INFORMATION

There are eight Trust Funds. The largest is the School Trust Fund. Land and mineral revenues are determined, collected, verified, deposited and transferred by this division into these funds. Each trust has two sub funds. One is named the Permanent Trust (non-expendable) and the other is named the Income Trust (expendable).

Trust revenues are divided into six receipt classes. Each sub fund is a depository for three (3) receipt classes.

A. Permanent Trust revenues are received from:

1. (a) Sales of land
- (b) Principal portion of Certificates of Purchase land contract amortization payments.
- (c) Payment received from the federal government for land taken under eminent domain.
- (d) Consideration received in addition to land value as the result of a land exchange/swap.
2. Consideration received for Rights of Way granted across State Lands.
3. (a) Royalties received as the result of the depletion or the anticipated depletion of oil, gas, geothermal, coal, gravel, or other mineral resources.
- (b) Bonus payment - the premium consideration, paid once, for a mineral tract sold at Public Auction.
- (c) Exploration Permit consideration paid by prospectors for permission to carry out seismic activity on state lands.

NOTE: Money deposited into the School Permanent Fund is invested by the State Treasurer. This fund is never depleted, it is a constantly growing investment base and provides a perpetual interest annuity for the School Income Fund. The Permanent Fund Investment as reported by the Treasurer for June 30, 1986 was \$154,622,745. See paragraph H.

B. Income Trust revenues are received from:

1. Rentals for surface land, oil, gas, geothermal, coal, gravel and other mineral rights given under lease contracts.
2. Money received from Timber Contracts and Permits.
3. (a) Interest portion of Certificate of Purchase land contract amortization payments.
- (b) Delinquent interest received as the result of late payments.

Revenue from State Forest leases is disbursed based on percentages derived from these acreages.

- E. As a result of automation, the land inventory figures and various other information is being updated from computer generated reports. This will insure greater accuracy and reliability for reporting purposes.
- F. On May 23, 1983, a Notice of Condemnation by the United States of America became effective for State-owned land in Las Animas County. The Civil action stated 27,223.21 acres as taken. The Board of Land Commissioners' records indicate the actual State-owned acreage as 26,736.34 acres. Since the transaction has not been completed, the latter acreage is being shown as vacant in the Las Animas County statistics.
- G. The State Land Board Administration Fund was created on July 1, 1983. Effective July 1, 1984 ten percent of all proceeds from the lands controlled by the State Board of Land Commissioners shall provide the corpus of this fund. Salaries of the commissioners and staff and all other associated expenses necessarily incurred by this Board in carrying out their Constitutional mandate will be appropriated from this fund by the legislature. Any annual residual balance remaining shall be apportioned among the trust funds from which derived.
