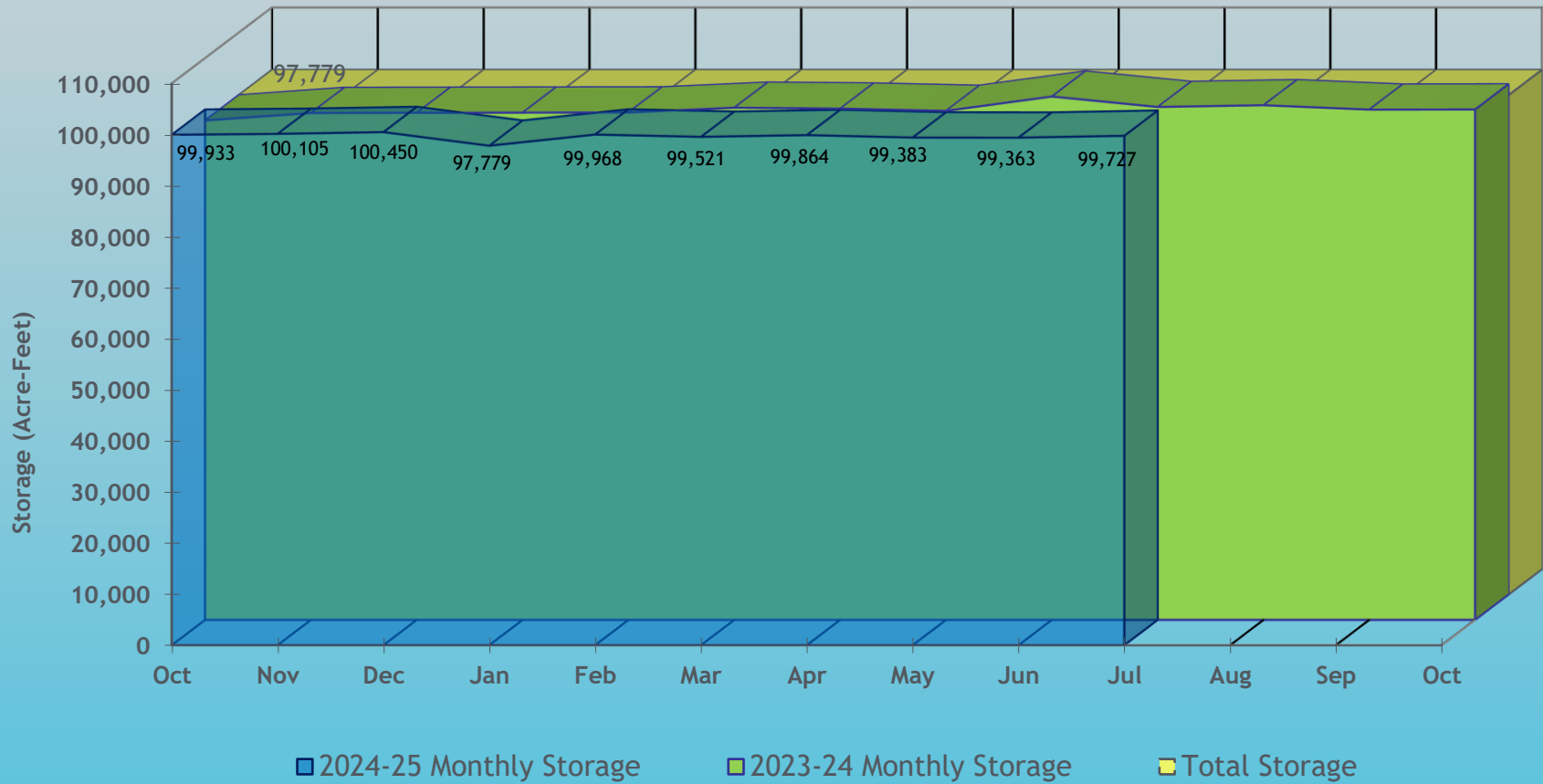

