Sir:

In compliance with Section 45 of Chapter 134, Colorado Statutes, Annotated, 1935, we are transmitting to you herewith a report of the State Board of Land Commissioners for the biennial period ending June 30th, 1946, showing by tables the lands belonging to the several funds of the State, the lands sold, the acreage leased, and the receipts of said Board from all sources, as provided by statute.

A comparison of this report with that for the preceding biennium reveals a general improvement. This is disclosed in the following:

While land sales decreased during the current biennium 4,687.44 acres below the total acreage sold in the preceding biennium, yet the total sale price of the land sold during the current biennium exceeded the sale price of the land sold during the preceding biennium by \$425,768.99.

The acreage of vacant land is the smallest in the history of the State. There were only 94,885.31 acres not leased during this biennium which is 38,717 acres less than the vacant, unoccupied land during the preceding biennium.

While the gains accomplished during this biennium are reflected chiefly in the increase of \$1,032,128.67 in the Permanent School Fund which now stands at \$13,657,700.02, investments made from this fund during this biennium were confined almost entirely to Government issues of War Bonds, Defense Bonds, etc. The reduced earning value of the money in the Permanent School Fund, however, has been offset by a general reasonable increase in rental rates on grazing and farm land so that the net income results still show an increase over the preceding biennium.

The amount distributed for teachers' minimum salaries during this biennium was \$1,618,467.89.

*The State Treasurer is the custodian of the investments owned by the Permanent School Fund. The figures on the investments of the Public School Permanent Fund are taken from a detailed inventory furnished to the State Board of Land Commissioners by the State Treasurer. The inventory includes as investments, Farm Loans to the extent of \$726,858.09. Actually, the investments in Farm Loans in the Public School Permanent Fund, June 30, 1946, amount to \$120,764.79. The remaining \$606,093.30 of the \$726,858.09 item carried by the State Treasurer as Farm Loans is represented by the foreclosed lands now owned by the State in place of the notes and trust deeds representing loans, and which said foreclosed lands are included in our School Permanent Fund Lands elsewhere in this report.

In addition to the investments shown above, 95,104.15 acres of land which have been sold, are now outstanding under certificates of purchase upon which there are due future payments amounting to \$727,743.31, which constitute an investment belonging to these funds.
