Program Update

• Thirteen requests for reimbursements (RFRs) were submitted and recommended for payment during the last week.

- The total amount of RFRs is now at five hundred-sixty (560), of which two hundred twenty-nine (229) are complete and one hundred sixteen (116) are with the sub-grantees.
- 86 million in RFRs has been requested. \$75.6M is considered initially eligible and \$27.5 has been recommended for payment.
- Eleven requests for scope changes were submitted in the last week. One request was completed. The total amount of scope change requests is now one hundred forty-seven (147), of which eighty-seven (87) are completed and thirty-five (35) are with the sub-grantees.

Program Update

- Thirteen local governments were notified that they are on-track to receive up to \$10.58 million in CDBG-DR funding for infrastructure projects:
 - o Aurora Housing Authority
 - City of Colorado Springs
 - o Town of Estes Park
 - City of Evans
 - o City of Fountain
 - Town of Frederick
 - Jefferson Conservation District
 - Larimer County
 - o City of Louisville
 - Town of Lyons
 - City of Manitou Springs
 - o Town of Nederland
 - Upper Thompson Sanitation District

- Their next step is to enter the formal environmental and historic preservation review process with the Colorado Department of Local Affairs (DOLA). State Recovery Liaisons will be working with these communities to assist them as they move through the grant process.
- To date, DHSEM has notified local government applicants of the award of \$12.5 million in CDBG-DR
 Infrastructure grants. This amount represents approximately eighty-one percent (81%) of the funding requested
 to date. It is anticipated that the balance of the application approvals will be completed during the next two
 weeks