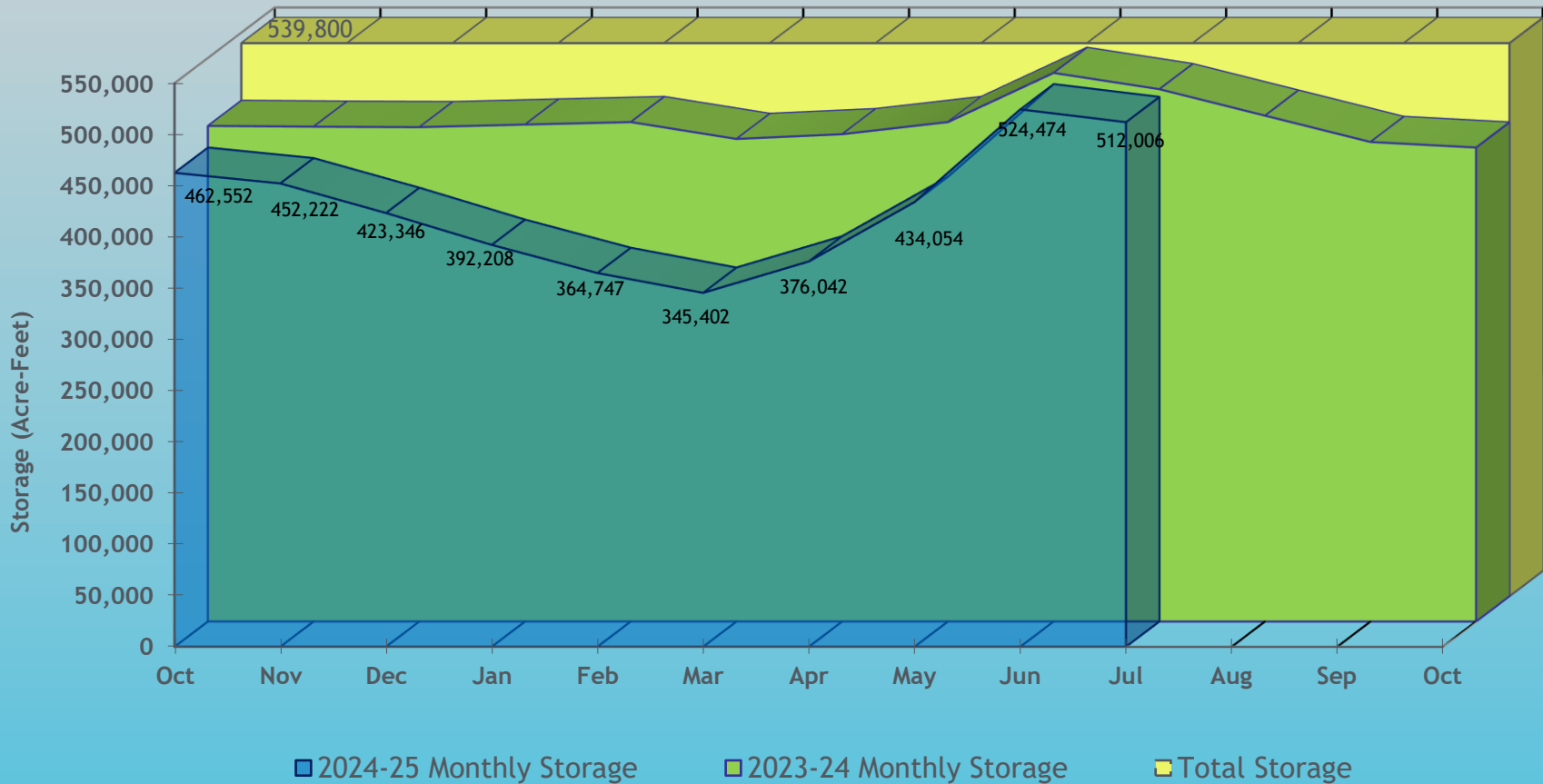
