- **Key Item:** All grantees have been reminded of close-out requirements for the grant program. Each grantee has **45 days** from the end date of their grant to submit all closeout documentation. All projects will be closed out by December **14**, 2014.
- DHSEM will be required to have the entire program closed out with NRCS by January 29, 2015.
- The first Request for Reimbursement from the State to NRCS was submitted the week of October 1. There will be another RFR submitted during the week of October 6.
- El Paso County, Larimer County, Colorado Springs, Estes Park, Evans, Lyons, and the Jefferson Conservation District, have completed their projects and are working to close out their NRCS grants. Boulder County, Jamestown, Morgan County are continuing to work on their NRCS projects.
