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Letter of Transmittal

January 2, 1935.

To His Excellency, ED C. JOHNSON, Governor of Colorado.

Sir:

Permit me to herewith submit the usual Annual Report of State Bank Commission as required under Section 68, Chapter 44, Session Laws of Colorado, 1913, for the year of 1934, a general statement of conditions, possibly showing an improvement over the previous year in some respects, regardless of drought conditions throughout the State, materially reducing financial returns anticipated and increasing requirement of State and Governmental assistance in many localities.

The adjustment of policy and administration in conformity with regulations and instructions of the Government has been of great importance, requiring much thought and decision relative to a policy that would produce best results.

Due effort has been put forth to cooperate with general plans submitted in nature of Deposit Guarantee and a universal report plan, requiring much time formerly devoted to examination and supervision of State Banks and Trust Companies, furnishing copies of examinations of this Department in all banks under the Preferred Stock of Reconstruction Finance Corporation.

Effective and apparent change in general conditions of banking institutions appears in recent Call Report, of November 30th, shown in high reserves and material increase of deposit accounts, due probably to operation of Federal Insurance, return to circulation of "hidden money" and the returns from season's crops; however, there appears a reluctance to advance credit conditions until a definite policy can be established as to valuations, consequently earning power in smaller banks is limited and relieved only by service charges, now in general effect throughout the State.

An encouraging statement may be made relative to closing of banks, due to the fact that not for sixteen months has it become necessary to assume charge for any purpose of liquidation.

Especial mention is made relative to Credit Unions, growing rapidly in membership, approximately four thousand members who receive the benefit of low interest rate when in need of financial assistance, and it is gratifying to state that twenty-three Credit Unions have been organized and now in successful operation, with earning power sufficient to pay expenses, as this is strictly a mutual benefit organization, operating with slight expectancy of profit.

Undue publicity has been given to conditions under the Money Lenders Act, resulting in a final Supreme Court decision holding the Act of 1919 to be unconstitutional and we recommend earnest consideration of legislation which will clarify the situation and provide a basic and operative law, as such has been adopted in many states, with provisions such as meet the demand for small loans.

Former reports have called attention to Industrial Banks organized and operating under the Law of 1923, and the past year has demonstrated that consideration should be given to legislation which would be beneficial to the public by all restrictions applicable to State Banks.

Results of the past year have proven satisfactory in institutions under Liquidating Department, in disbursement of dividends amounting to \$600,000.00 to duly approved claimants, and only available by constant application of ability and experience of the Special Deputies in charge, and relief obtained from Governmental Agencies, the proceeds of which amounting to thousands of dollars, anticipated as being available during the next few months.

Every effort has been put forth to care for the constantly increasing demand in the way of reports required by cooperative examinations with the various Government Agencies, absorbing much time formerly devoted to Banks in way of examination and supervision, which is most important to meet with general approval and can only be produced by competent and loyal personnel of this Department, whose assistance has been graciously given, if necessary, by additional hours of work without compensation.

The advice and counsel of the Governor and Attorney General have enabled your Commissioner to decide many important questions that have arisen during the past year and is duly appreciated and the Colorado Banking Department is well rated as to accomplishments.
