The following Resolution was proposed by Commissioner Blackwell at the March 3, 1980 regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Clear Creek County, Colorado:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to provide library services for Clear Creek County on a county-wide basis; and

WHEREAS, county-wide library services should be financed by a county-wide levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Clear Creek County, acting jointly with the Board of Aldermen of the City of Idaho Springs and the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Georgetown to establish a county-wide library district to be known as The Clear Creek County Library District in accord with and pursuant to CRS 1973, 24-90-110, et seq. as amended. The boundaries and area of The Clear Creek County Library District shall be identical with the boundaries and area of the County of Clear Creek, State of Colorado.
