2007 ANNUAL LOCAL VALE REPORT (January 1 – December 31, 2007)

In 1984, the General Assembly approved legislation to establish the Assistance to Victims of and Witnesses to Crimes and Aid to Law Enforcement Act (VALE). As currently enacted, the Act mandates a surcharge on fines imposed for felonies, misdemeanors, juvenile offenses, class 1 and 2 traffic offenses, and certain traffic infractions. A flat fee, rather than a surcharge, is collected on cases where fines are not imposed. The funds collected are used for grants to agencies that provide services to crime victims within the local judicial district in which the monies are collected. The Act has been amended several times since its original passage in 1984.

In 2007, the Colorado Legislature passed Senate Bill 55 (SB 07-55), which impacted VALE collections in two ways. First, prior to July 1, 2007, the portion of the surcharge attributable to the increase enacted in 2003 was deposited into the General Fund. Senate Bill 55 (SB 07-55), redirected all future deposits, formerly deposited into the General Fund, to the local judicial districts. Second, the legislation also rounded the surcharge amounts into whole dollar figures. The surcharges that may be imposed are as follows: felony convictions \$163.00, misdemeanor convictions \$78.00, class 1 misdemeanor traffic offenses \$46.00, class 2 misdemeanor traffic offenses \$33.00, and class A and B traffic offenses as outlined in C.R.S. § 24-4.1-119(1)(f).

Section 24-4.2-108 of the VALE statute mandates that each of the local VALE boards shall submit to the Division of Criminal Justice an annual report detailing: the amount of funds granted to agencies; the number of agencies applying for funds; and the projects and services for which grants were awarded. This is the twenty-first year that such a summary has been completed by the Division of Criminal Justice.

The graphs and summarizing data in this report provide an overview of the types of grants that were awarded by local VALE boards. The report also breaks down the percentage of funds supporting each victim service and law enforcement category. A detailed chart of each judicial district's awards is also included in the report.

LOCAL VALE BOARDS

The Act provides for a five-member board (appointed by the Chief Judge) in each judicial district. Each local board accepts applications and makes decisions regarding the use of VALE funds in that judicial district.

FUNDING SOURCE

Of the total fees collected by each local VALE program, a maximum of 10% may be used in each district for costs related to the administration of the Act and for preparation of victim impact statements. After allocation of administrative expenses, 13% of remaining collections are deposited with the State Treasurer for state administrative expenses and for the State Victim Assistance and Law Enforcement (VALE) competitive grant application process; this amounts to 11.7% of all collections.

GRANT AWARDS


During 2007, 357 grants and 588 scholarships were awarded to various organizations by local Victim Assistance and Law Enforcement boards. These grant awards and training scholarships totaled \$10,990,195.

Since 1986, 13,045 grants and scholarships totaling \$133,925,004 have been approved for funding by local VALE boards.

PRIORITY FUNDING AREAS

There are two areas of equal priority for VALE funding. One priority establishes funding for programs that implement the Victim Rights Act (CRS 24-4.1-302.5; 24-4.1-303; and 24-4.1-304). The other priority is funding for victim and witness services which are listed in the CRS 24-4.2-105(4). These include, but are not limited to, crisis intervention services, referrals of victims to appropriate community services and victim compensation programs, translator services, and counseling.




2007 Local VALE Grant Awards and Scholarships Percent of Grand Total Graph 1



2007 Local VALE GRANT AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS


Statewide Total Awards by Year Graph 2

Financial Report on the VALE Fund by Judicial District

Table 8: Collections, Administrative Expenses, Allocations to the State, Other Revenue, and Funds for Grant Program

The Judicial District financial report that follows is a snapshot of a single year of revenue to the VALE fund, with the statutory allocations for administrative funds and the state treasury included. The State Court Administrator's Office supplies revenue information.

The financial report has additional limitations that should be acknowledged in the review of the information. The report does not fully describe the status of the VALE fund in each district. It does not record fund balances, actual expenditures of administrative funds, or any refunds to the fund (e.g. a grant award that is not fully expended).

Despite these limitations, the financial report offers a statewide look at collections to the VALE fund during the period of a single year that may be useful to VALE Boards and Administrators.

Table 9: Historical Look at VALE Collections

A table is included that reflects the amount of VALE dollars collected in each Judicial District since 2000. This table clearly illustrates that collections have increased over the last four years.
