Governor of the State of Colorado.

Sir:

In compliance with Section 45 of Chapter 134, Colorado Statutes, Annotated, 1935, we are transmitting to you herewith a report of the State Board of Land Commissioners for the biennial period ending June 30th, 1944, showing by tables the lands belonging to the several funds of the State, the lands sold, the amount leased, and the receipts of said Board from all sources, as provided by statute.

A comparison of this report with that for the prior biennium reveals a general improvement. This is disclosed in the following:

The Permanent School Fund increased \$649,574.00 during the biennium.

Land sales increased from the 15,305 acres sold in the prior biennium to 62,080 acres sold in this, the increased receipts from such sales amounting to \$361,145.00.

Of the total of 3,240,826 acres under the Board's supervision, the acreage of vacant lands was reduced during this biennium from 204,178 acres to 133,602 acres.

The amount outstanding under certificates of purchase was reduced \$165,000.00; while that outstanding under farm loans was reduced \$112,000.00.

The income receipts, consisting of interest, rentals and royalties, increased from \$1,692,195.00 to \$1,787,231.00. Mineral department receipts increased from \$87,134.00 to \$142,002.00, while the receipts concerned with the administration of the State Forest and other forested State lands increased from \$30,178.00 to \$41,534.00.

The amount distributed for teachers' minimum salaries increased from \$1,528,608.00 to \$1,608,307.00.

In addition to the investments shown above, 107,477.14 acres of land which have been sold, are now outstanding under certificates of purchase upon which there are due future payments amounting to \$761,223.38, which constitute an investment belonging to these funds.

The State still owns 2,916,931.54 acres of the original grant which constitutes a tremendous asset to the School Fund, both as to yearly income and future possibilities of sale.
