#### SUGGESTED LEGISLATION

#### Commercial Banks:

Provide for the reorganization of the department into separate divisions to meet the demands created by the rapidly growing number of commercial banks, industrial banks, credit unions, and finance companies.

Provide for per diem allowance for members of the State

Banking Board.

Clarify and prescribe standards for construction of driveup facilities and their proximity to main banking quarters.

#### Industrial Banks:

Eliminate the conduct of any other business in the same office with an industrial bank.

Provide for the ownership of stock as a requirement for being a director of an industrial bank.

#### Credit Unions:

Increase Guaranty Fund limit to 30%.

Provide for loan officers under direct control of Credit Committee.

Mandatory Blanket Bond coverage—directors, credit and supervisory committees, collectors, credit union employees.

Provide for interest refunds to borrowers if authorized by

Board of Directors.

Stipulate clearly what constitutes compensation of members and officers.

Waiving of dividends on unclaimed accounts.

Provision for disposing of accounts of members whose whereabouts are unknown for five years.

Provide for due process of law in foreclosures and judgments.

Right to lease, purchase, hold and dispose of property necessary and incidental to its operation.

Provide for limitations on investments other than direct loans to members.

Provide for charging out uncollectible assets or establishment of reserves to cover such accounts.

#### **Consumer Finance Act:**

Licensees be restricted to lending, insurance, and notary services unless other business is authorized by the Commissioner in writing after an investigation.

Provision for penalty of \$5.00 for each day of delinquency

for failure to file reports when due.

## Money Lenders Act of 1913:

Increase license fee comparable to fees on other lending laws.

Increase the cost of certified copies of surety bond to at least \$2.50.

Provision for penalty of \$5.00 for each day of delinquency for failure to file reports when due.

Prohibit all fees, commissions, charges and renewal costs under whatever name, the only charge being the 2% per month on declining balance.

Increase time for filing and deciding on complaint cases to 15 days.


