INFORMATION

There are eight Trust Funds. The largest is the Schaol Trust Fund. Land and minerol revenues ore determined, callected, verified, depasited and tronsferred by this divisian into these funds. Each trust has two sub funds. One is named the Permanent Trust (nan-expendable) and the ather is nomed the Income Trust (expendable).

Trust revenues ore divided inta six receipt classes. Each sub fund is o depasitary far three (3) receipt classes.

- A. Permanent Trust revenues are received fram:
 - 1. (a) Sales af land
 - (b) Principal portion of Certificates of Purchase land controct amartization poyments.
 - (c) Poyment received fram the federal government for land taken under eminent damain.
 - (d) Cansideratian received in addition to lond volue os the result of o lond exchange/swap.
 - 2. Cansideratian received far Rights af Way gronted acrass State Lands.
 - (a) Rayalties received as the result of the depletion or the anticipoted depletion of ail, gas, geathermal, coal, gravel, or other mineral resources.
 - (b) Banus payment the premium cansiderotian, paid ance, far a mineral troct sold of Public Auctian.
 - (c) Explarotian Permit cansiderotion poid by prospectars far permissian ta carry aut seismic activity an state lands.
- NOTE: Money depasited into the Schaal Permonent Fund is invested by the State Treosurer. This fund is never depleted, it is o constantly growing investment base and provides a perpetual interest annuity far the Schaal Incame Fund. The Permonent Fund Investment as reparted by the Treosurer far June 30, 1986 was \$154,622,745. See porograph H.
- B. Income Trust revenues are received from:
 - 1. Rentols for surfoce land, ail, gas, geothermol, caal, grovel ond other minerol rights given under lease cantrocts.
 - 2. Maney received fram Timber Controcts and Permits.
 - (a) Interest portion of Certificate of Purchase land contract omartization payments.
 - (b) Delinquent interest received os the result of lote poyments.

C. Trust Fund Names are:

- 1. Public School 5. Saline
- 2. Penitentiary 6. Colo. State University
- 3. Public Buildings 7. Hesperus Endowment

Revenue from State Forest leases is disbursed based on percentages derived from these acreages.

- E. As a result of automation, the land inventory figures and various other information is being updated from computer generated reports. This will insure greater accuracy and reliability for reporting purposes.
- F. On May 23, 1983, a Notice of Condemnation by the United States of America became effective for State-owned land in Las Animas County. The Civil action stated 27,223.21 acres as taken. The Board of Land Commissioners' records indicate the actual State-owned acreage as 26,736.34 acres. Since the transaction has not been completed, the latter acreage is being shown as vacant in the Las Animas County statistics.
- G. The State Land Board Administration Fund was created on July 1, 1983. Effective July 1, 1984 ten percent of all proceeds from the lands controlled by the State Board of Land Commissioners shall provide the corpus of this fund. Salaries of the commissioners and staff and all other associated expenses necessarily incurred by this Board in carrying out their Constitutional mandate will be appropriated from this fund by the legislature. Any annual residual balance remaining shall be apportioned among the trust funds from which derived.
